Platform dedicated to organisers of **conferences**, workshops or scientific meetings



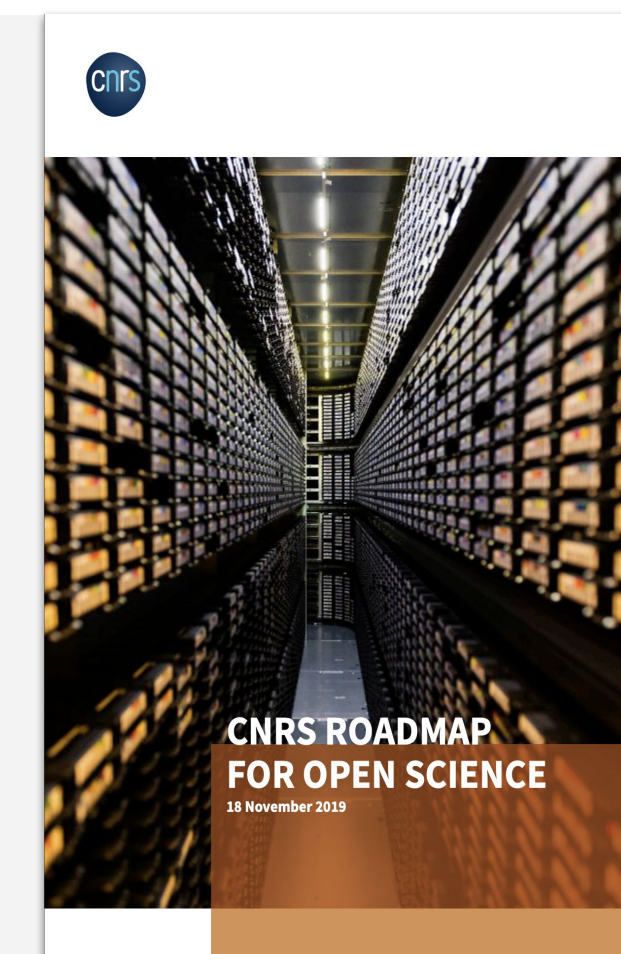

Action 1: Conduct a policy of support and development of the open HAL archive in conjunction with a policy of encouraging the deposit of scholarly publications

...Therefore, **the CNRS requires that all scholarly publications resulting from research funded mainly by public funds**, and which can be deposited in open archives on the basis of the Digital Republic Act **should be accessible in HAL**



Aix-Marseille Université recommends that its teaching and research staff make the publications resulting from their research work accessible to as many people as possible by **depositing them in the university's open archive HAL AMU** as soon as they are published.



The ANR asks to deposit full text of the scientific publications (version Author Accepted Manuscript or Version of Record) **in the national open archive HAL**, and mention the ANR research project reference

Why PIDs adoption is important ?

Simplify and leverage self archiving.

Avoid duplicates and preserve data quality and reliability.

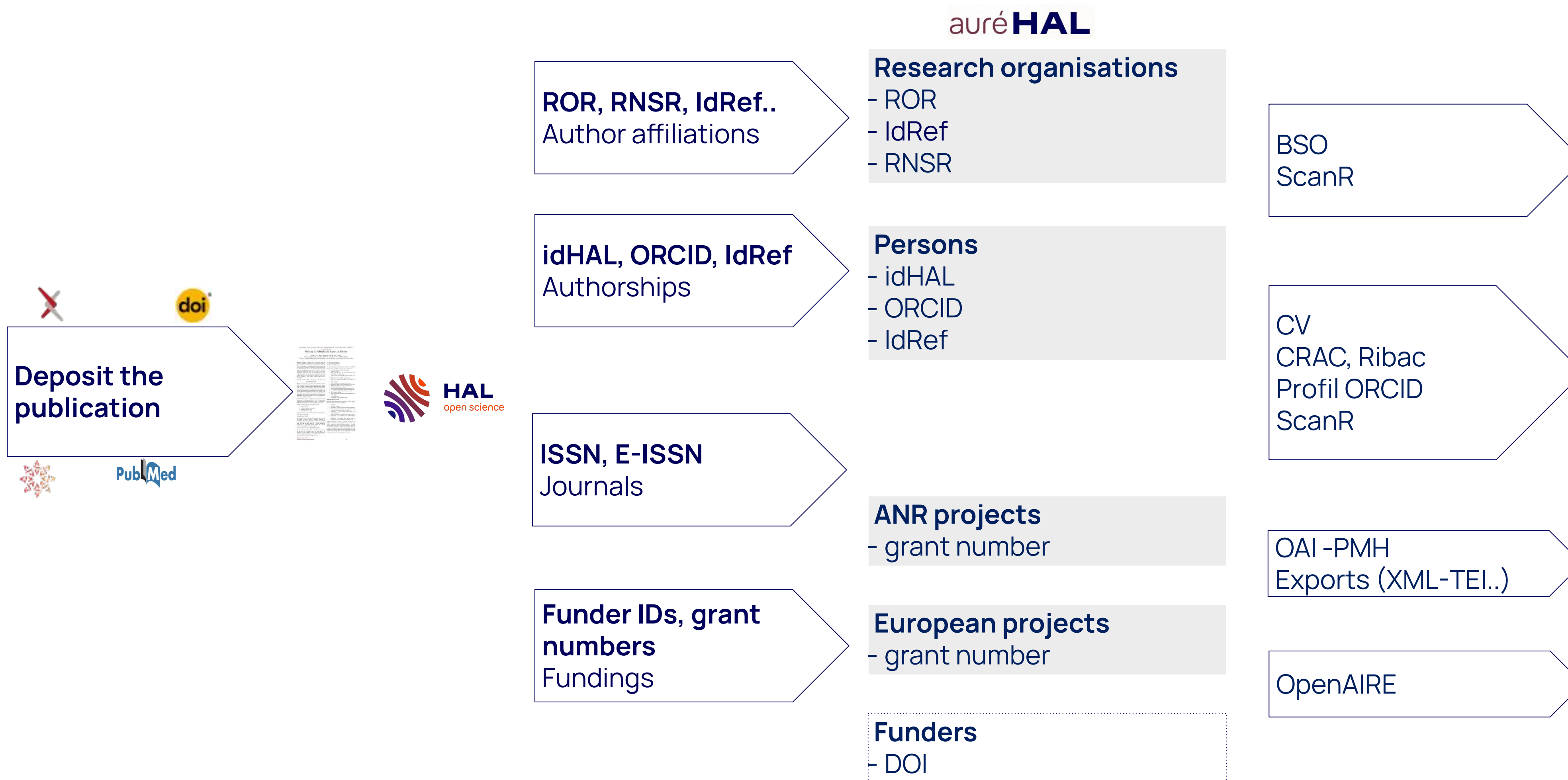
Make the entities discoverable and support the curation process.

Build tools for research outputs monitoring.

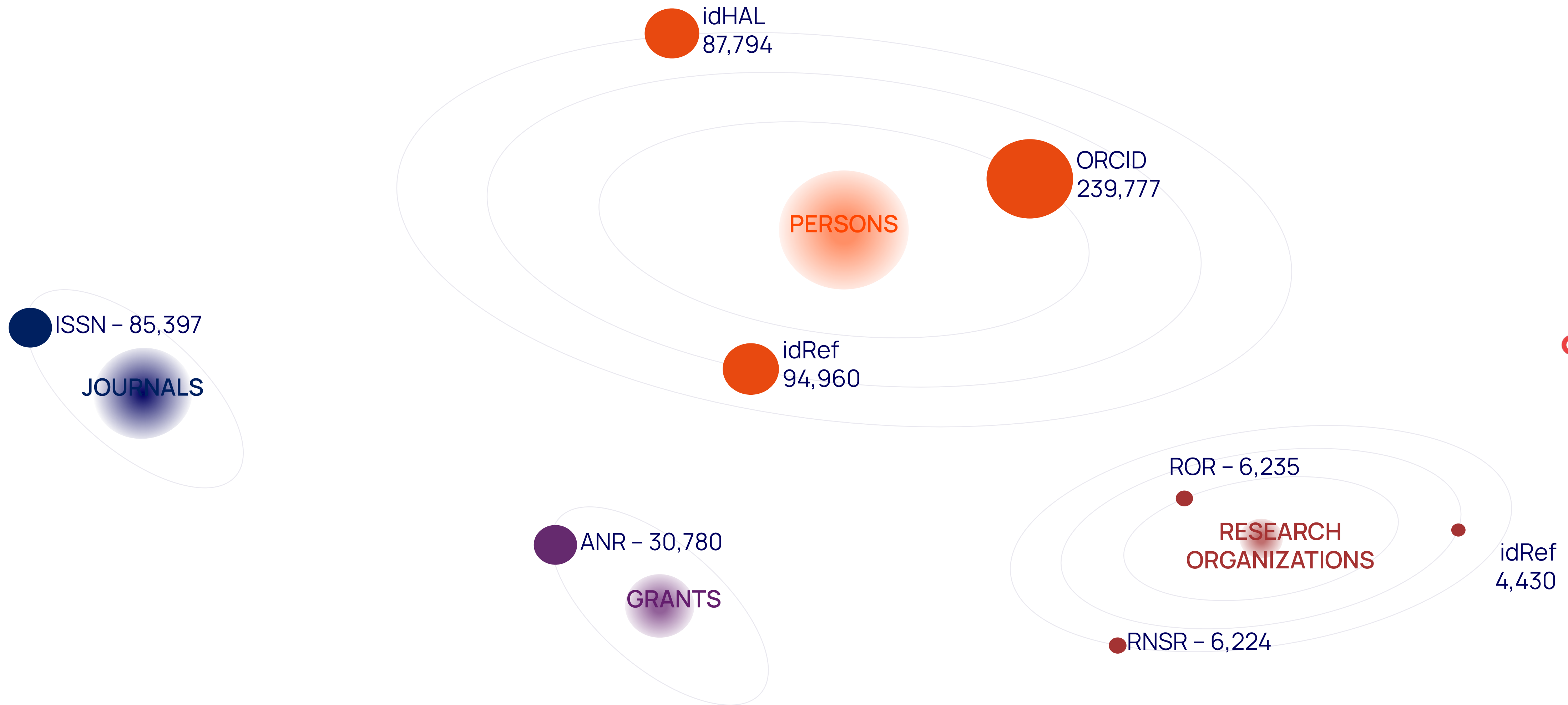
Track changes and enrich the metadata.

Help moderators when verifying the compliance of the deposits.
