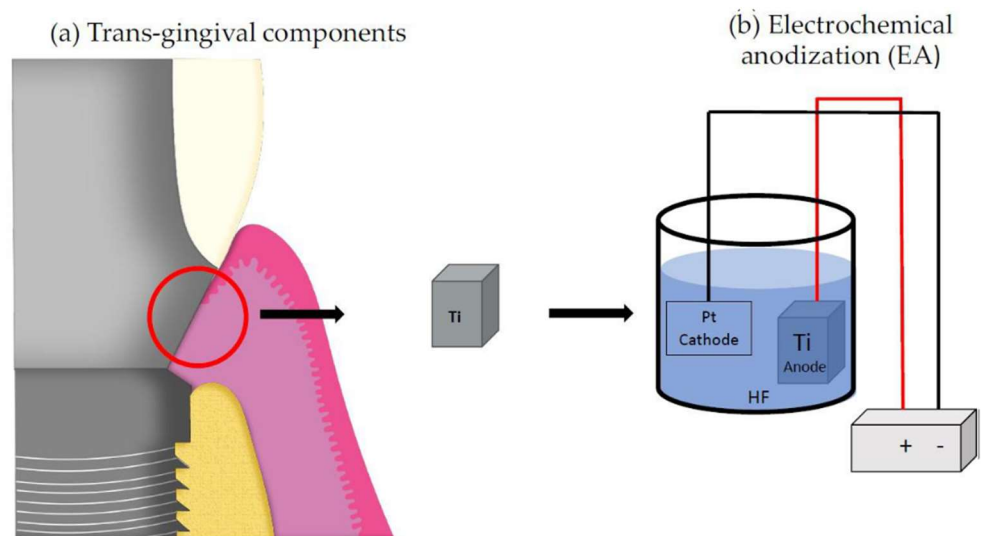


Figure 1. Schematic representation of (a) the trans-gingival abutment-mucosa interface and (b) the electrochemical anodization step to fabricate TiO₂ nanotubes or nanopores.

In the original article [1], there was a mistake in Figure 1 as published. The corrected figure appears below and the original article has also been updated.
