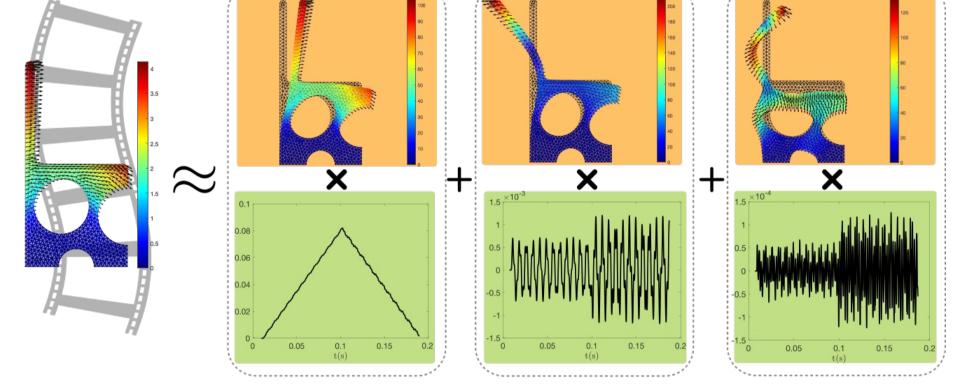

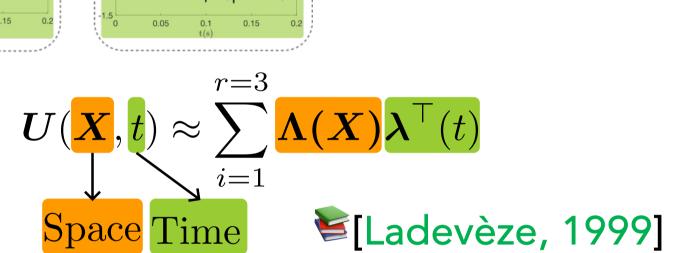

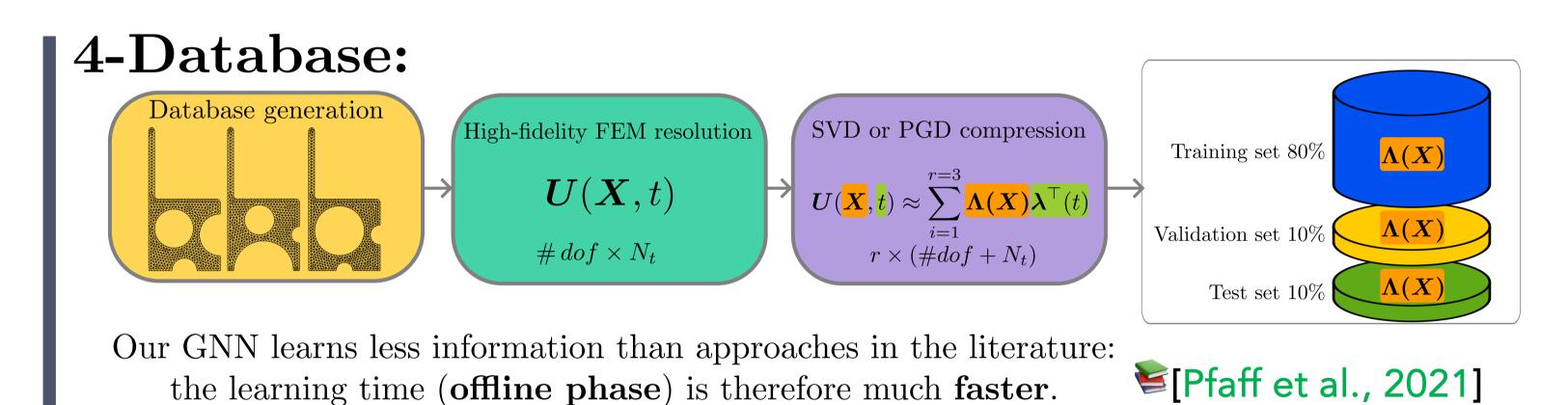
1-Loading case: Acceleration (g) $\mathbf{\tilde{U}}(t) + \mathbf{K}\mathbf{U}(t) = \mathbf{M}\mathbf{\Gamma}_{\mathrm{inertie}}(t) + \mathbf{F}_{\mathrm{ext}}(t)$ $\mathbf{X} \in \Omega, t \in]0, T]$ $\tau = 180 \text{ ms}$ $\boldsymbol{U}(t) = 0$ $\boldsymbol{X} \in \Gamma, t \in]0, T]$ $\boldsymbol{U}(0) = \dot{\boldsymbol{U}}(0) = 0$ $\boldsymbol{X} \in \Omega, t = 0$ Acceleration profile for aircraft seat design. $\boldsymbol{F}_{\mathrm{ext}}\left(t\right)$ equivalent to stopping a TGV Load induced by a 90-kg at full speed in 2s! passenger.

2-The Proper Generalized Decomposition (PGD):

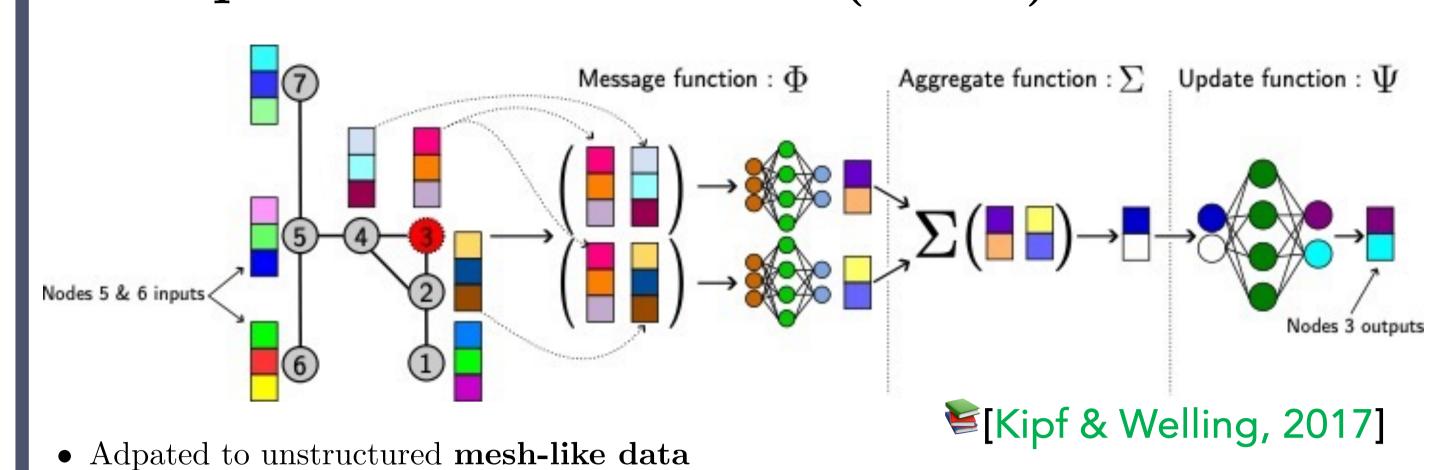


- Variable separation adapted to the industrial problem
- A priori method (no database required)
- Solves the equation from **physics**





3-Graph Neural Networks (GNN):



- Does not depend on the number of nodes and edges in the input graph, only in the number of input features (through permutation-invariant aggregate function)
- High flexibility and generalisability

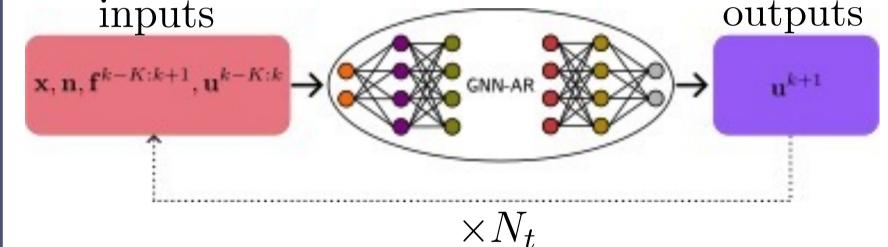
Developed spatial convolution layer:

node i embedding: $\mathbf{v}_i^0 = \text{MLP}_{\text{encoder}}(\mathbf{F}_i, \mathbf{n}_i)$,

edge $j \to i$ message: $\mathbf{m}_{ij}^l = \phi\left(\mathbf{v}_i^l, \mathbf{v}_j^l, \mathbf{F}_i, \mathbf{F}_j, \mathbf{n}_i, \mathbf{n}_j\right),$ [Huang et al., 2018] node i update: $\mathbf{v}_i^{l+1} = \psi\left(\mathbf{v}_i^l, \sum_{j \in \mathcal{N}(i)} \mathbf{m}_{ij}^l, \mathbf{F}_i, \mathbf{n}_i\right),$

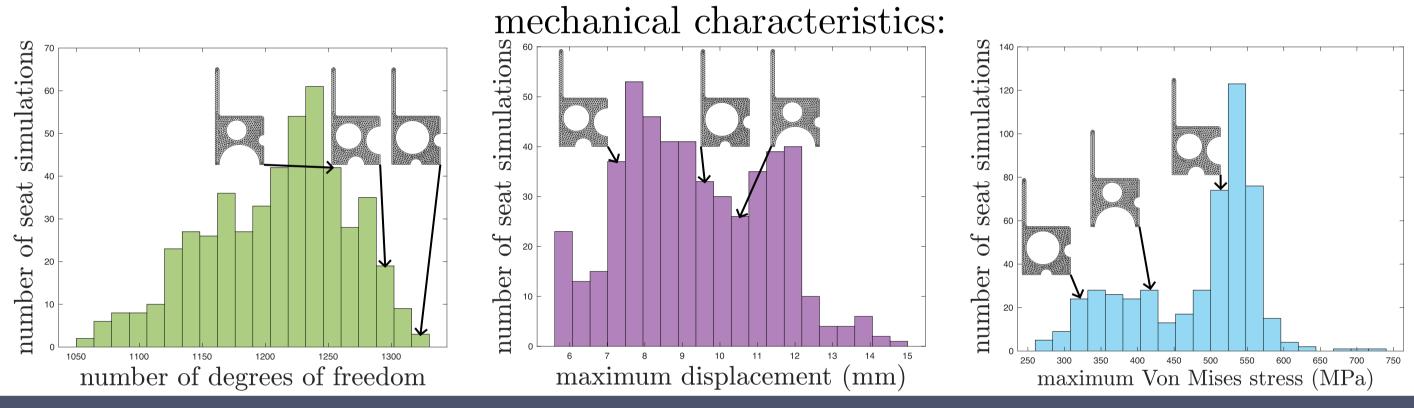
node i final state: $\Lambda_i^{GNN} = \text{MLP}_{\text{decoder}}(\mathbf{v}_i^L)$ [Brandstetter, 2022]

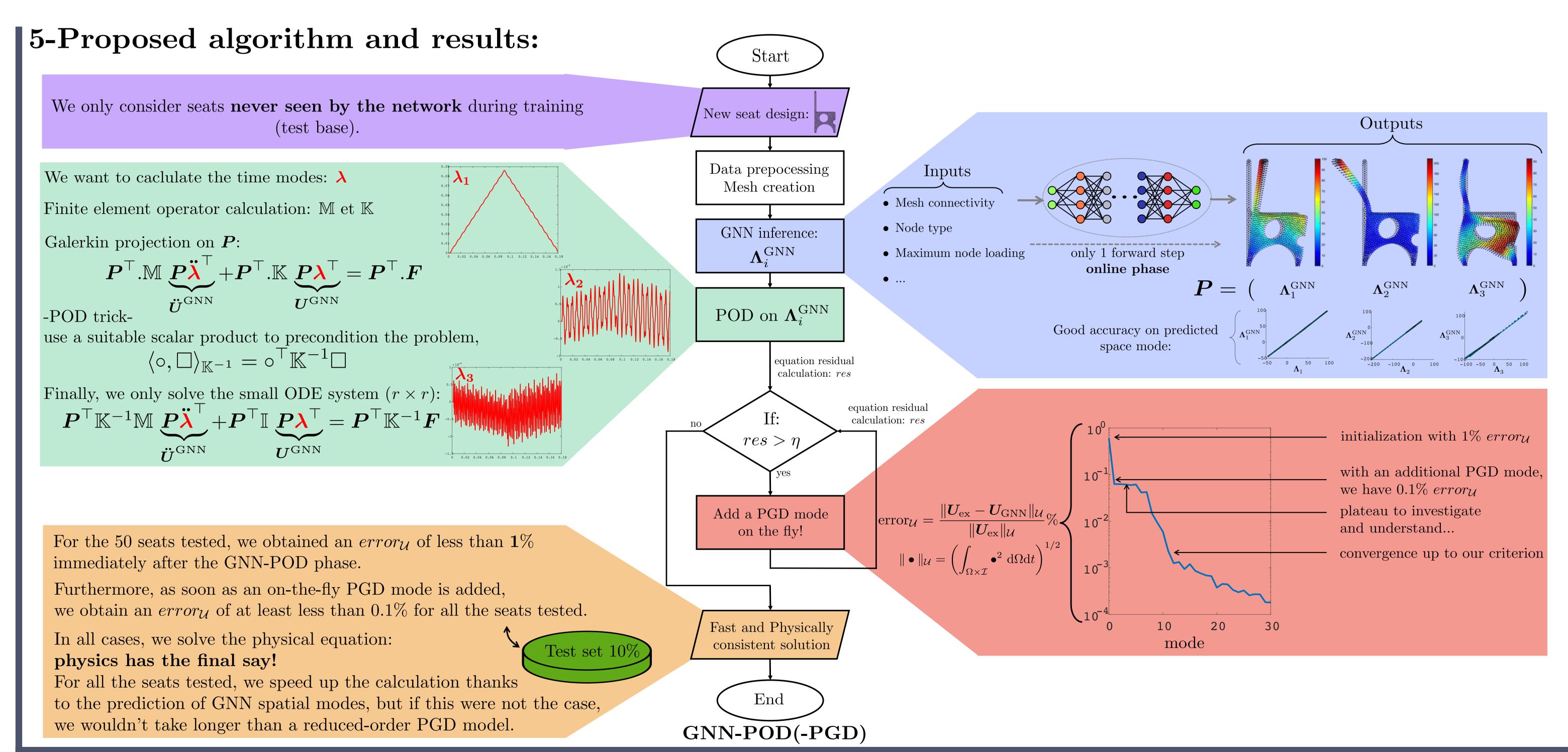
Popular approach in the literature: [Pfaff et al., 2021]



- Autoregressive approach
- Inference time proportional to number of time steps N_t
- Error increases during simulation
