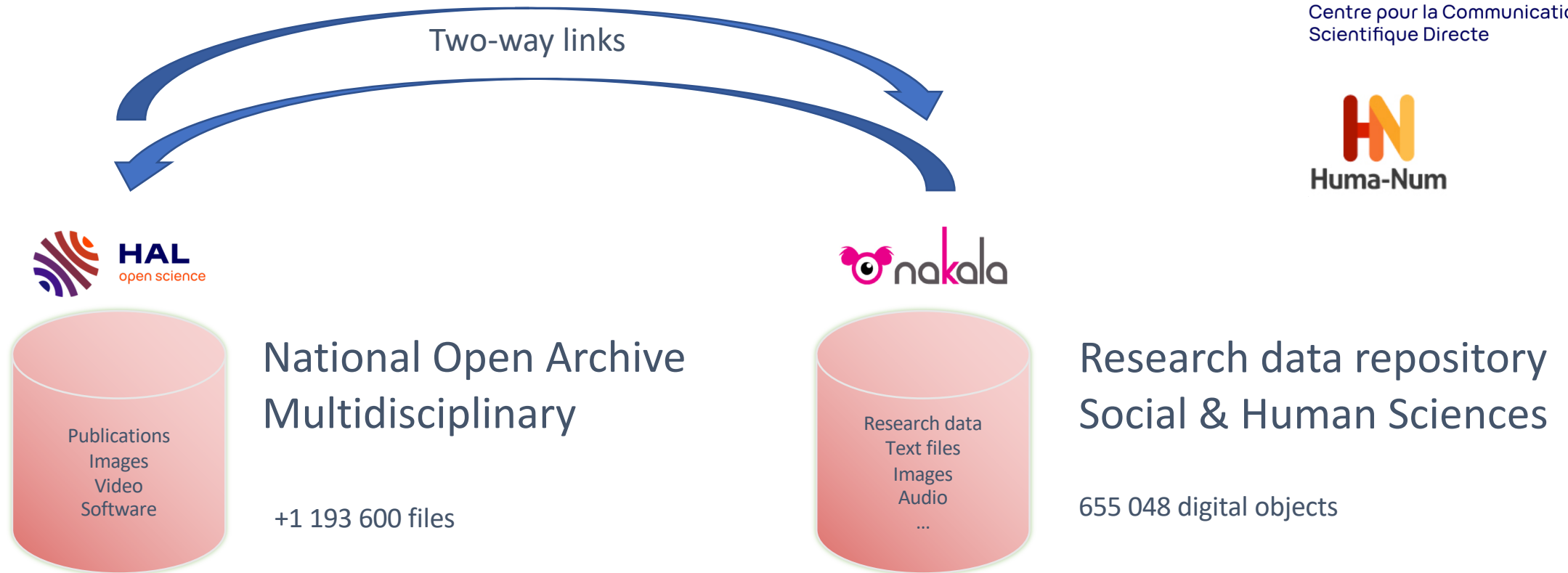

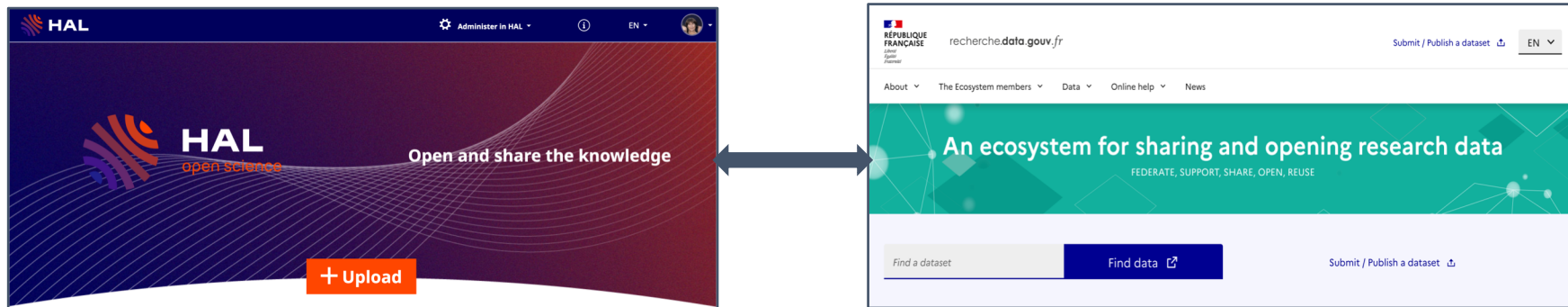

- HAL : another relationship system to integrate
- HAL => Research Data Gouv (Dataverse)



- Mercure protocol => Notify protocol (HAL / Dataverse)
- Automatic enrichments
- Deposit publications and data together in HAL then pushing data in a data repository (Nakala, RDG), and Data repository PID retrieval in HAL
