
eScriptorium

- must support multilingualism





points of discussion

- it's not 100% robust against obsolescence & may have blind spots
 - so is it trustworthy?
 - yes, thanks to transparency and openness to collaborations
- multilingualism has yet to be achieved
- it's possible to contribute to open source software dev. with documentation
- a documentation increases accessibility and can create a broader audience
- the collaborative nature of the documentation can attract new contributors

CONCLUSION

- it's possible to contribute to open source software with something else than code
- we shared our vision of an efficient collaborative documentation project
- we'd be happy to find volunteers to make it multilingual!
