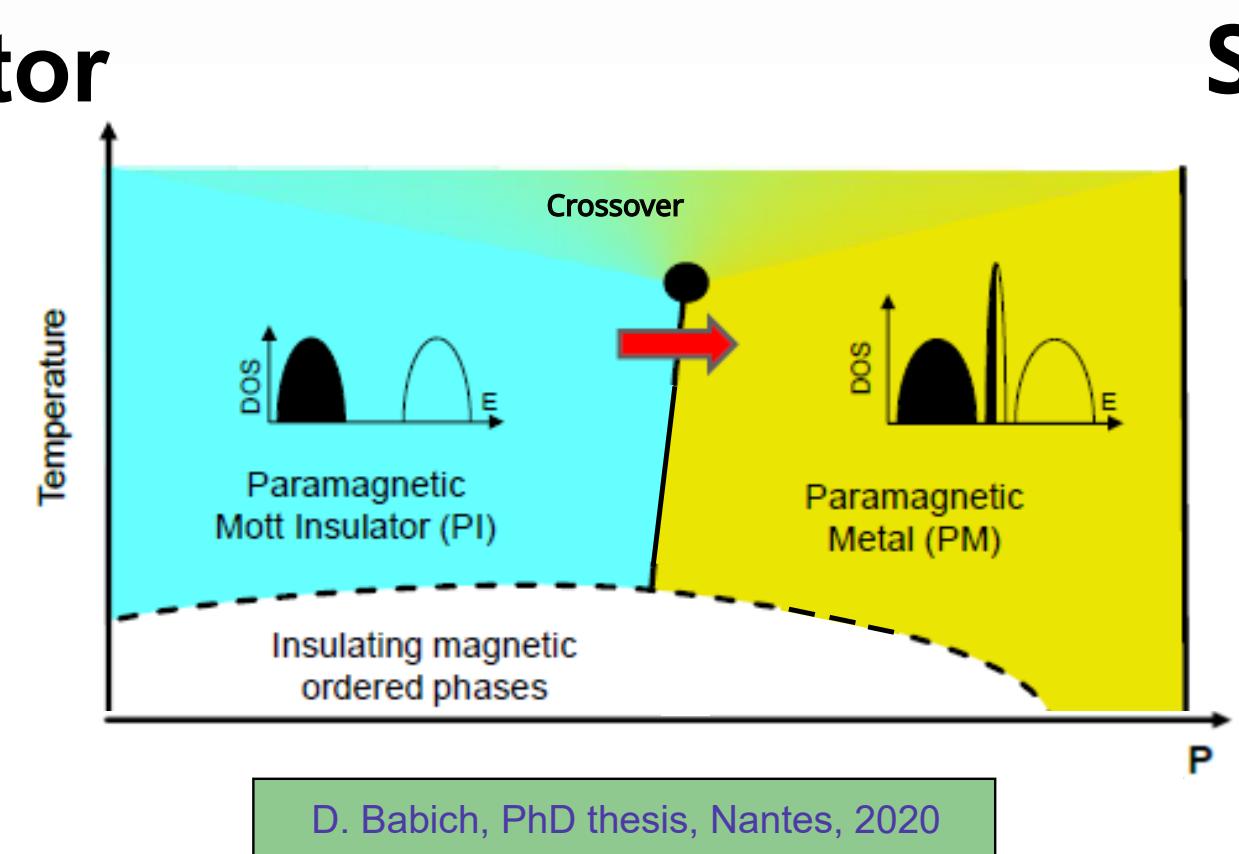
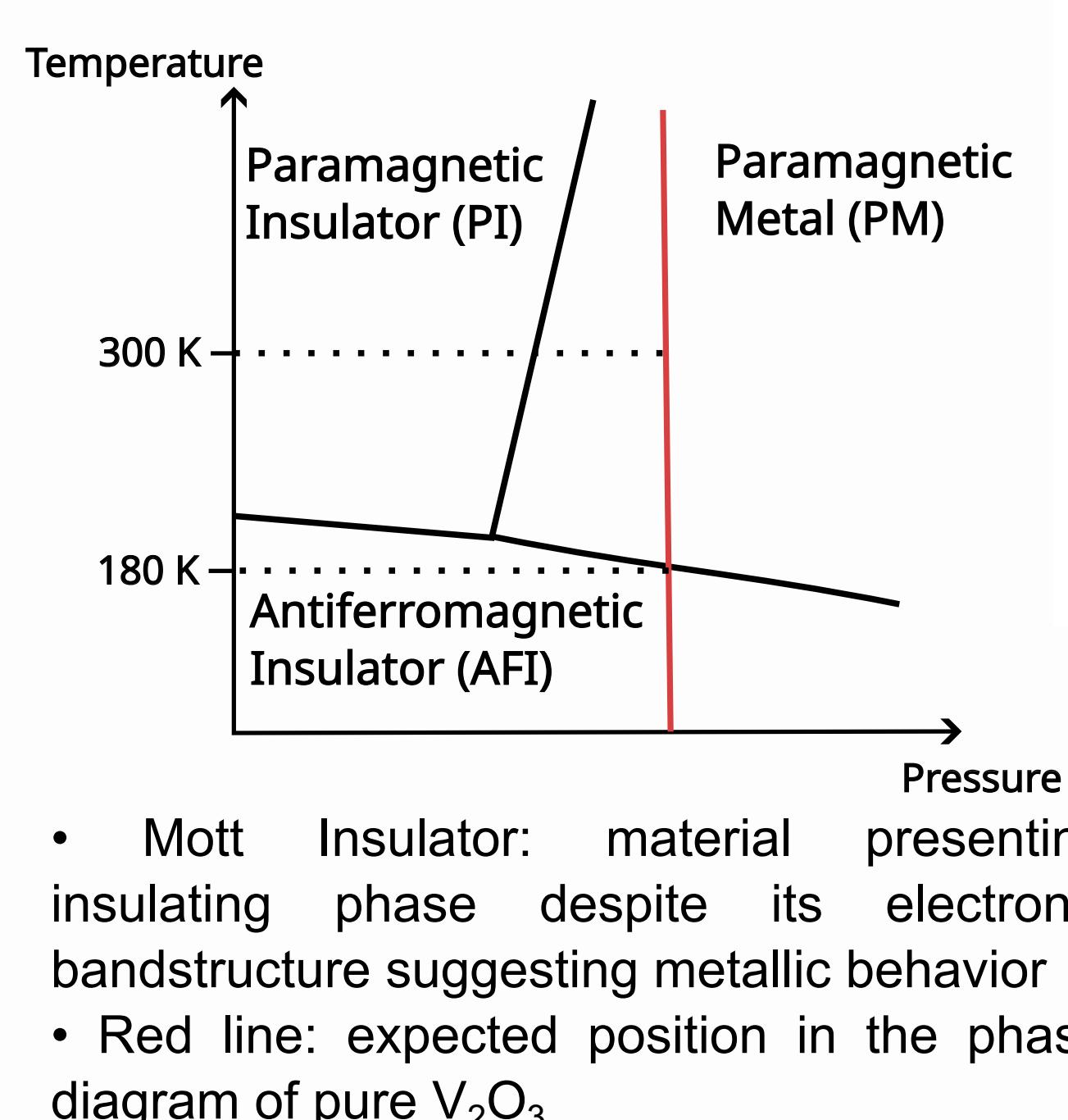

Impact of Pressure, Temperature and Excitation Density on photo-induced A_{1g} optical mode?

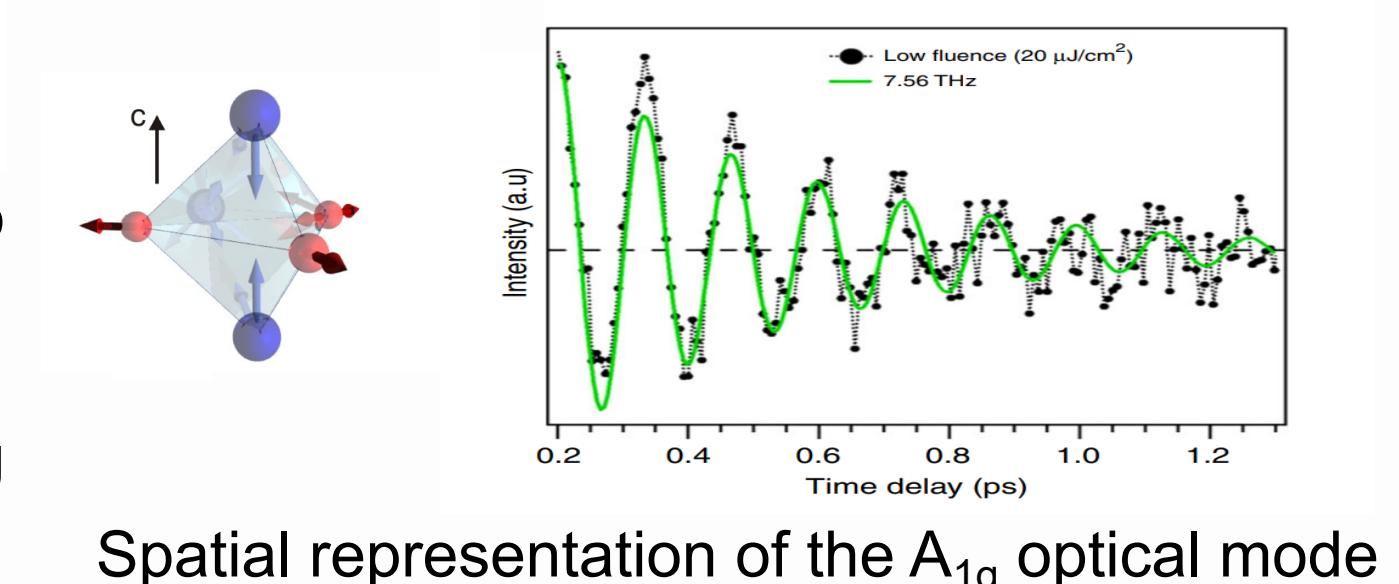
V_2O_3 prototypical Mott Insulator



- Electronic bandwidth impact the Insulator to Metal transition
- Crossing the PI-PM line by applying pressure
- Pressure enhances orbital overlap ->enlarging the bandwidth

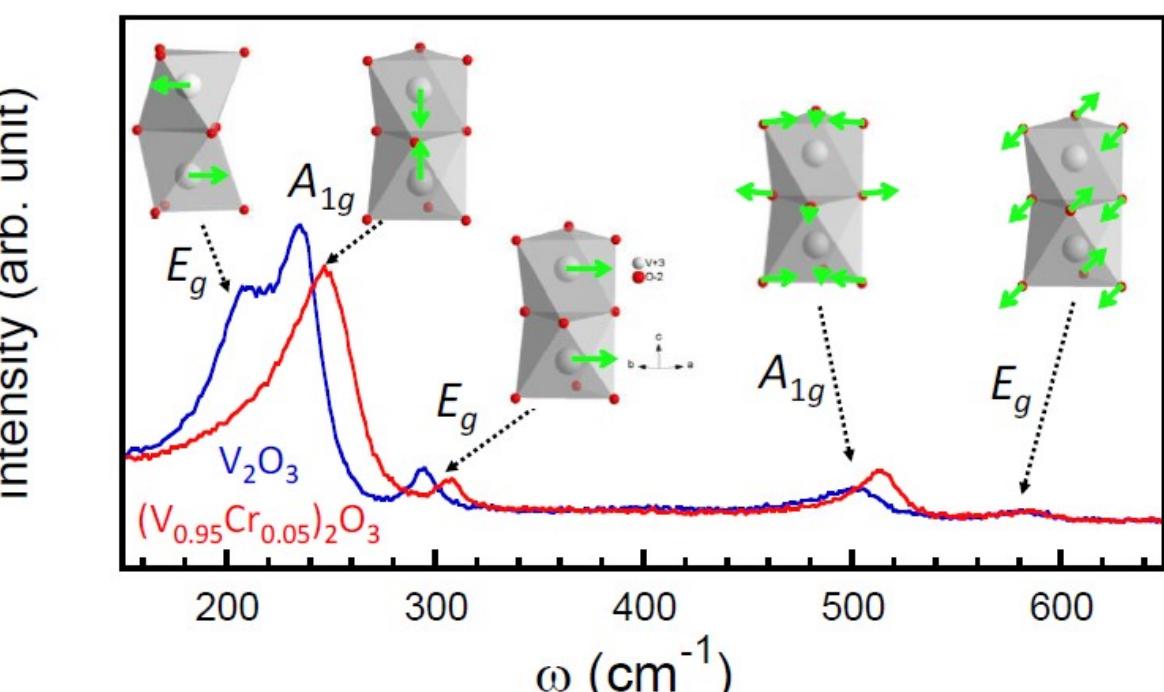
Spectroscopy of coherent phonons

- Photo-excitation induces the generation of coherent optical phonon within DECP mechanism (Displacive Excitation of Coherent Phonon)
- Observation of one single frequency around 7 THz; in agreement with A_{1g} frequency (Raman)

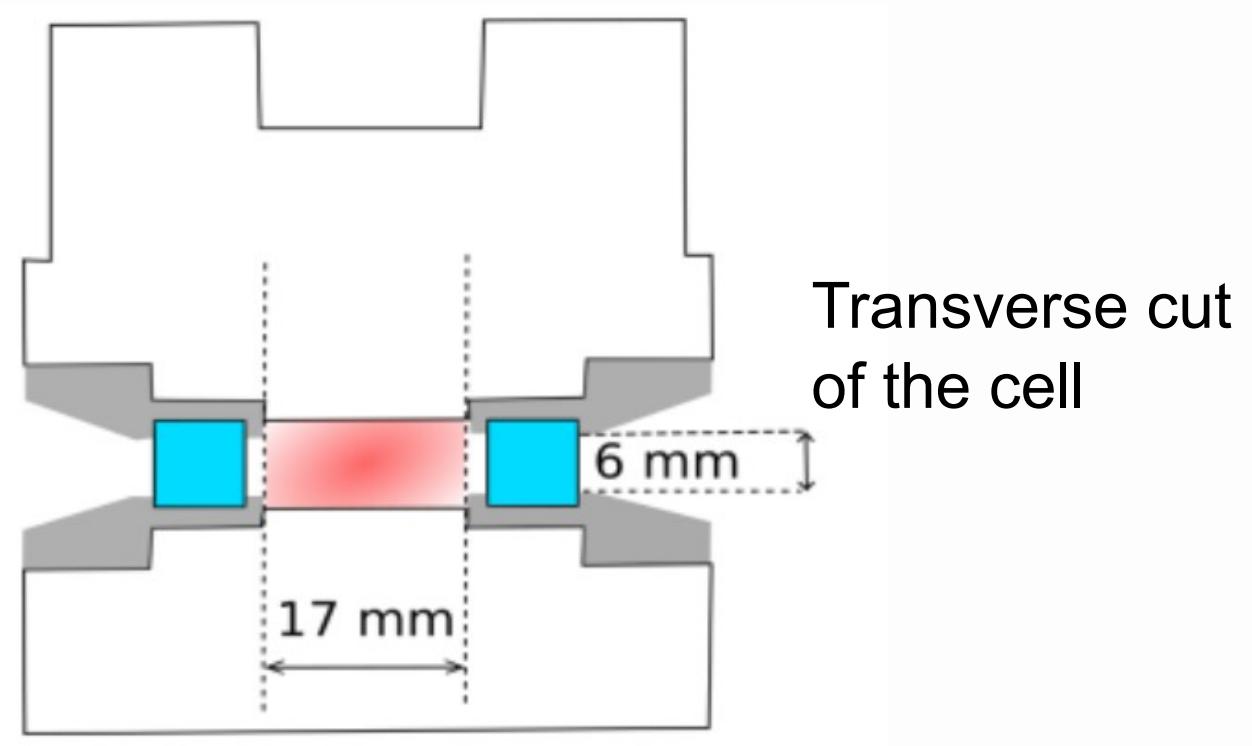
Goals:

- Performing ultrafast spectroscopy on "strained" V_2O_3 thin film (PI phase) under pressure
- Monitoring the evolution A_{1g} mode with thermodynamical control (Temperature, Pressure)

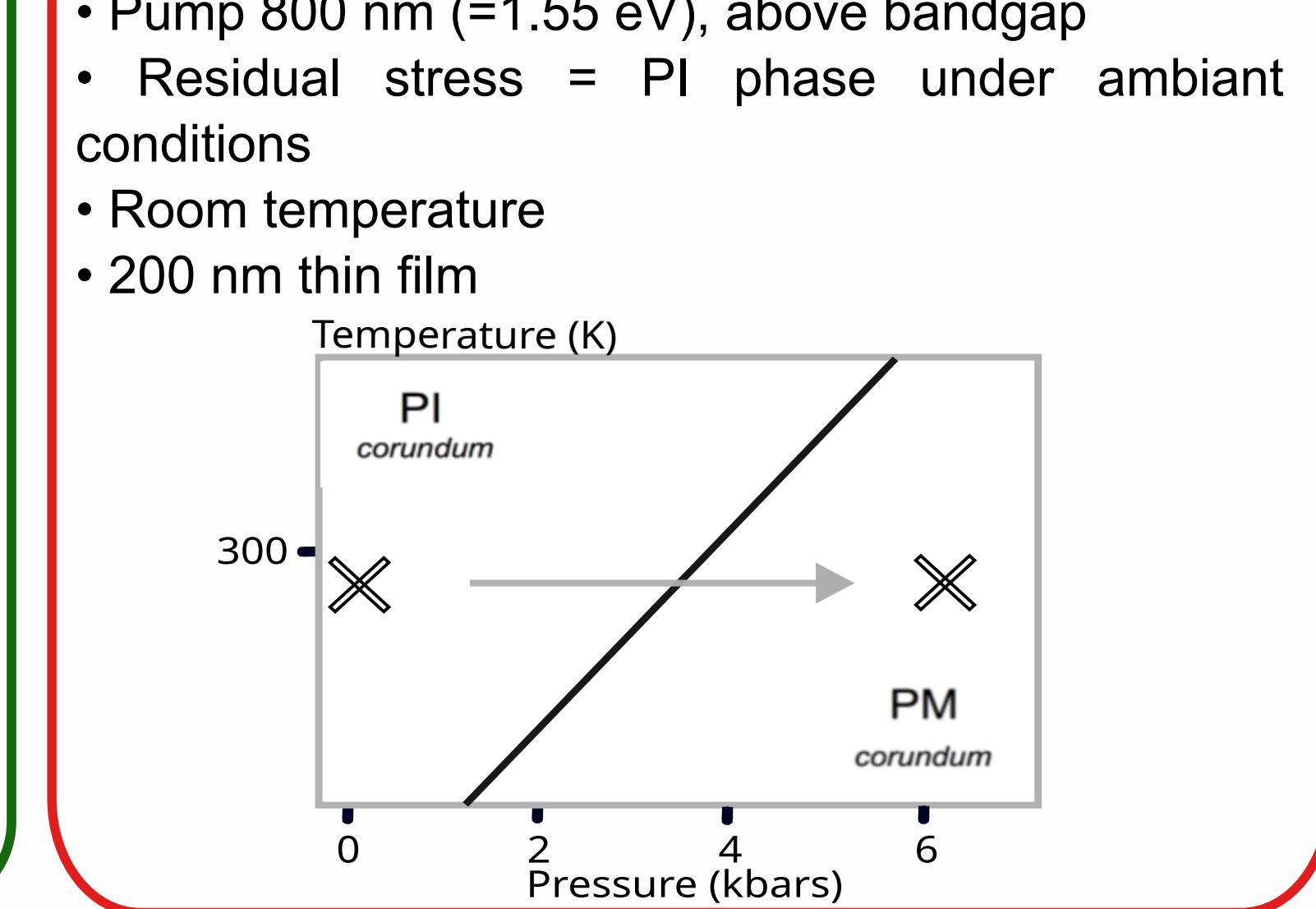
Spectroscopy of coherent phonon across V_2O_3 PI-PM phase transition

High Pressure Cell

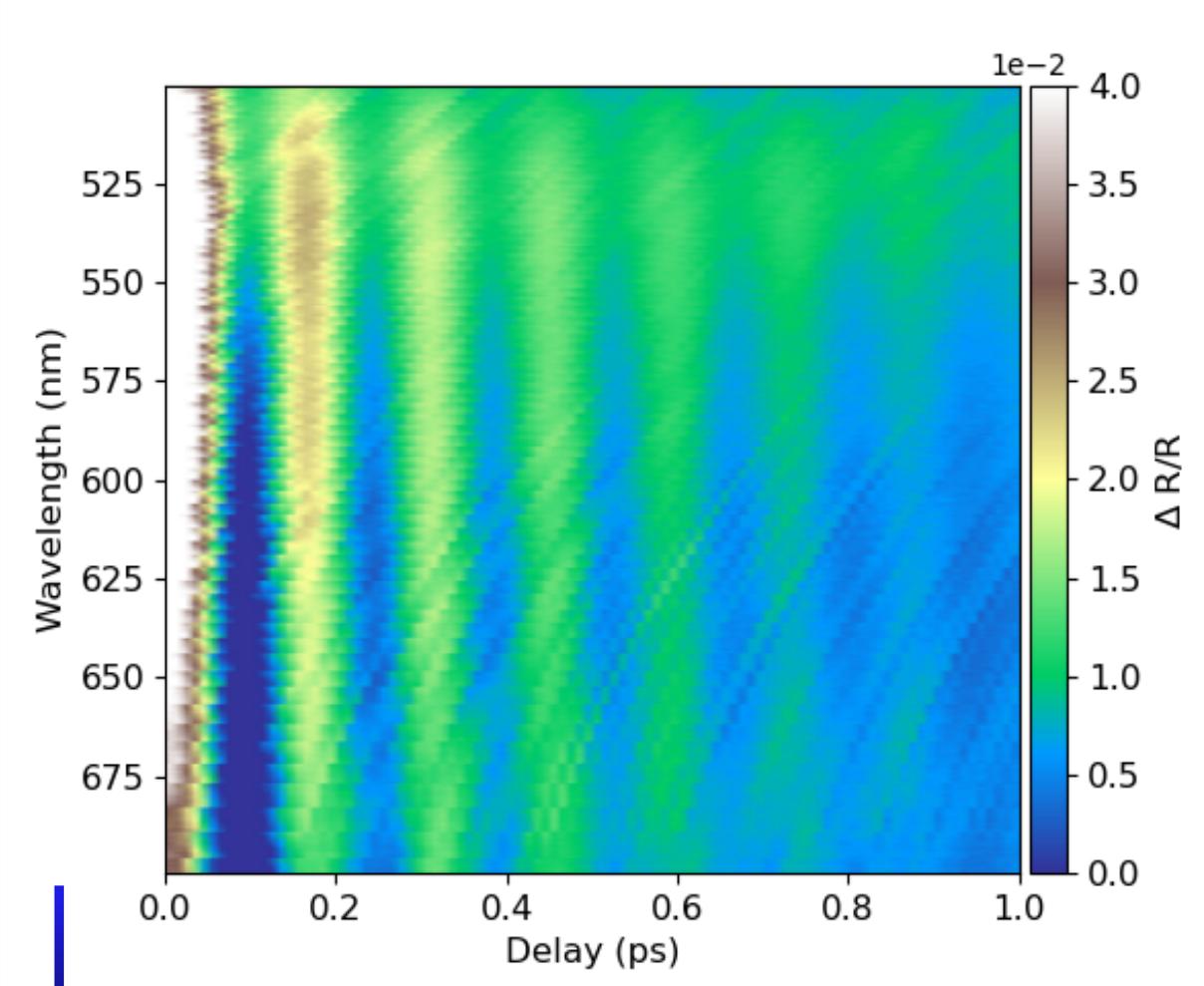
- Helium gas high pressure set up
- Hydrostatic pressure from 1 to 7000 bars
- Sapphire windows allowing optical Transmission/Reflection

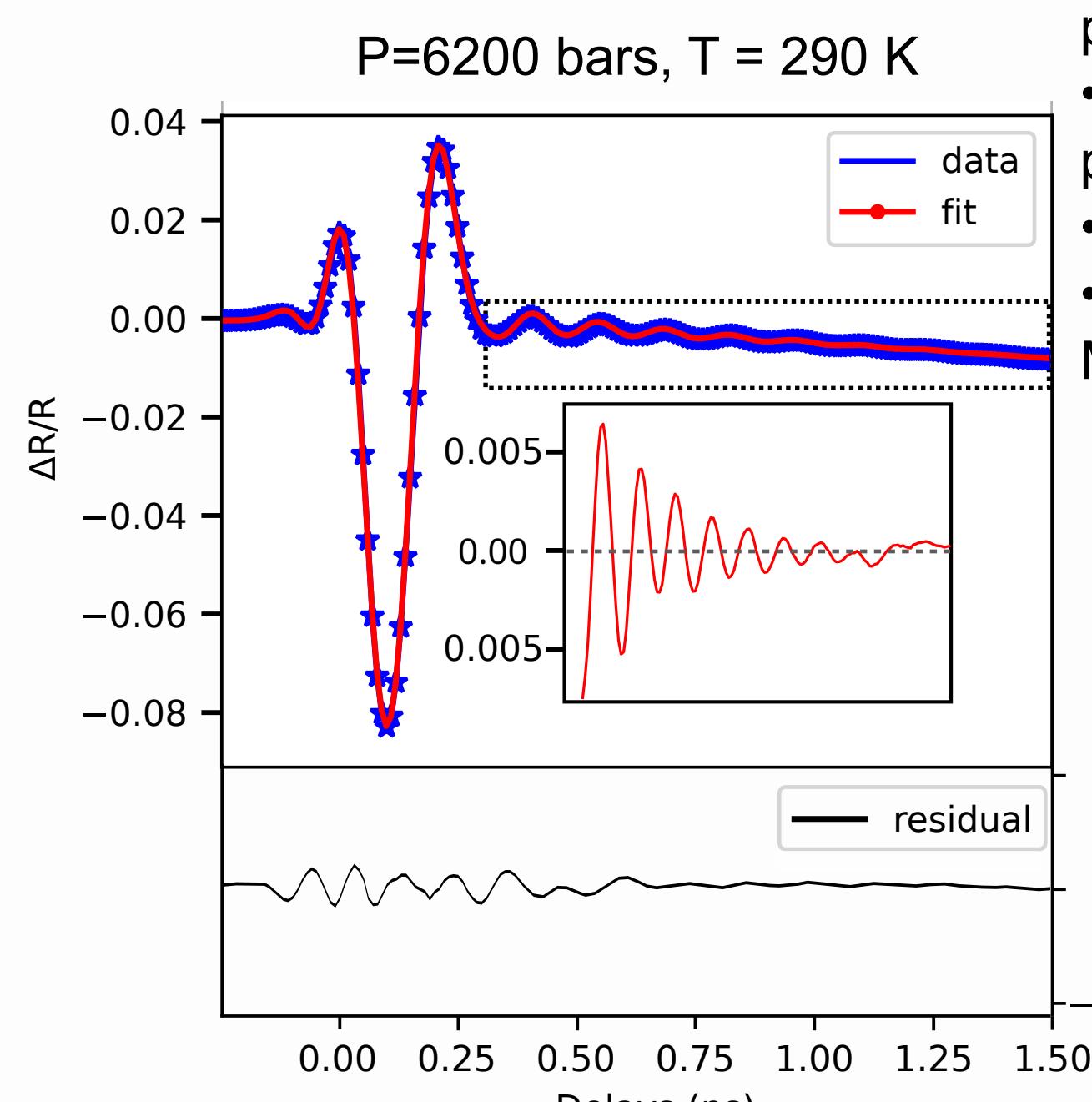


Experimental Data

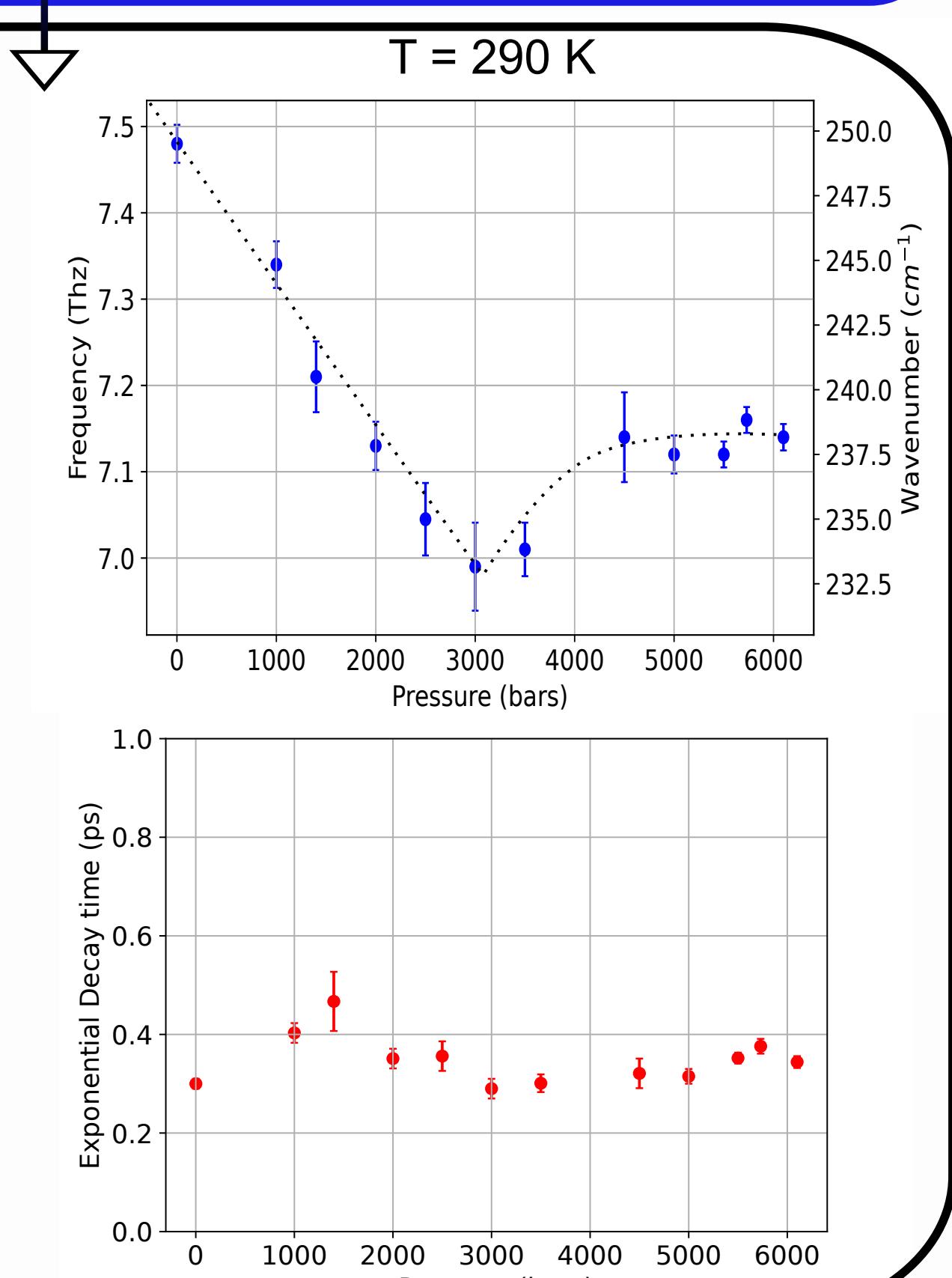
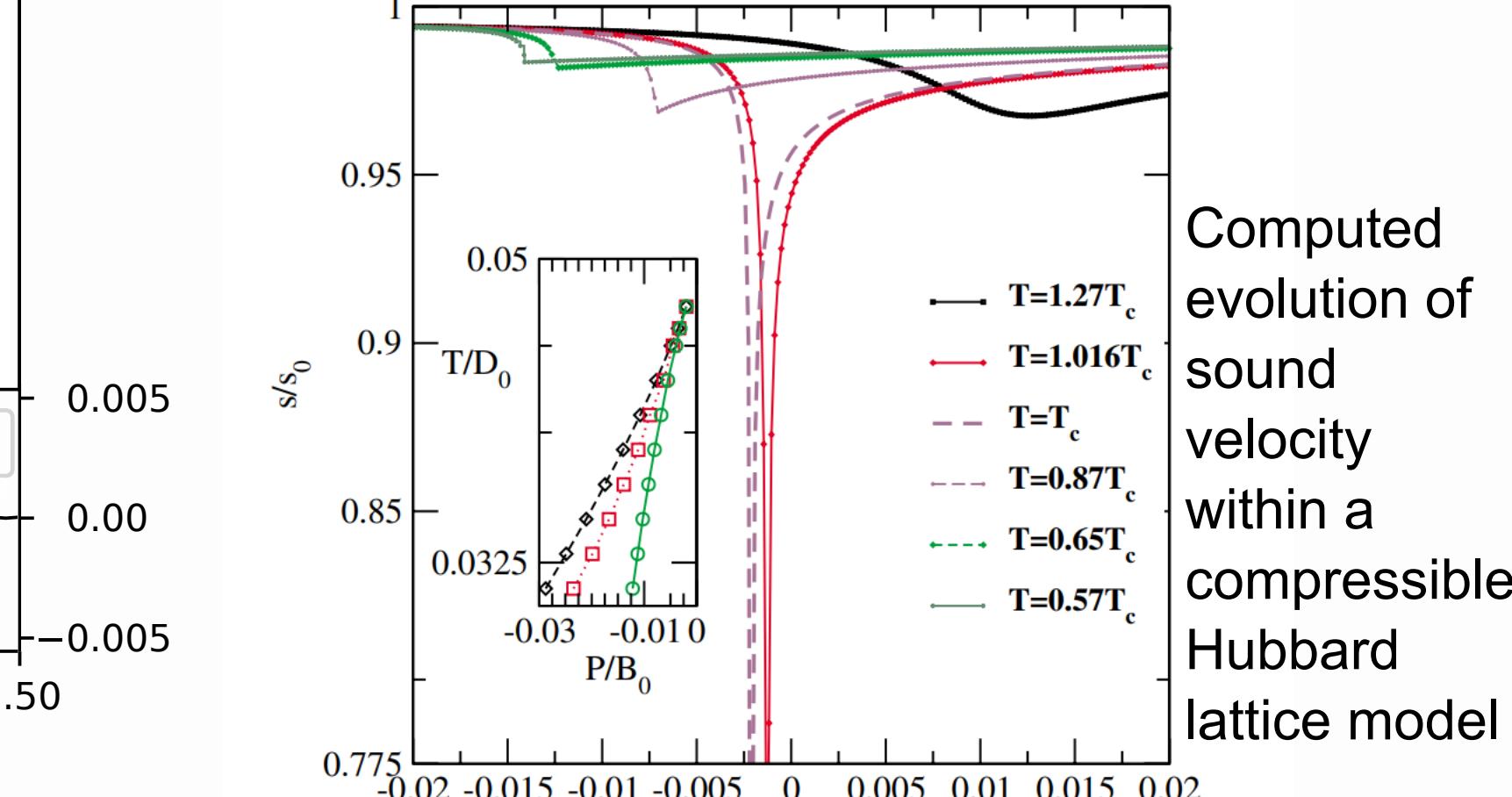


Data treatment and observations

- Transient Reflectivity around 675 nm with 800 nm photo excitation
- Raw data points are shown in blue points and fit in red solid line. Bottom, residual component of the fit.
- Insert shows the oscillatory component
- Fit with 3 contributions
 - Non linear effect at time zero + electronic excitation
 - Oscillatory component from coherent phonon
 - Thermo-elastic effects



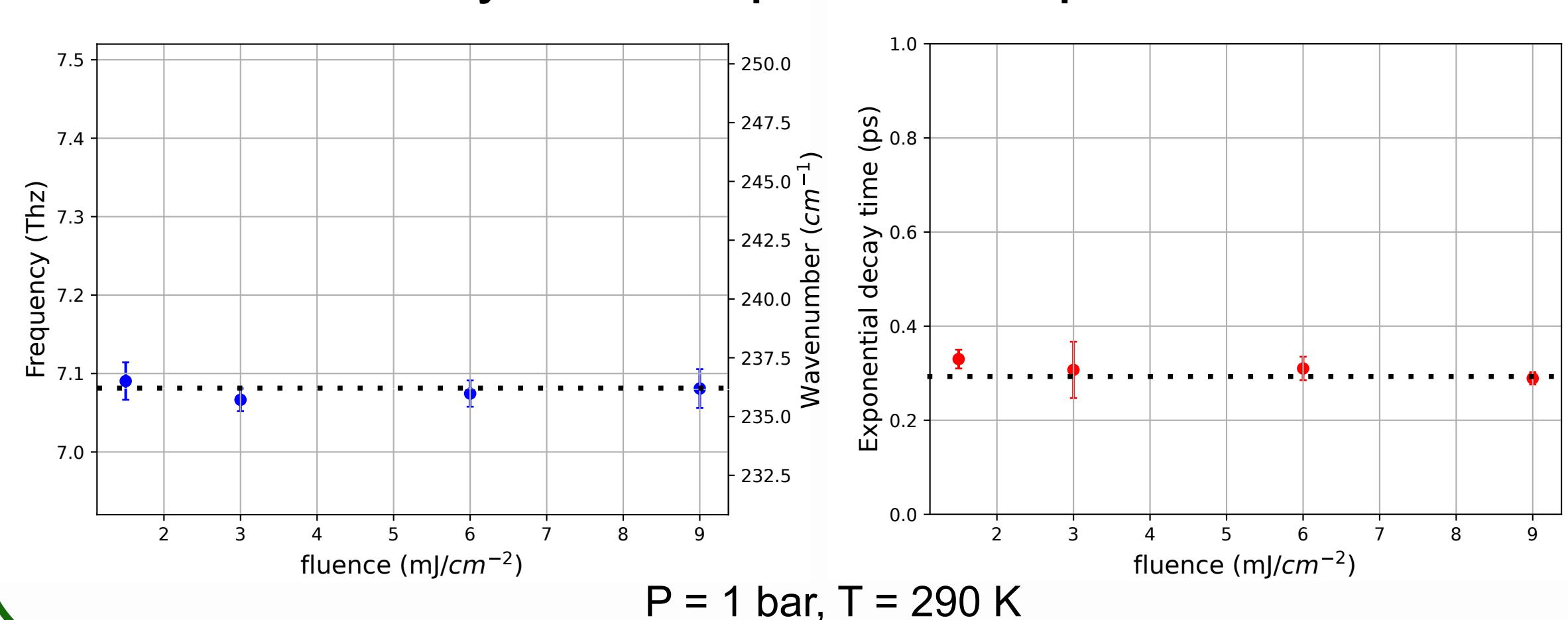
- Extracting A_{1g} frequency and damping as a function of pressure
- No obvious dependency of the damping time with pressure
- Lowest value of phonon frequency around 3 kbars
- Similar behavior as the sound velocity observed in other Mott materials



Impact of the temperature and excitation density on structural dynamic in V_2O_3 (PM phase)

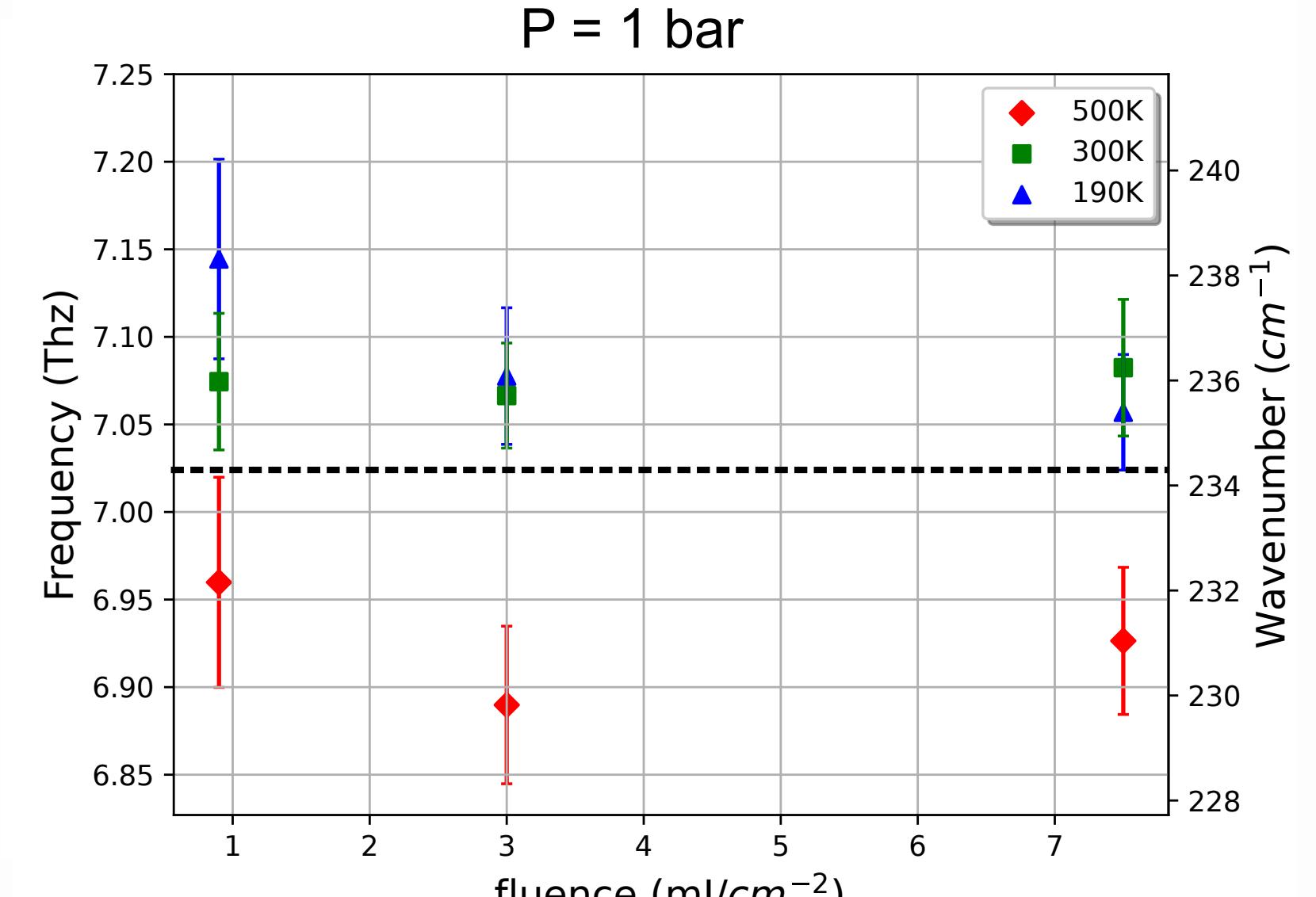
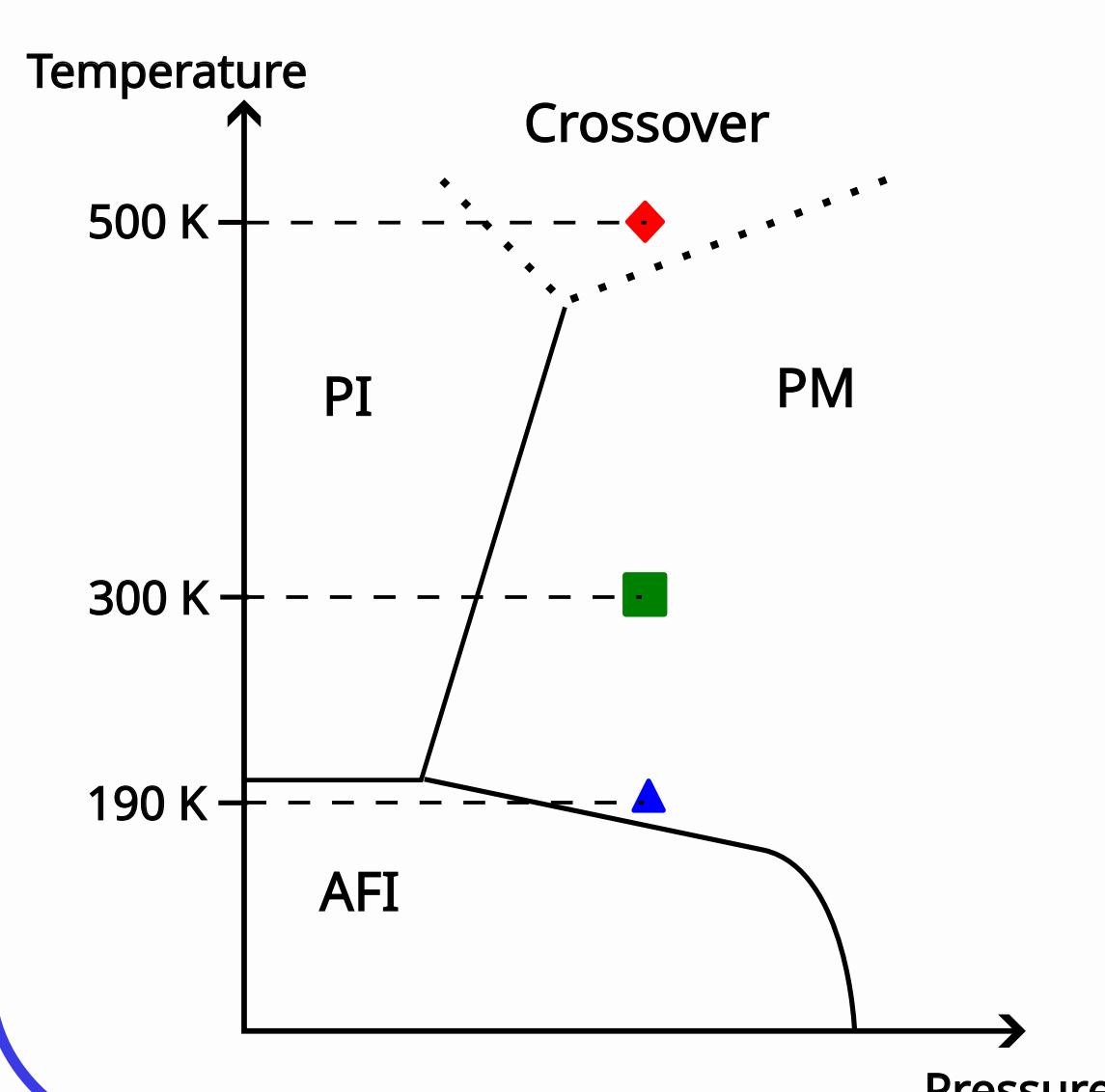
Excitation density

- From 1.5 to 9 mJ/cm⁻²
- No influence from the excitation density
- No influence on the damping time
- Different from Bismuth (softening) or Gold (hardening)
- **The excitation density does not impact the lattice potential**



Temperature

- From 190 K to 500 K
- Softening of the A_{1g} mode at 500 K (Crossover region)
- No evolution of the frequency with the excitation density



Outlooks

- Exploring the Pressure/Temperature phase diagram of molecular material
- Using Pump-Probe experiment to study optical response of different phase, follow electronics and structural dynamics
- Application to molecular materials: (EDO-TTF)SbF₆
