#### Future work

- Analysis of contact resistance bias (lab / theoretical investigations)
- Analyse the IP data (decay curves; filtering requirements)
- Thermal state analysis, relate to BH dataset
- Investigate the steep topography impact regarding inversion (compare with other softwares)
- Carry out 3D inversion
- Include full wave form signal analysis

#### Take home messages

- Major efforts to install and maintain device
- Poor reliability of ABEM Terrameter LS2 (especially for monitoring purpose)
- Dataset spanning 3 years, with year round information to document rockwall permafrost
- Importance of data management: automation, analysis, filtering, ...
