#### Introduction

### Motivation

- X Need to regularly test new functionalities on CAV and set up pre-certification process, including test phases.
- Two Type of *scenario-based reduction* [1]:
  - X Testing-based processing: Sampling approach
  - Falsification-based process: Find critical scenario

### **Objectif and Innovative**

- X This paper develops a testing-based process implemented with a preliminary computation of criticality indicators. The main focus lies in the introduction of the experimental protocol to select the functional scenarios to evaluate. Especially, a sampling guided by precomputed criticially levels is used to design the experimental plan
- X We get interested in a scenario-based developped in former works [1]. The current work add two supplementary steps to design the experimental plan:
- X Step 5: Clustering of S<sub>f</sub> by semantic similarity and criticality differences
- Step 6: Cluster space reduction in terms of Sf criticality and attributes coverages
