


# On the history of the phonetic institute of the Université de Paris from 1911 to 1950

After the recent closure of the building hosting the Institut de Phonétique de Paris since 1928, we aim to retrace some of the key aspects of this historical location based on newly-found documents.




## (i) From the students' registry (1931-1950)

A key figure in research and training students in instrumental phonetics at the Institute.
