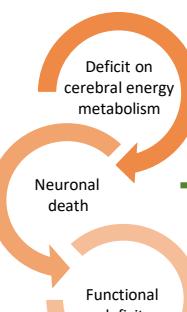
## Neonatal hypoxia-ischemia (NHI)

- 4 million newborns per year, worldwide
- 15-20% of deaths during the perinatal period
- 25% motor and cognitive deficits



- ↓ Brain blood perfusion
- ↓ O<sub>2</sub> and glucose deprivation

Absence of pharmacological solutions



## Resveratrol

### maternal supplementation

- ↓ Brain lesion volume
- ↓ lesion severity
- Preservation of sensory motor and cognitive functions

Evaluate effect of a vegetal extract (VE) rich in highly bioavailable polyphenols

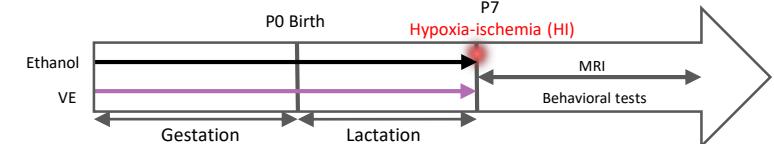


↗ Synergy + ↗ Bioavailability = Neuroprotection ?

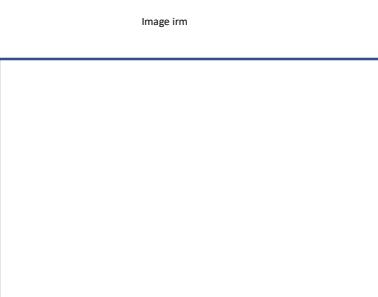
Transgenerational, nutritional neuroprotective approach through maternal supplementation with EV



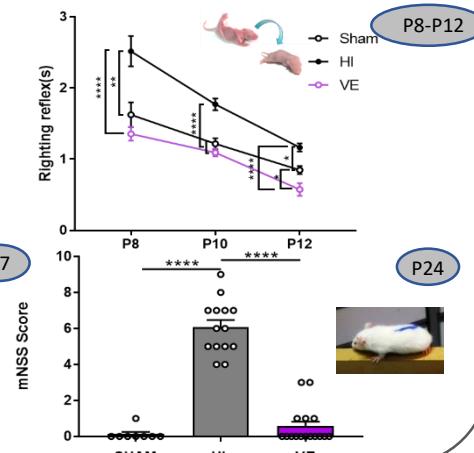
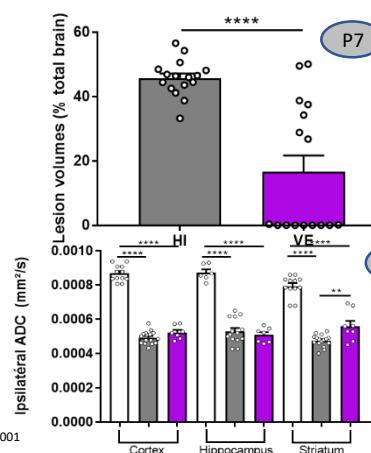

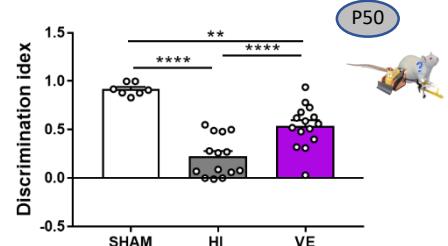
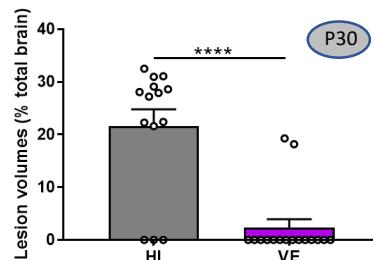
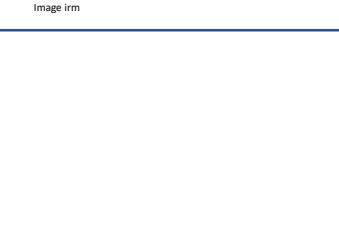
## Short-term effect of maternal supplementation with VE



ADC : apparent diffusion coefficient  
 mNSS : modified neurologic severity score  
 AnovaFisher's LSD \* p < 0,05 ; \*\* p < 0,01 ; \*\*\* p < 0,001 ; \*\*\*\* p < 0,0001



## Long-term effect of maternal supplementation with VE



AnovaFisher's LSD \*\* p < 0,01 ; \*\*\*\* p < 0,0001

Maternal supplementation with VE lead to short and long-term neuroprotection effects (cortex, hippocampus, striatum) in the context of neonatal HI

Better Bioavailability + Synergic effect → Better neuroprotection

Perspective : development of a food supplement, targeting premenstrual woman, to prevent the deleterious effects of neonatal HI
