

### Content Curation is: Information and Knowledge Management system

- With human flair like Museum or Exhibitions curation
- Still a recent and no so well known concept, however many tools available
- Choice of Scoop.it
- Finding, collecting, elevating, sharing relevant knowledge material available from the web
- Covering either classical published scientific information, as well as material from internet and social networks
- To build specific content hubs











#### Advantages of digital content curation

- Research: various Immunology topics and subtopics, finding, archiving, retrieving information for
  - Personal use and network of students and colleagues
- Teaching and Learning for « Media and Information Literacy »
  - Active-, Hybrid-, Blended-Learning
  - Self-Learning
- Long Distance Learning (Resources and activities) during Covid pandemy
  - Nancy Lorraine, Wuhan Hubei, Kunming Yunnan
- Life-long learning (CME/CPD) in High Education and Corporate Settings
  - Knowledge management in companies, individually or as networks
- Challenges: like most learning approaches
  - Digital content curation is a day to day duty... like walking the dog
  - Will artifical intelligence help, and « social listening » tools?

# **LIGHTING Innovation Design**

## Technical Watch

- LEDs : up to 30% of posts in the first years, from savings to (blue) light pollution
- Solar Lighting >10% posts
  - Africa, Asia, Europe...
- Smart Cities >15% posts and thriving

# Information from a Global World:

- Europe #40%
- Americas >25%
- Asia: China, India #5% each
- Africa #5% (Master by A.Dia) from Lighting to Energy, from Off-Grid to Smart cities













# **Societal Watch**

- Economy of public lighting: policy makers, public officers
- From costs (#5%) to savings
- Through LEDs and lighting limitations

# Well-Being: the state of being comfortable, healthy or happy


#### - HUMANS








#### Digital Content Curation is for...
