labeled ‘WT’ and the white bars ‘MDA5-KO’. The correct figure is provided below. The authors and the editorial office apologize for any inconvenience caused.

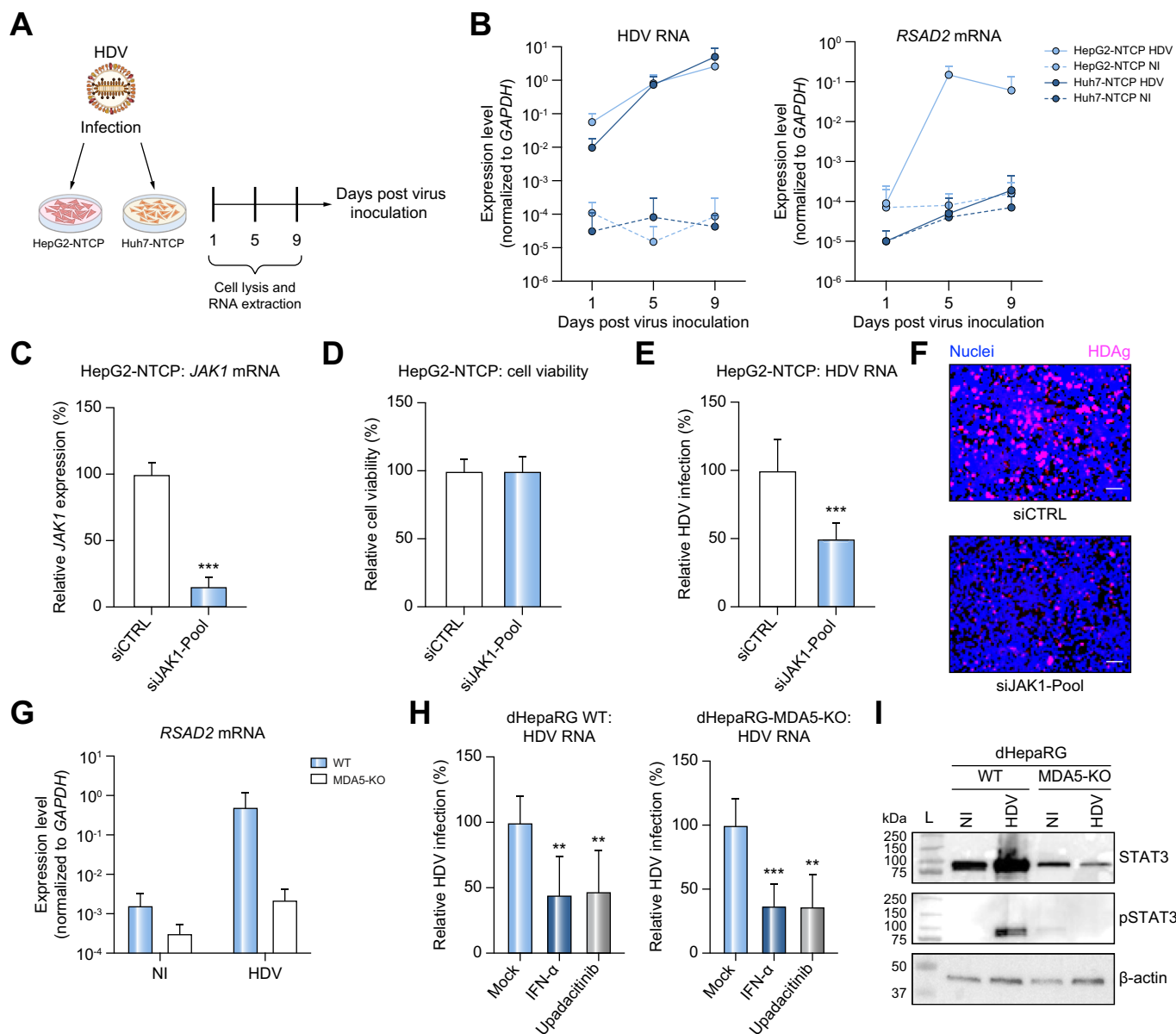
