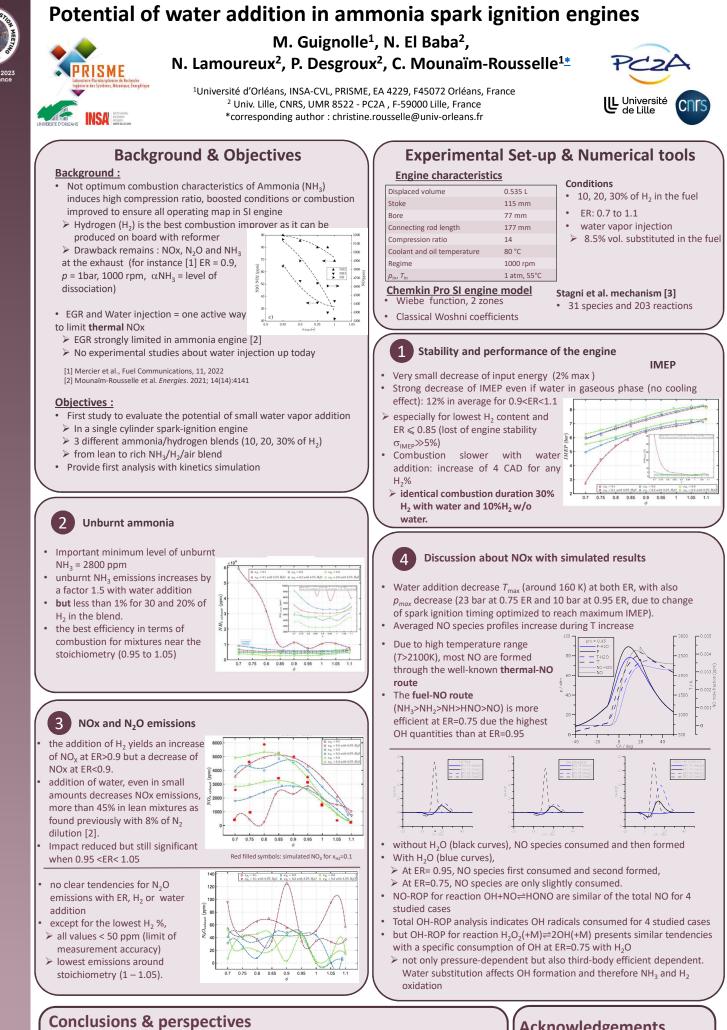

First experimental study about the potential of water addition in NH₃/H₂ fuel to reduce NOx emissions For lean NH₂/H₂ mixtures, NOx strongly reduced by water presence, even if both thermal and fuel NOx routes are involved, due to change of OH radicals, pointed out by the simulated by 0D 2 zone model Further experimental studies and kinetic chemistry analysis necessary to discriminate the effect of pressure, temperature and chemistry on the decreasing of NO
