Is there a unifying principle linking speed to kinematics?

Thrust : force generated by pushing the fluid mass of fluid times the fin acceleration

Drag:

Large swimmers: proportional to U^2 (pressure drag) Moderately large swimmers : proportional to $U^{3/2}$ (skin drag or boundary layer drag)

Balancing Thrust and Drag : two scalings

$$U \propto A\omega$$
, for
 $J \propto \left(\frac{A^4\omega^4 L}{\nu}\right)^{1/3}$,

- fluid density
- fluid dynamic viscosity
- fluid kinematic viscosity
- thickness boundary layer 0

Does it work?

Robotic swimmer

- State: $F_y(t), F_y(t)$ Set of actions $\phi_c = -0.5, 0, 0.5$ (rad)
- **Reward:** $F_x(t)$

It learned ! • 1.5h of training **50 episodes**
