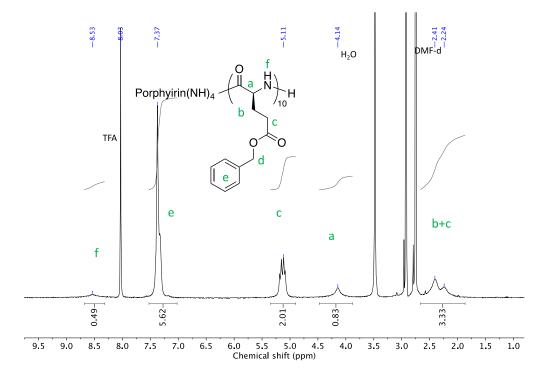


Figure S1. ¹H-NMR of star-like PBLG initiated with porphyrin targeting a DP = 10 in DMFd (**polymer 1**).

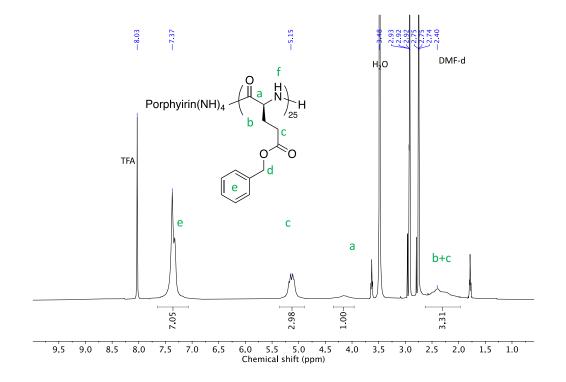


Figure S2. ¹H-NMR of star-like PBLG initiated with porphyrin targeting a DP = 25 in DMF-d (**polymer 2**).

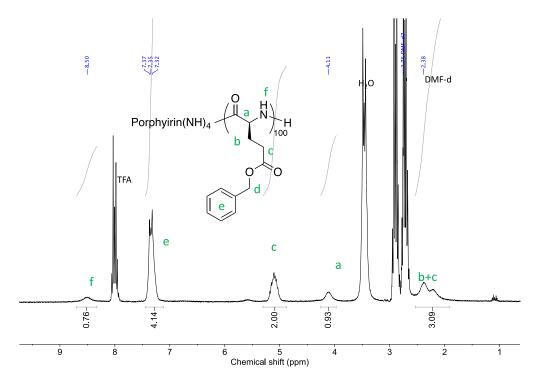


Figure S3. ¹H-NMR of star-like PBLG initiated with porphyrin targeting a DP = 100 in DMF-d (**polymer 3**).

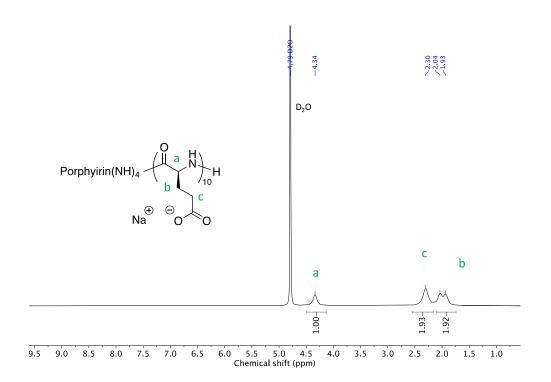

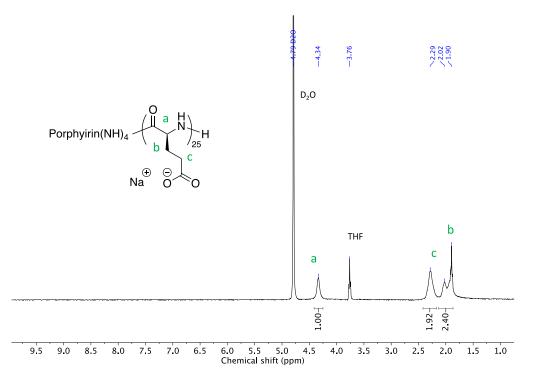

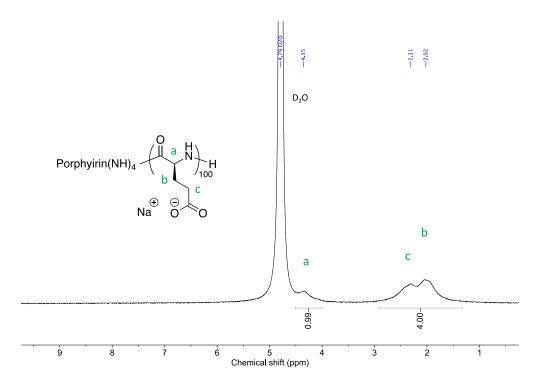

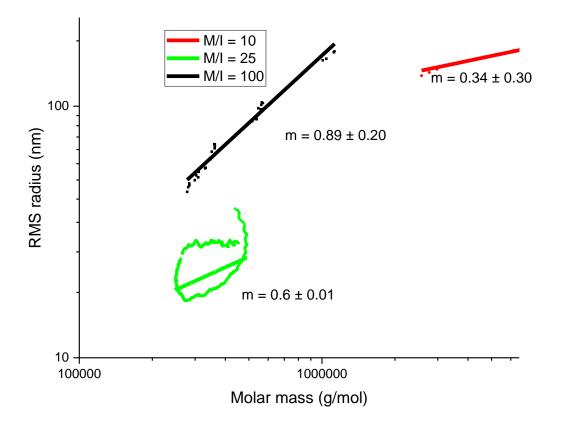

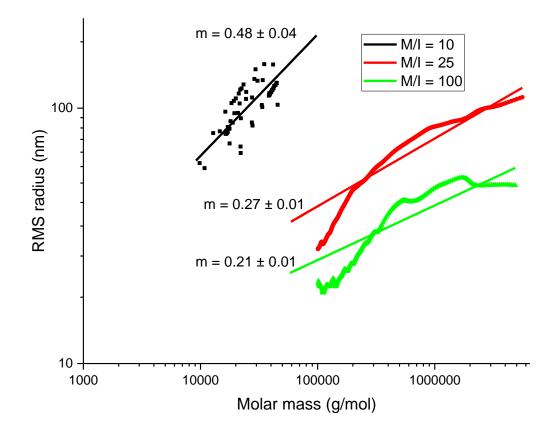

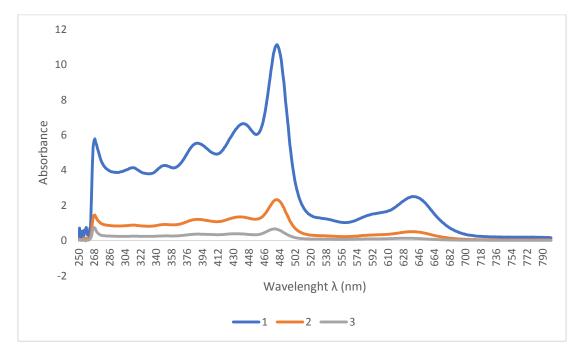


Figure S9. UV-vis spectra of star-like protected conjugates 1, 2 and 3 in DMF

A solution of Mn-TAPP was prepared at 1×10^{-5} M in DMF and was analyzed by UV-vis. The molar attenuation coefficient (ϵ) of Mn-TAPP was calculated using the Beer-Lambert law giving ϵ =90000. Solutions of 1 mg/mL of polymers 1, 2 or 3 in DMF were prepared and were analyzed by UV-vis (figure SX) in the same condition as Mn-TAPP. The concentration of porphyrin in the solution of polymers was calculated using ϵ of Mn-TAPP and the Beer-Lambert law. Results for all polymers were listed in Table S1.

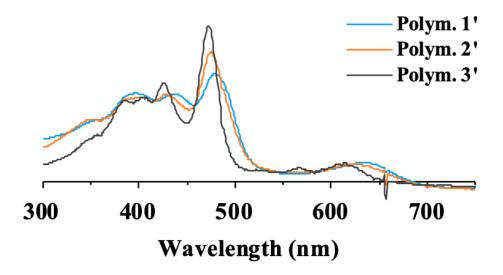

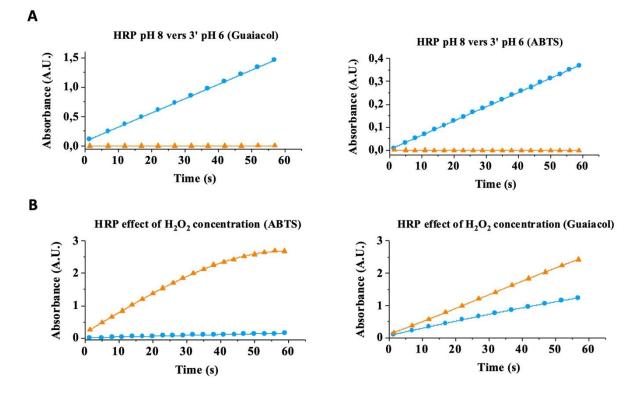

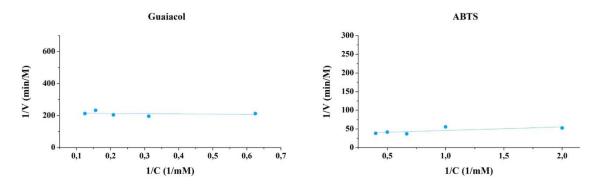

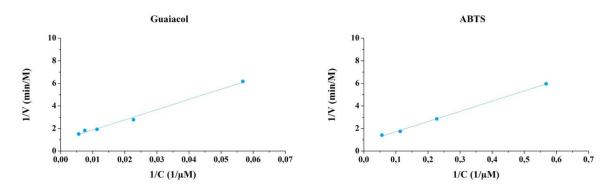


Figure S13. Lineweaver-Burk plot of the H_2O_2 mediated oxidation of guaiacol or ABTS using HRP.

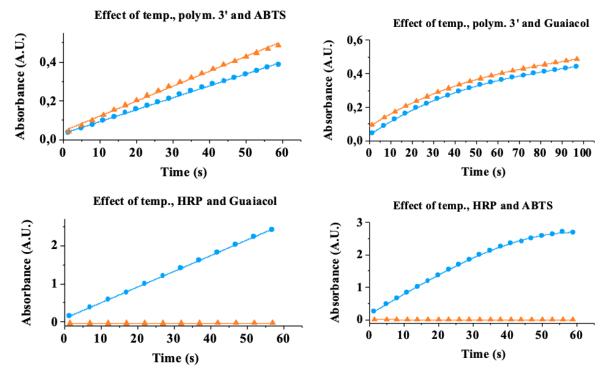
