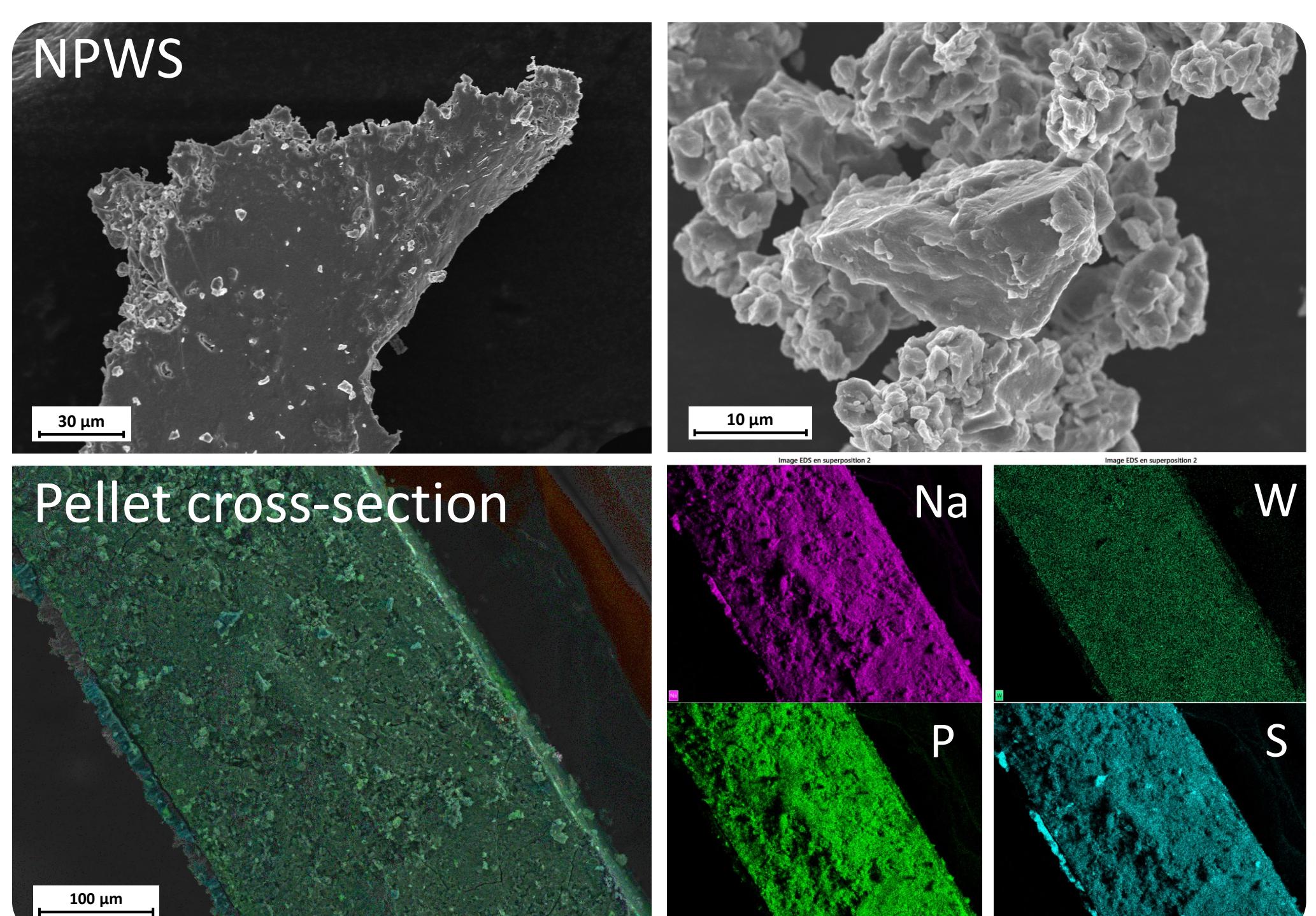

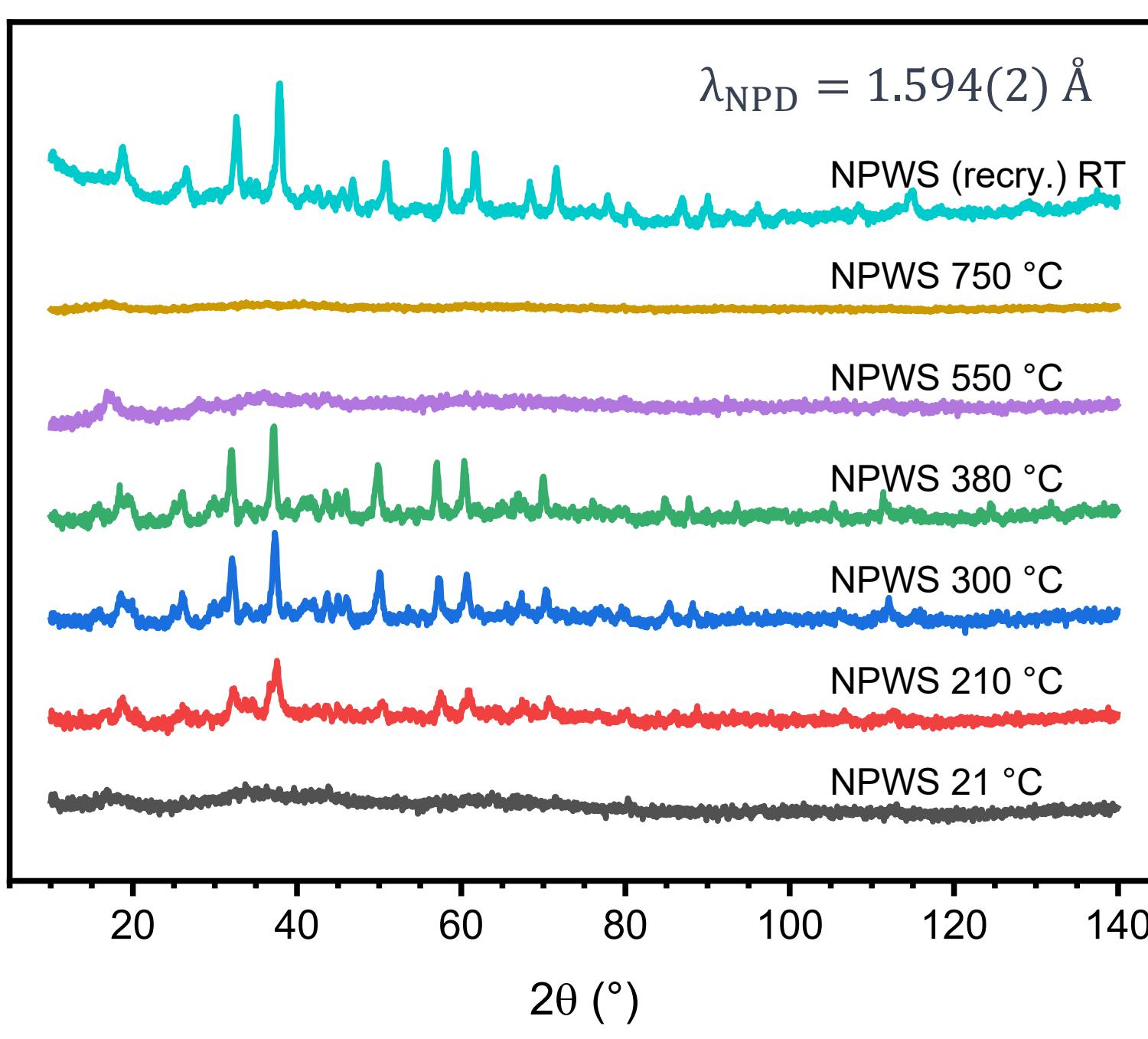

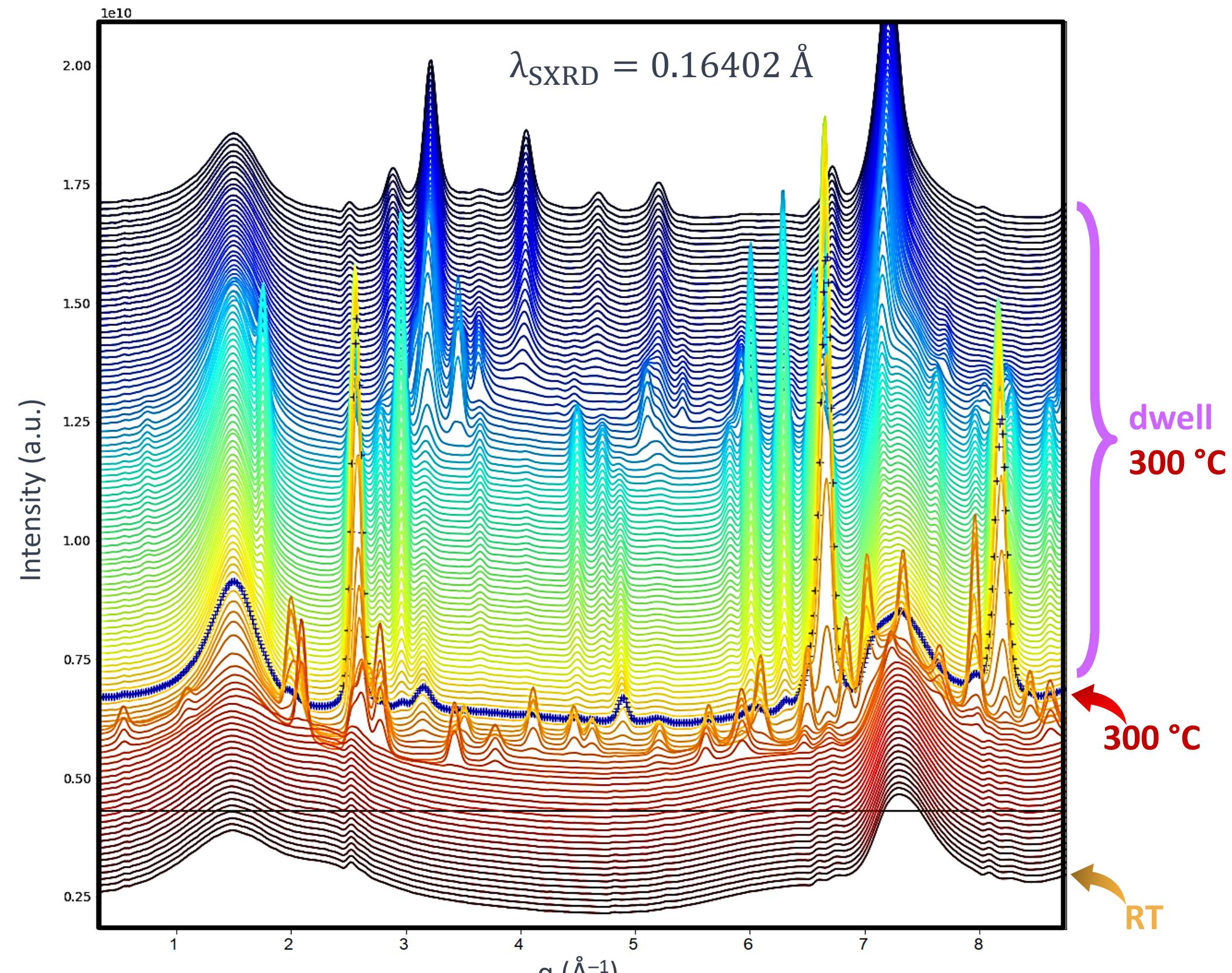
Na_{2.85}P_{0.85}W_{0.15}S₄ (NPWS) – Scanning electron microscopy-EDS



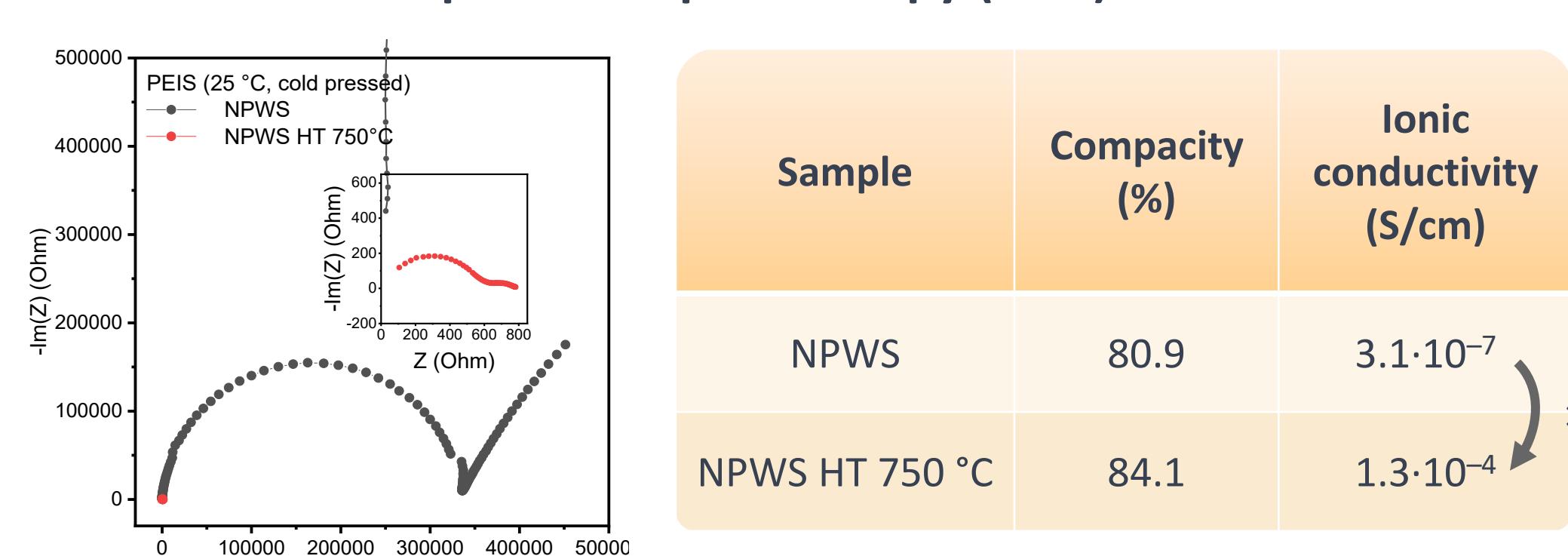
Neutron powder diffraction (NPD)



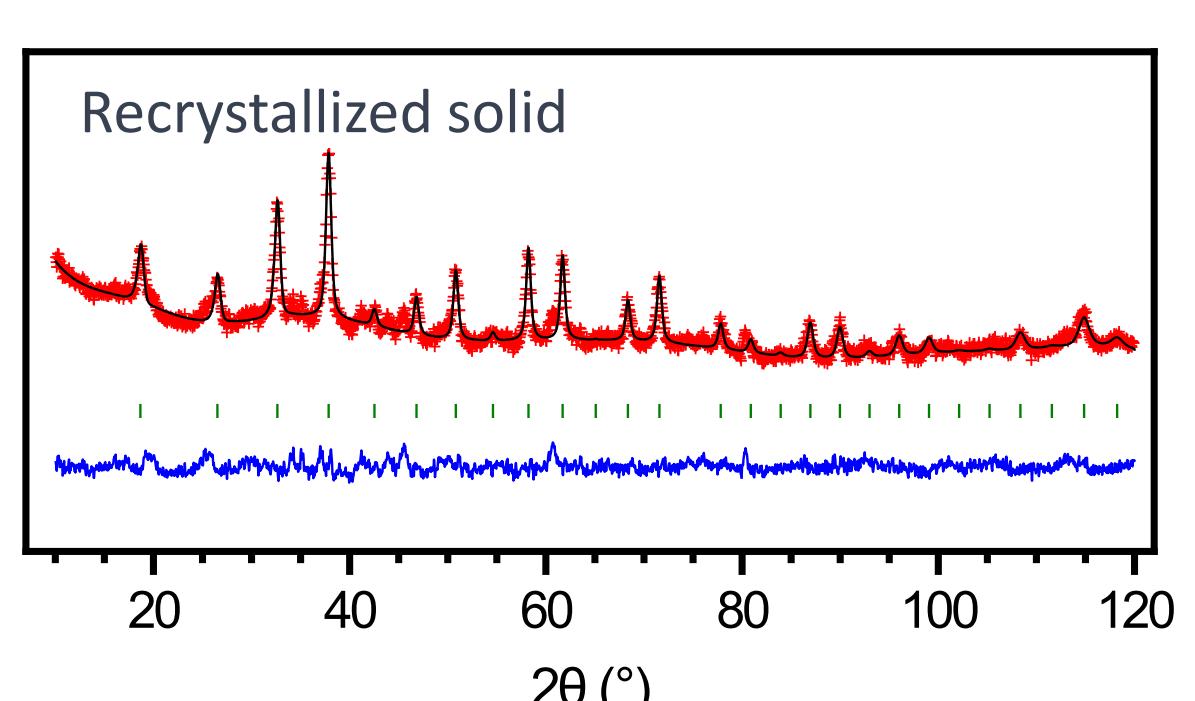
Synchrotron X-ray diffraction (SXRD)

» Cubic $I\bar{4}3m$ (217) space group

» Na1 found in high multiplicity site

» $f_{occ} < 1$

» Percolation favoured

Na⁺ ions pathway (by BVEL)

Conclusions and overview

Ball milled NPWS ➤ amorphous

Recrystallization ➤ β phase (stable at RT)

✓ Na hop favored ➤ $\sigma_{ion} \times 420 \checkmark$

- **Transient** phase @ ~275 °C
- **Multiple phases** during hold @ 300 °C
 - Can they be **isolated**?
 - **Electrochemical performance?**

- **Phase identification** @ ≠ **time** & **Temp**
- **Long rest** @ 300 °C & 380 °C (12 h)
- Electrical conductivity **negligible**? **Electrochem. stability window**, plating stripping, full cell...
