The protein bands were digitally quantified using ImageLab software (BioRad, ver. 6.0.1). On the panel B following lines represent: A – muscles after 3 x 3 h cold stress + 24 h recovery, B – muscles after 3 x 3 h cold stress, C – muscles control, D – fat body after 3 x 3 h cold stress + 24 h recovery, E – fat body after 3 x 3 h cold stress and F – fat body control. Despite many attempts, we did not obtain bands of sufficient intensity for the fat body to be quantified. This is probably due to the use of antibodies other than those originally used to identify UCP4 protein in the fat body and muscle tissues of the cockroach by Slocinska et al. (2011). These antibodies are no longer commercially available.
