Introduction to Codabench

Codabench [1] is an open-source web platform that aims toward reproducible research and benchmarking.

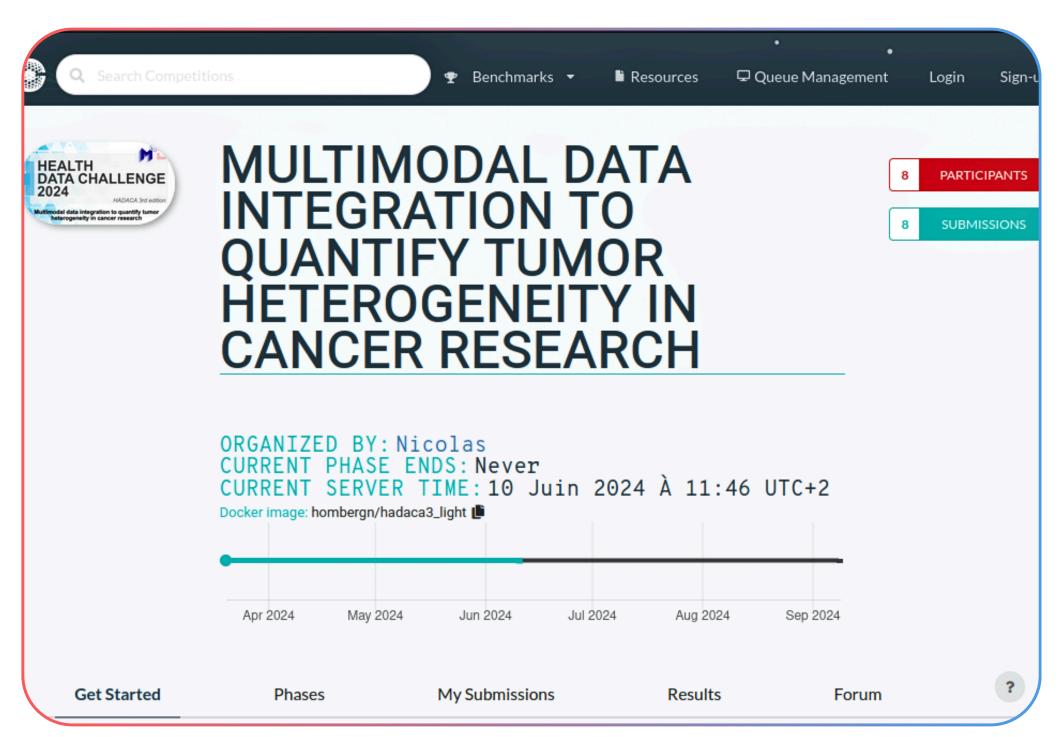
It represents the upgraded iteration of the competition platform **CodaLab.** Alongside EvalAI, Alcrowd, and Kaggle, CodaLab stands out as one of the leading platforms for academic competitions today [2].

Codabench @LISN & Paris-saclay

- 4 computing servers, 4 storage servers and backup servers (main instance)
- 3 dozens of virtual machines (compute workers and preproduction)

Codabench @UGA & Gricad

• Custom-sized, temporary, and local Codabench instances (compute workers and pre-production)



The beautiful and user-friendly Codabench interface.

Features:

- Create a challenge from
 - o a graphical User Interface
 - o a zip bundle and a yaml recipe
- Submit a result or a function
- Rank submission in a leader board
- Set opening and ending dates
- Set different phases
 - with several tasks per phases
- Create and manage queues for
 - GPU workers
 - CPU workers

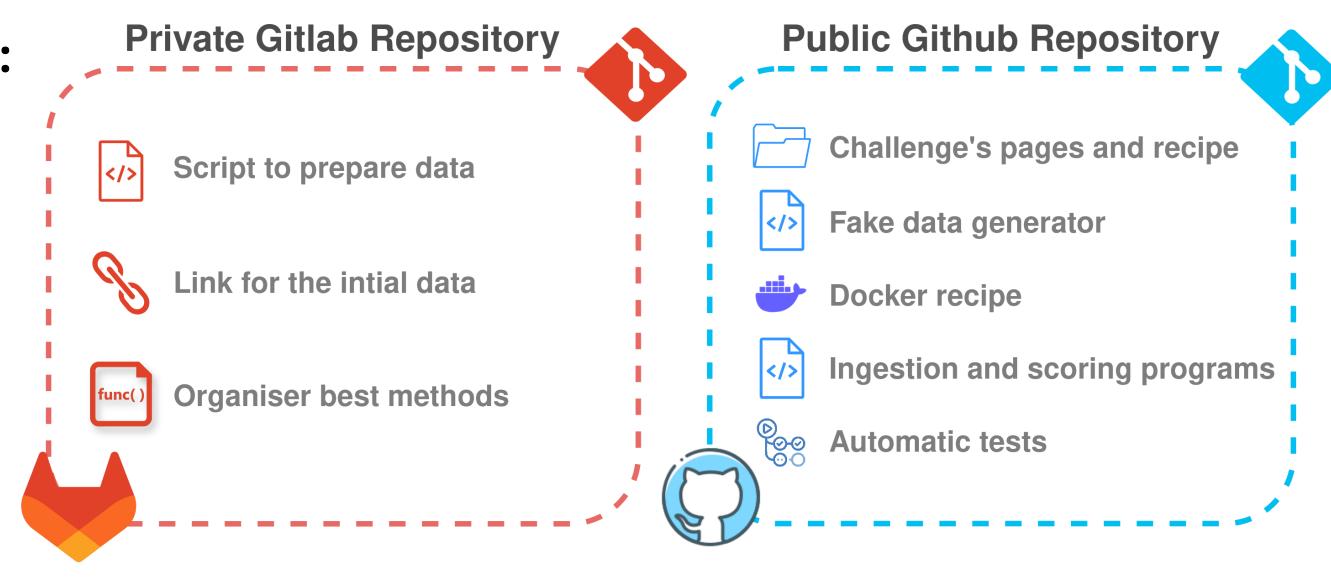
Challenge Organizationnal Template

Our organizational template relies on a bipartite git repositories devoid of binary files: zip, data files...

This organization follows the Agile software development practices and guarantees ease of reproducibility and maintenance.

The private Gitlab repository:

- Ensure fairness and confidentiality
- The recipe to prepare, clean and create target datasets
- Organiser best methods including easier methods to use as baseline methods.



This template enhances teamwork by Facilitating task distribution and using GitHub Issues to track problems and desired features.

The public GitHub repository:

- Ensure reproducibility and fairness
- Create the challenge zip bundle
 - Challenge materials
 - Starting kit with **multiples baselines**
 - Ingestion and scoring programs
- Manage challenge's datasets
 - Simulate a fake dataset
 - Fetch target dataset
- Automatic tests of submissions to guarantee the challenge's health
 - Every push via GitHub Actions
 - Locally on the docker container

Third Health Data Challenge-hadaca3: 2-6 Dec 24

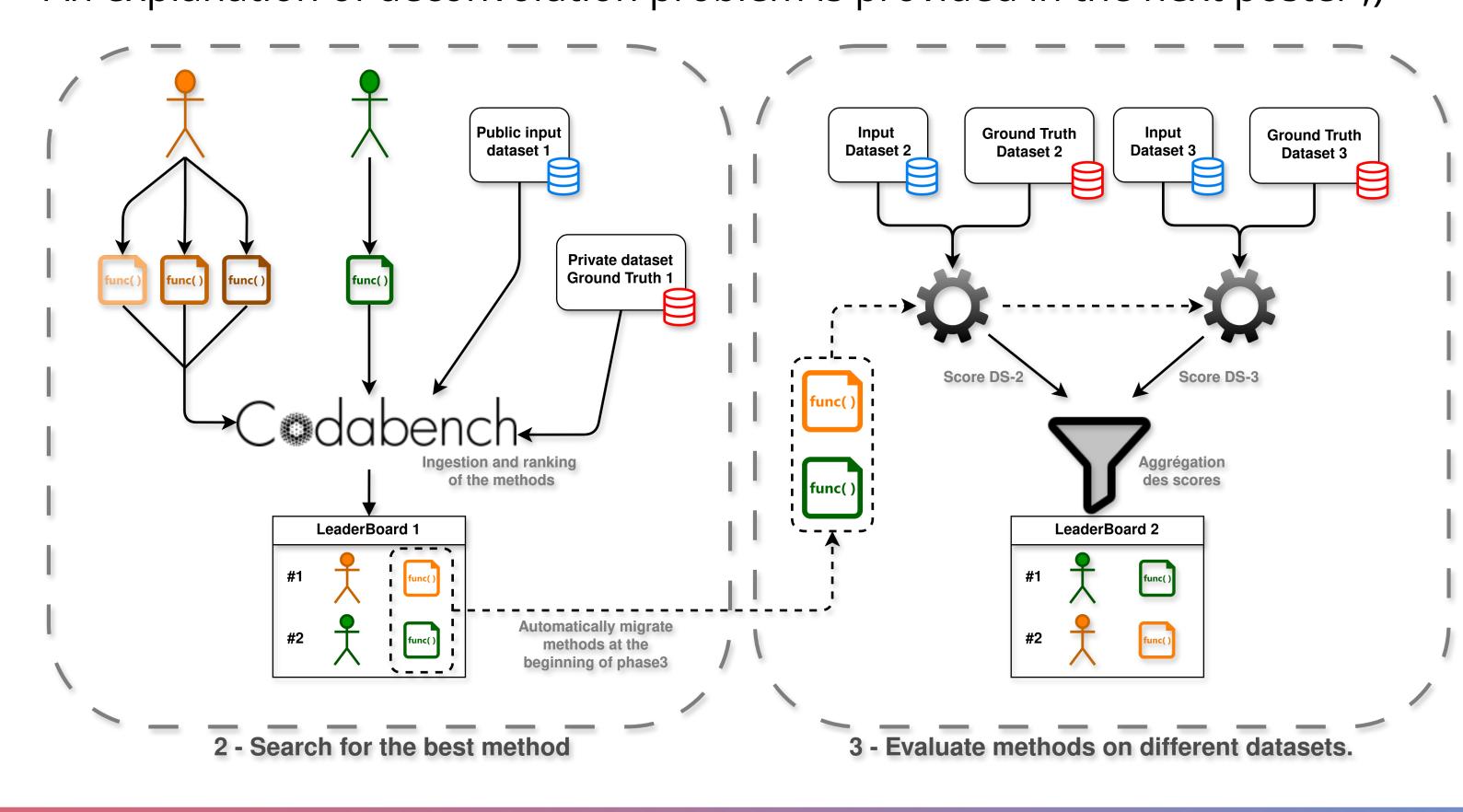
Hadaca 3 Program:

Phase 1:

Toy deconvolution challenge to test the Codabench framework and familiarize with the platform and dataset.

Phase 2:

Estimation of cell type
heterogeneity from pancreatic
adenocarcinoma matching bulk
methylomes and transcriptomes
using multimodal references
profiles, for five different cell types



Phase 3:

Auto-migration from phase 2 best methods and evalution on previously unseen validation dataset.

Post challenge:

Aggregate the data, further trial the methods, and publish the results in collaboration with the challenge participants.
