The ELIPSS device


a probabilistic research panel

- Approximately 2,600 people
 over the age of 18
- Recruitment based on a probabilistic approach
- Monthly studies designed by researchers in the Humanities and Social Sciences
- Data produced disseminated to the scientific community

- Intervention during DATA collection
- Regular monitoring of surveys responses
- Understanding and limiting panel attrition
- Making a link between panellists and the CDSP







B1	Difficulty answering questions	Too many political parties, don't know where to turn / no more left/right ++ Difficulty positioning LREM left/right The questionnaire does not take into account the left-wing alliance Difficulty answering questions about the media (outside traditional channels) Not enough knowledge on the subject + Male/female divide VS skills + Sometimes the vote is cast for a candidate, other times for a party Sometimes too many 0 to 10 scales that don't make sense
B2	Lack of choice in response proposals	Missing a neutral option ++ Choices too binary + Sometimes single-choice questions instead of multiple-choice questions Lacks an option/filter for those who don't want to say who they voted for + Missing an option/filter for those who cannot vote + Small candidates forgotten + The question "Do you think the different categories are treated fairly?" does not differentiate enough between social classes
B3	Impossibility to develop the answer	Desire to qualify or clarify answer
B4	Poorly defined/contextualized question	Problem with the wording "enjoy social networks" Some questions too general ++ Problem with the notion of "group" + Need a better explaination "left" and "right" (parties, movements, economically, socially, historically) + First two questions (about TV viewing time) not clear enough (to watch what?) Questions too vague/general + General conditions (RGPD box to be ticked at the start of the survey) too complex, need for pedagogy on this point
