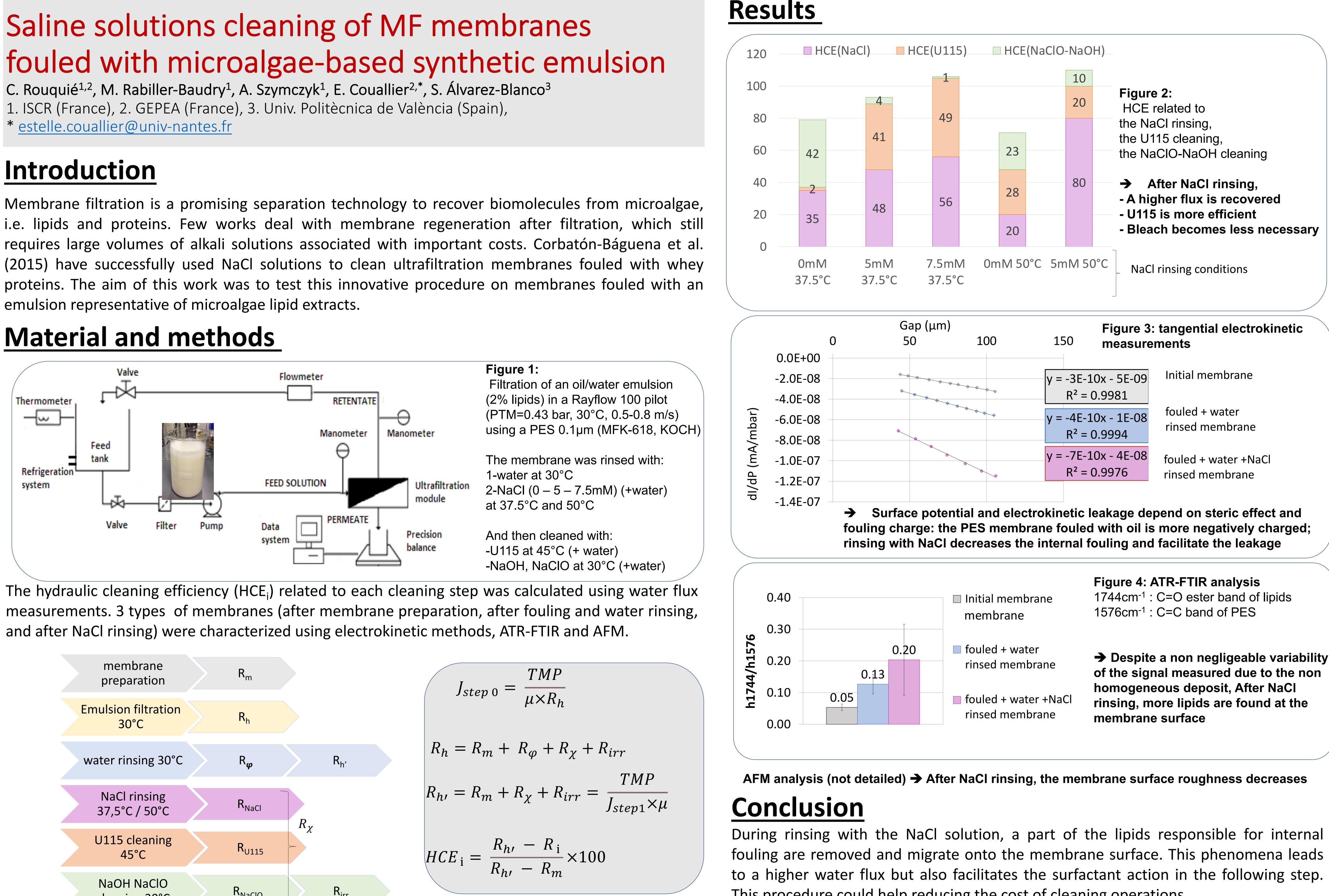

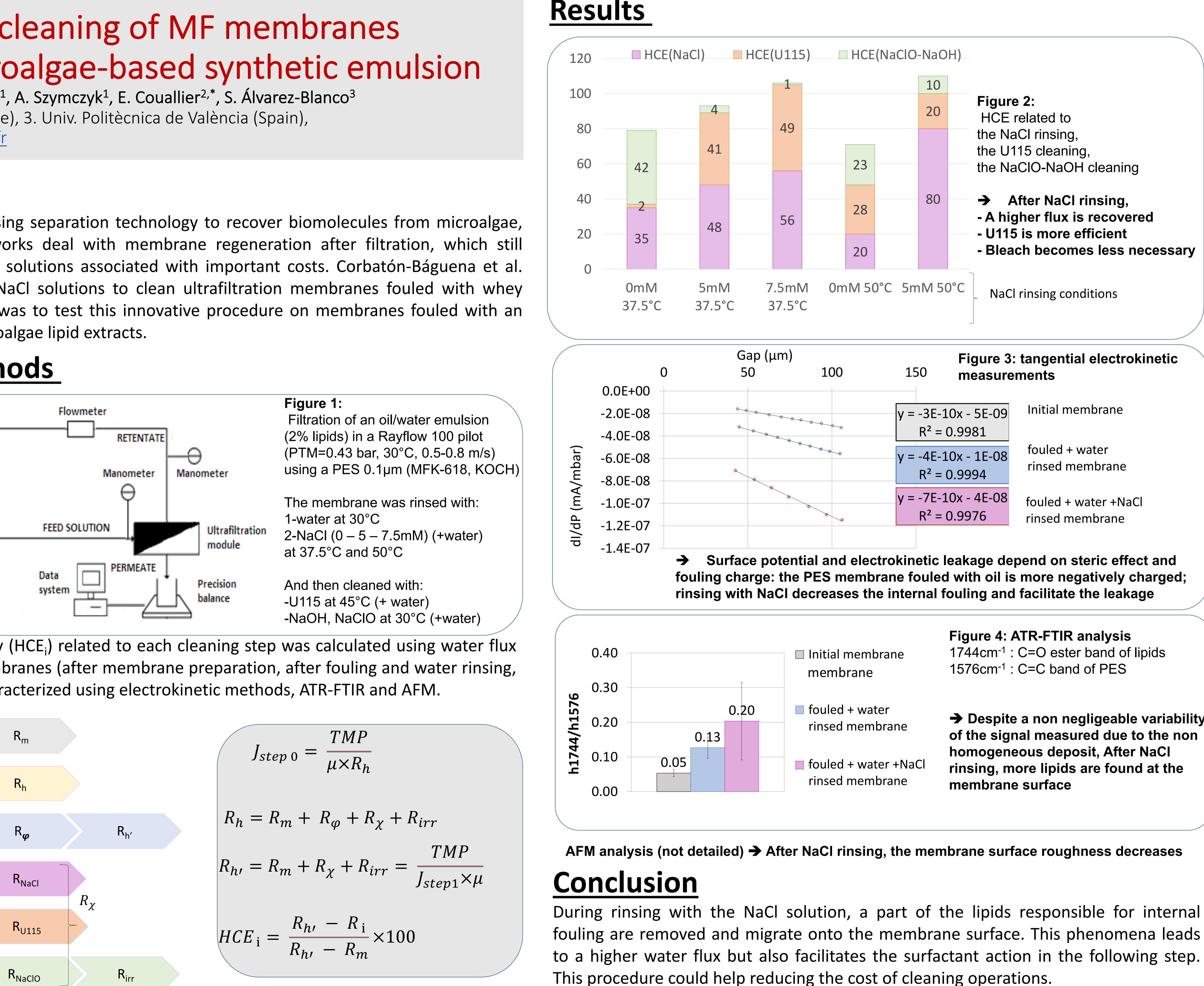

uled + water nsed membrane	→ Despite a non negligeable variability of the signal measured due to the non homogeneous deposit, After NaCI rinsing, more lipids are found at the membrane surface
uled + water +NaCl nsed membrane
