Content: Gift of a village by Bhānudeva III, son of Narasimha II.

Language: Sanskrit (mixed prose and verse). 137 verses.

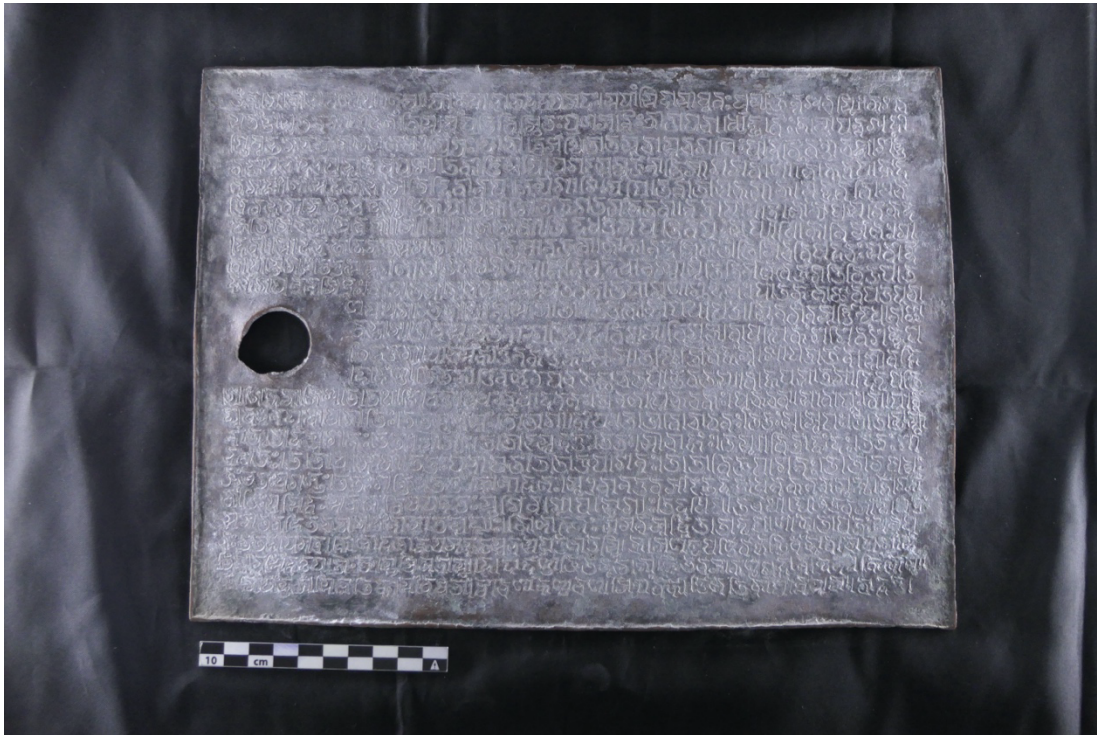


Figure 1. Kaijang Plates of Bhānudeva III, Śaka 1284: Plate 1, second side.

Dynasty: Nandodbhava.

Description: Single plate with a seal attached; landscape format.

Provenance: Talmul, Angul district.

Content: Gift of a village by Devānandadeva, son of Śivānanda, grandson of Parānanda and great-grandson of Jayānanda of the Nandodbhava family.

Language: Sanskrit (mixed prose and verse).

Number of inscribed faces: 2.

Total number of lines: 38 (recto 20, verso 18 + one line with seven *akṣaras*).

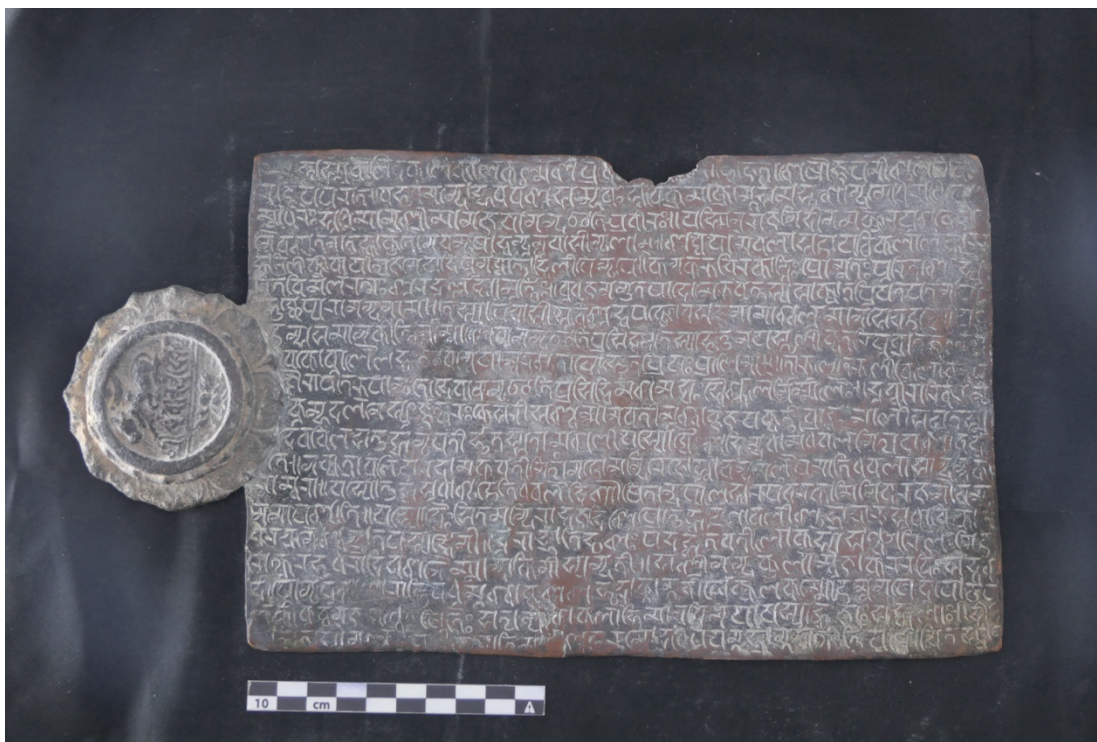


Figure 2. Talmul Copper Plate Charter of Devānandadeva, Year 152.

Dynasty: Bhañja of Khijjīṅga-Koṭṭa.

Description: One single plate with a seal attached and decorated on both sides; portrait format.

Provenance: Suhagpur, Puri district.

Content: Gift by Śrīman Narendrabhañja, son of Vibhramatuṅga and grandson of Koṭṭabhañja.

Language: Sanskrit (mixed prose and verse).

Number of inscribed faces: 2.

Total number of lines: 29 (Plate 1: recto 16/verso 13).

Identifier: DHARMA_INSSulki00001.

Dynasty: Śulki dynasty.

Description: Single plate with a broken seal attached; portrait format.

Provenance: Somewhere in the vicinity of Parjang Police Station, Dhenkanal district.

Content: Gift of a village by the reigning king Anālastambha, son of Kalahastambha and grandson of Kañcanastambha of the Śulki family.

Language: Sanskrit (mixed prose and verse).

Number of inscribed faces: 2.

Total number of lines: 36 (Plate 1: recto 17/verso 19).

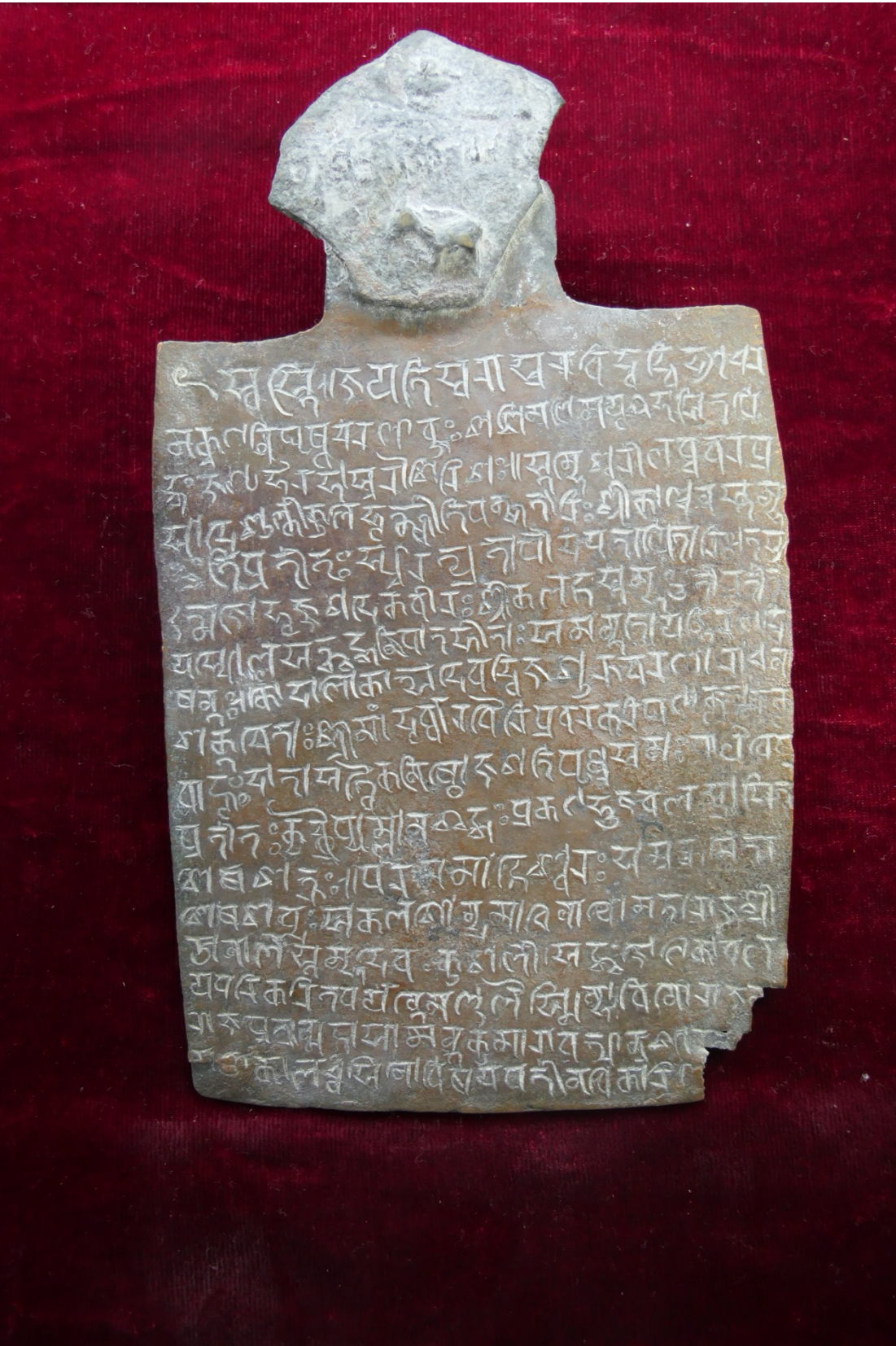


Figure 8. A Copper Plate Charter of Anālastambha.

Description: Set of three plates with a seal and a cut and twisted ring; landscape format.

Provenance: Aṅgapaḍā, Kishorenagar Police Station, Āṭhamallik subdivision, Angul district.

Content: Gift of a village to a brahmin by Raṅabhañja, son of Śatrubhañja and grandson of Śilābhañjadeva of the Bhañja family.

Language: Sanskrit (mixed prose and verse).

Number of inscribed faces: 2.
