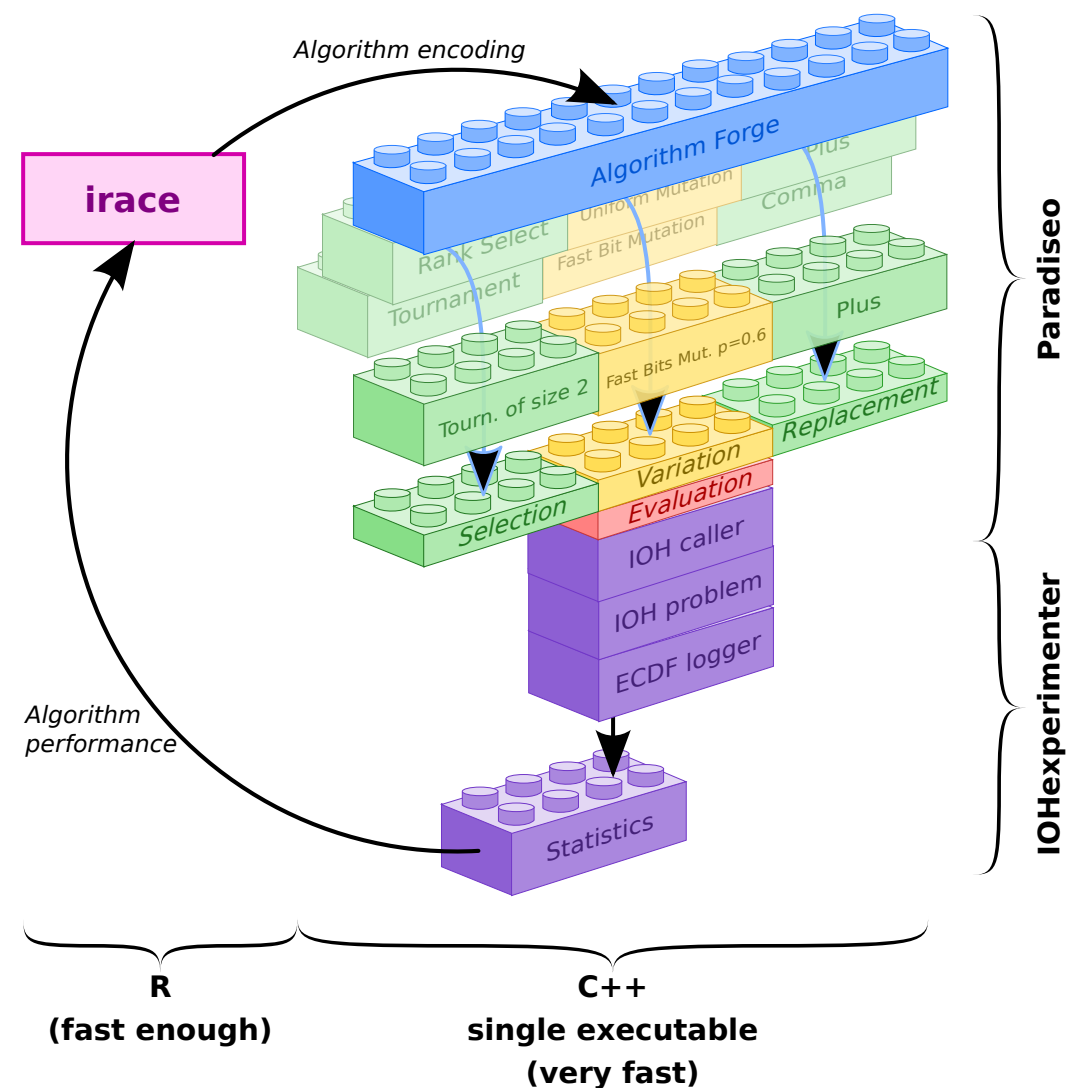

1. Fast Automated Pipeline



100 000 runs for each of 19 problems
in 3 hours on a laptop

(at least 10 times faster than optimized C/Python/Numpy counterpart)

Very fast runs,
 very expressive models,
 (for algorithms and performance)
 standardized results data,
 that can be easily explored,
 Open-source.

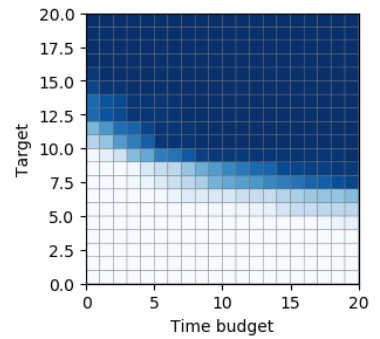
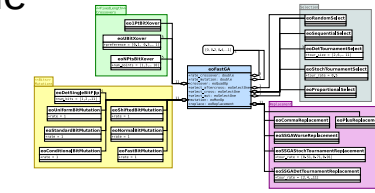

 Stat. : 2D Quality/Time log ECDH volume

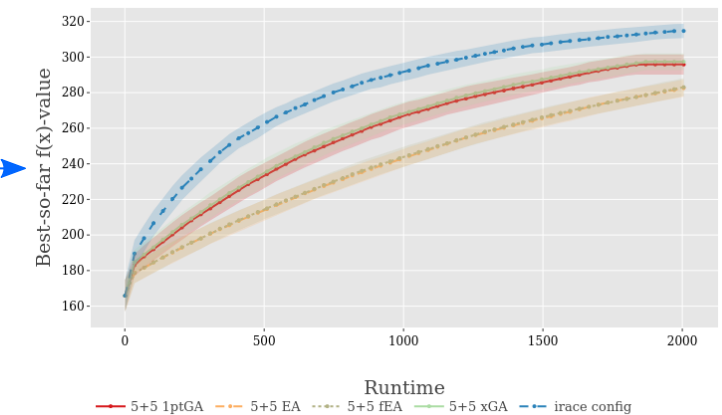
Per-instance configuration with irace.
