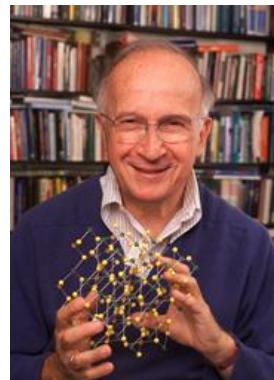

Trapping of 2-halogenated aminocyclopropanes



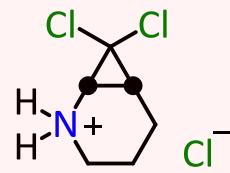
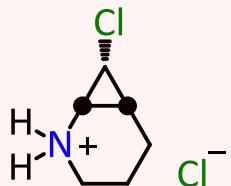
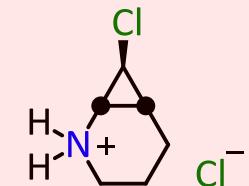
