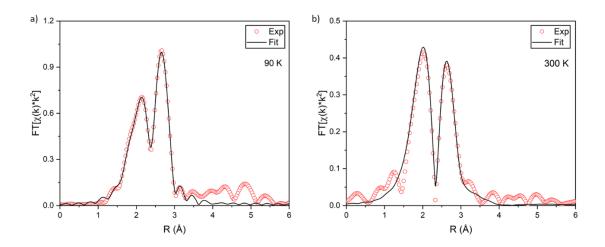

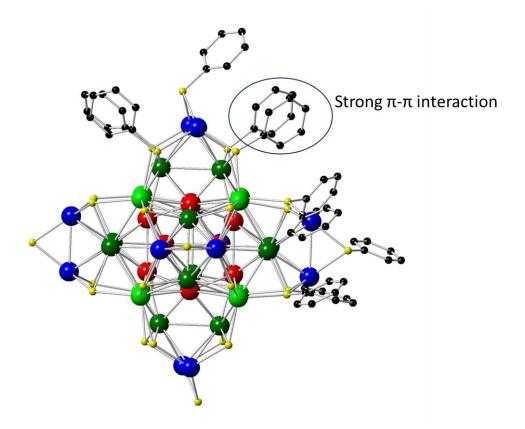


Figure S2. The structure of Ag44(SR)30 with some ligands to show the strong π - π interaction between ligands within one mount motif

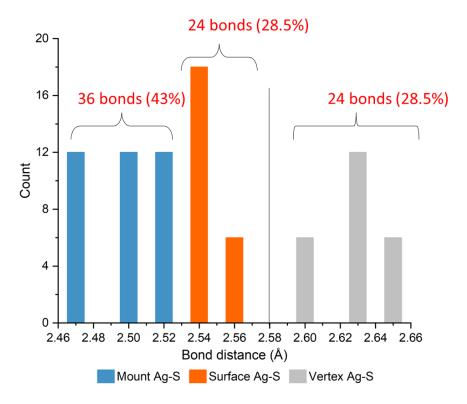


Figure S3. The bond length distribution of Ag-S bonds in $Ag_{44}(SR)_{30}$ with the percentage of each type of bonds.
