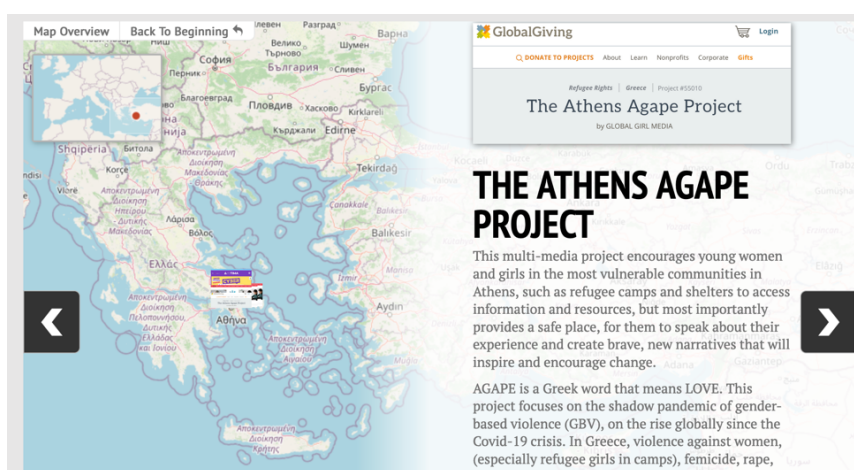

The map overview is local and global allowing to find projects within a European cartography. This cartography will be updated regularly and enriched as the GenderEd Coalition expands its networks over the next two years. As of June 28<sup>th</sup>, the ten selected projects of France and Greece for the National reporting (D2.1 due July 30<sup>th</sup>) have already been integrated.



**Functionalities:** In order to extract various information from the reports concerning all of the selected projects (actors / location ; major project's goals ; networks...) The GenderEd Coalition project picked a free mapping tool (<https://storymap.knightlab.com/>) to describe those projects on the web by highlighting the location and some of the main project's features. It is a new, dynamic tool.

This story mapping allows to add a slide for each project location and description. Some visuals allow to identify the project in the

map.
