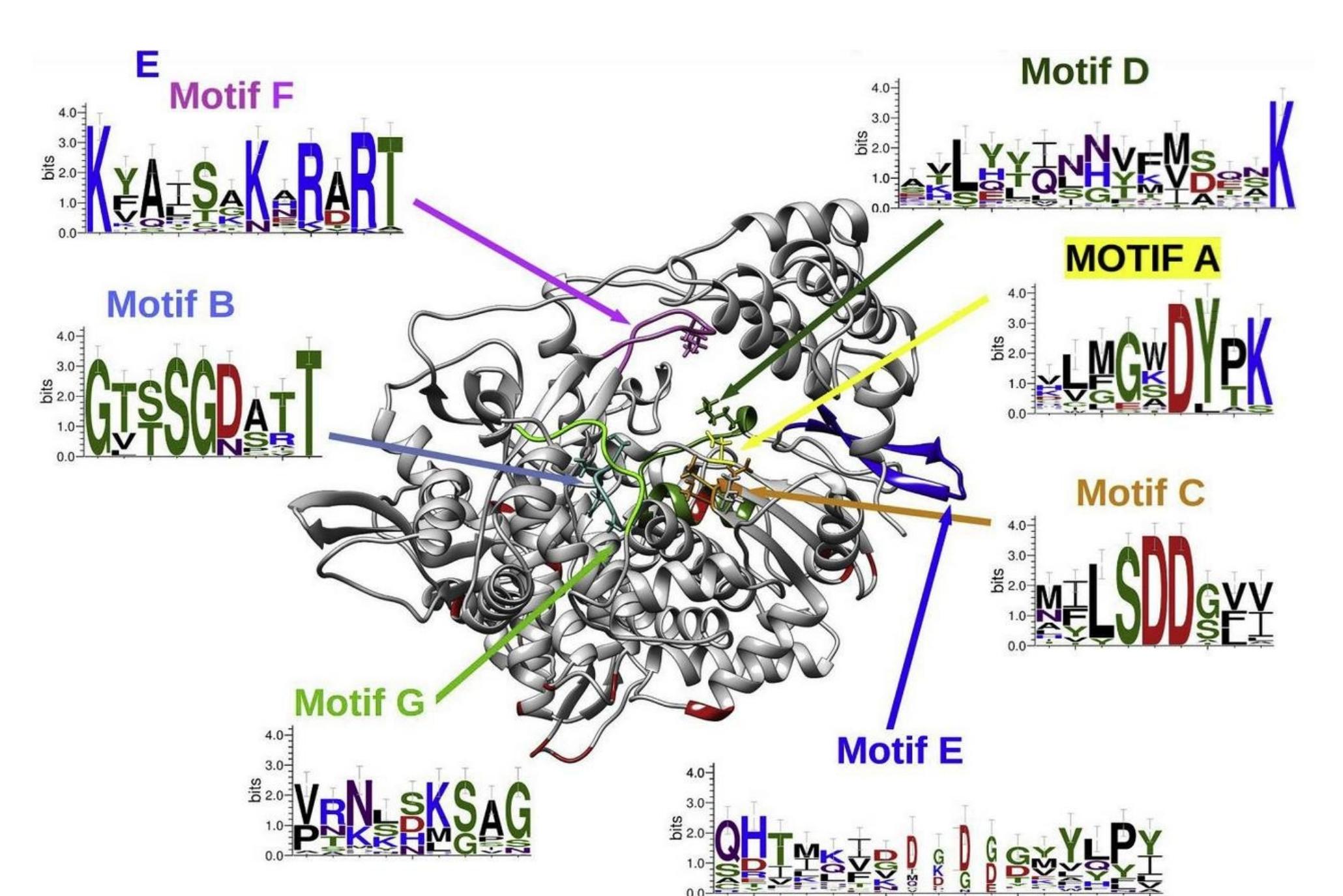
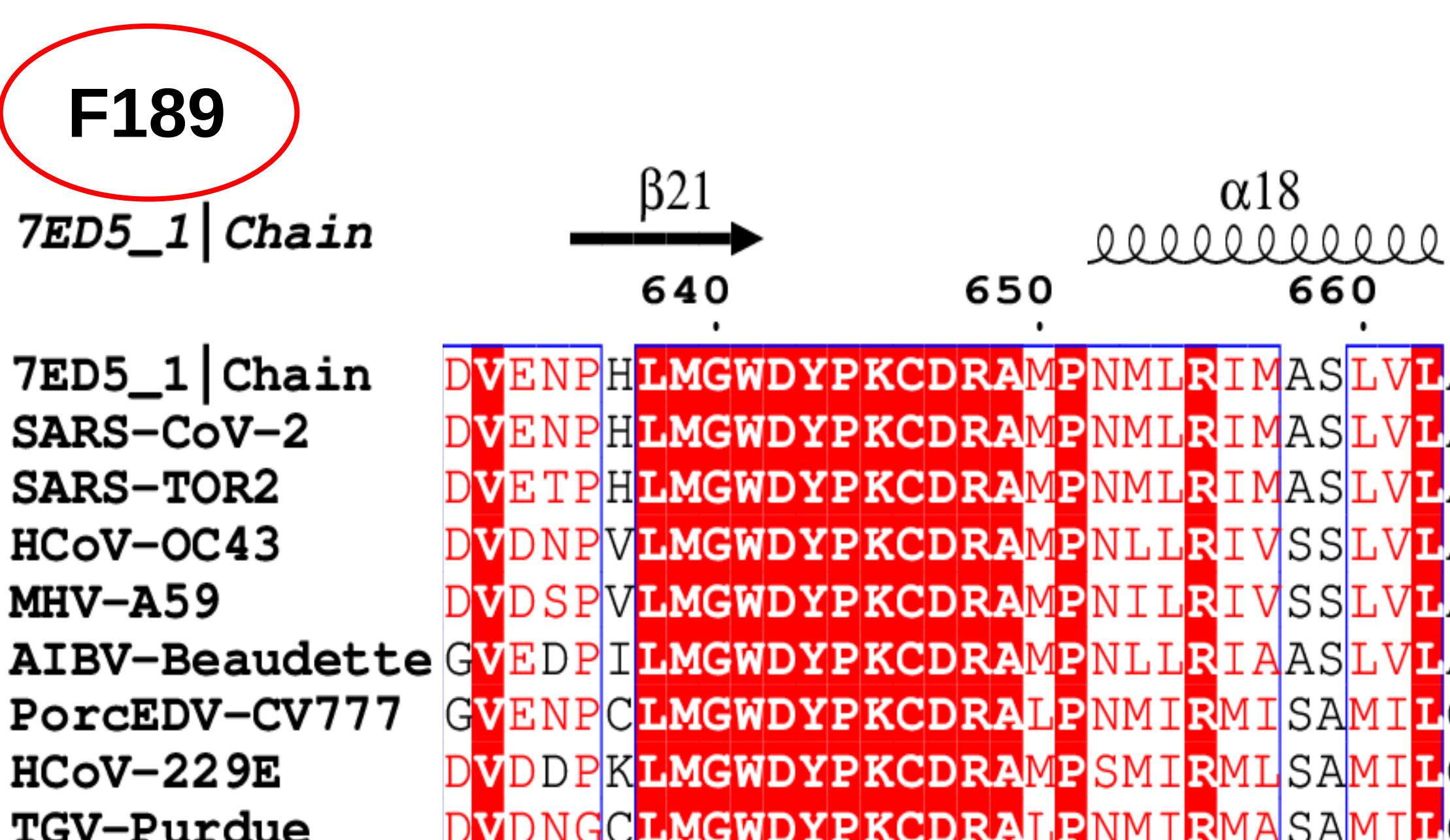
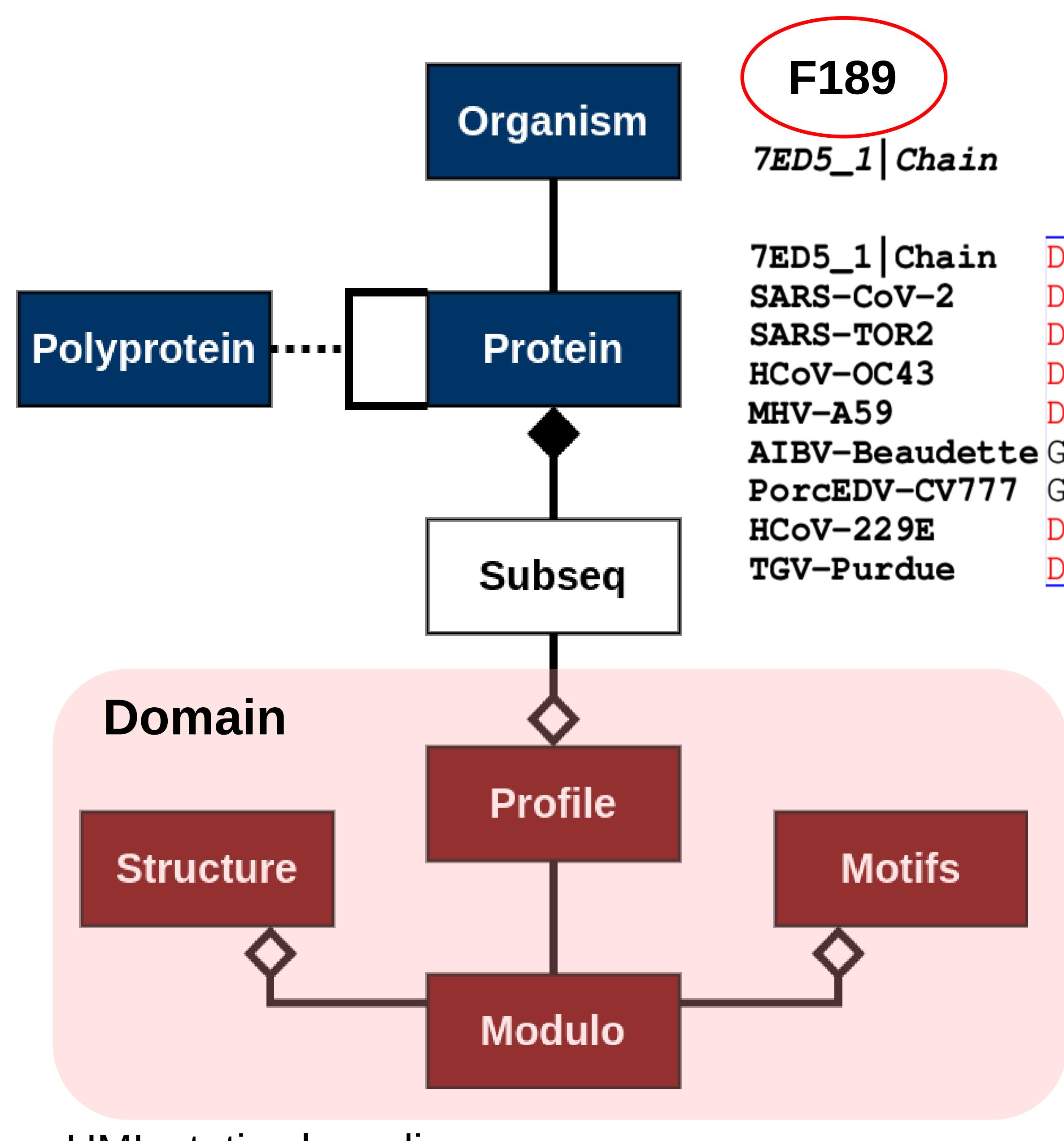
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Abstract

Objectives

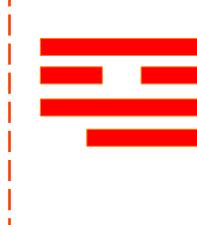
- Curated database
 - starting point previous VAZyMolo and leader of other families.
 - annotating protein into modules.
 - merging Phylogeny and Functional Annotation.
- Web-service
 - Search
 - user through a protein sequence or keywords (GO / EC).
 - detecting the closest well-known virus orthologue.
 - transferring the orthologue annotation on the query's sequence.

Methods

Routine analytic pipeline

 Motif Search
Gathered from literature or Structure Analysis
Example: Motif A → "T-G-D-N"
→ Pattern search (regex)

 Sequence Alignment
Using pair-wise alignment "hit and run"
→ Clustering with MMseqs2

 Profile Alignment
Depending on two previous output
Against the profile of 'each' domain
→ Aligning with Muscle

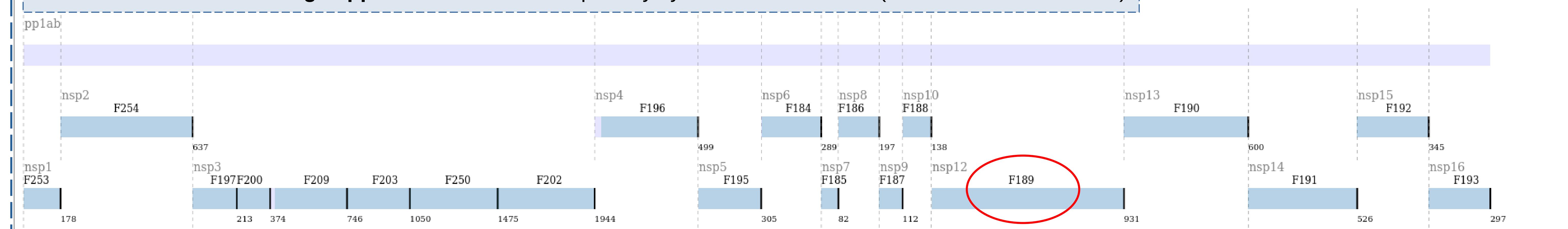
Internal analytic pipeline

Internal usage to characterize :

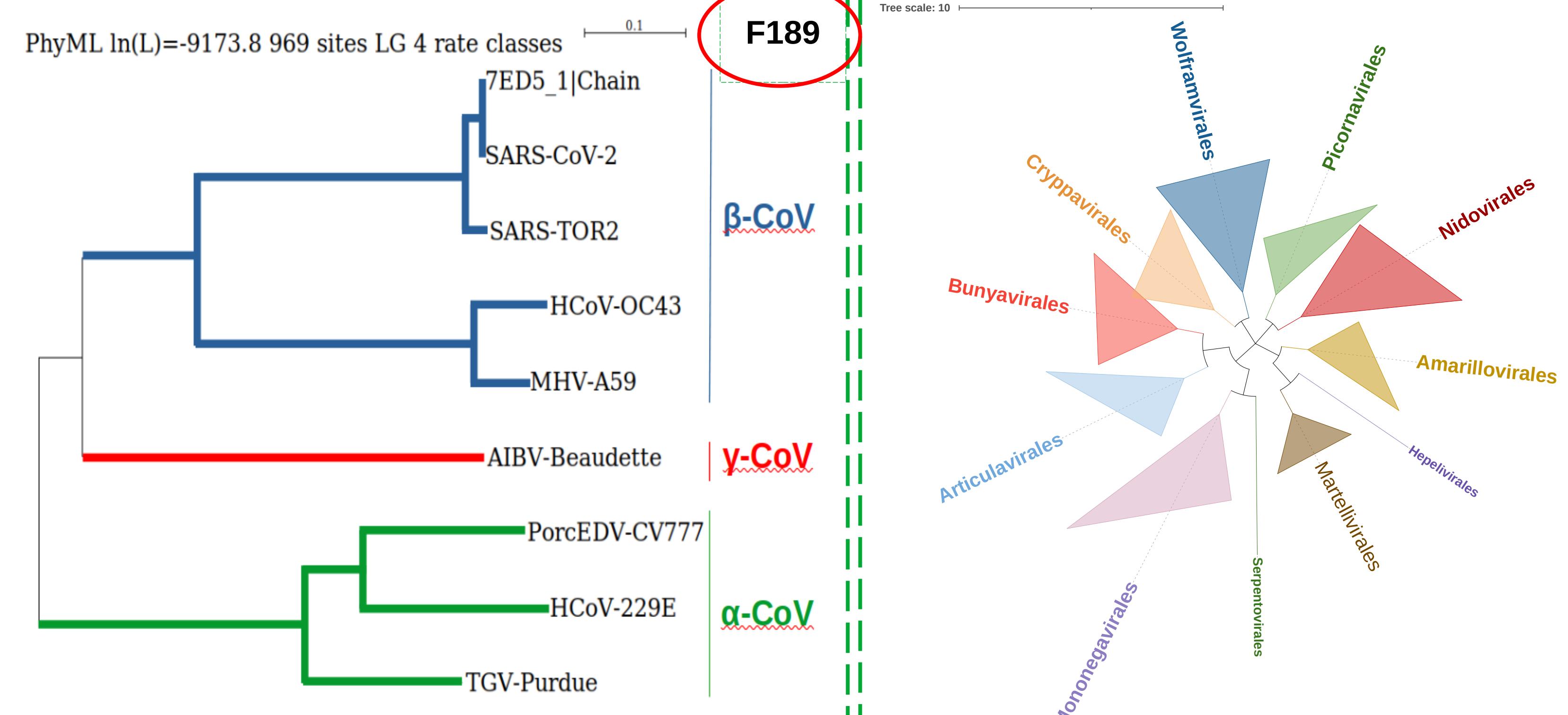
- structure determination
