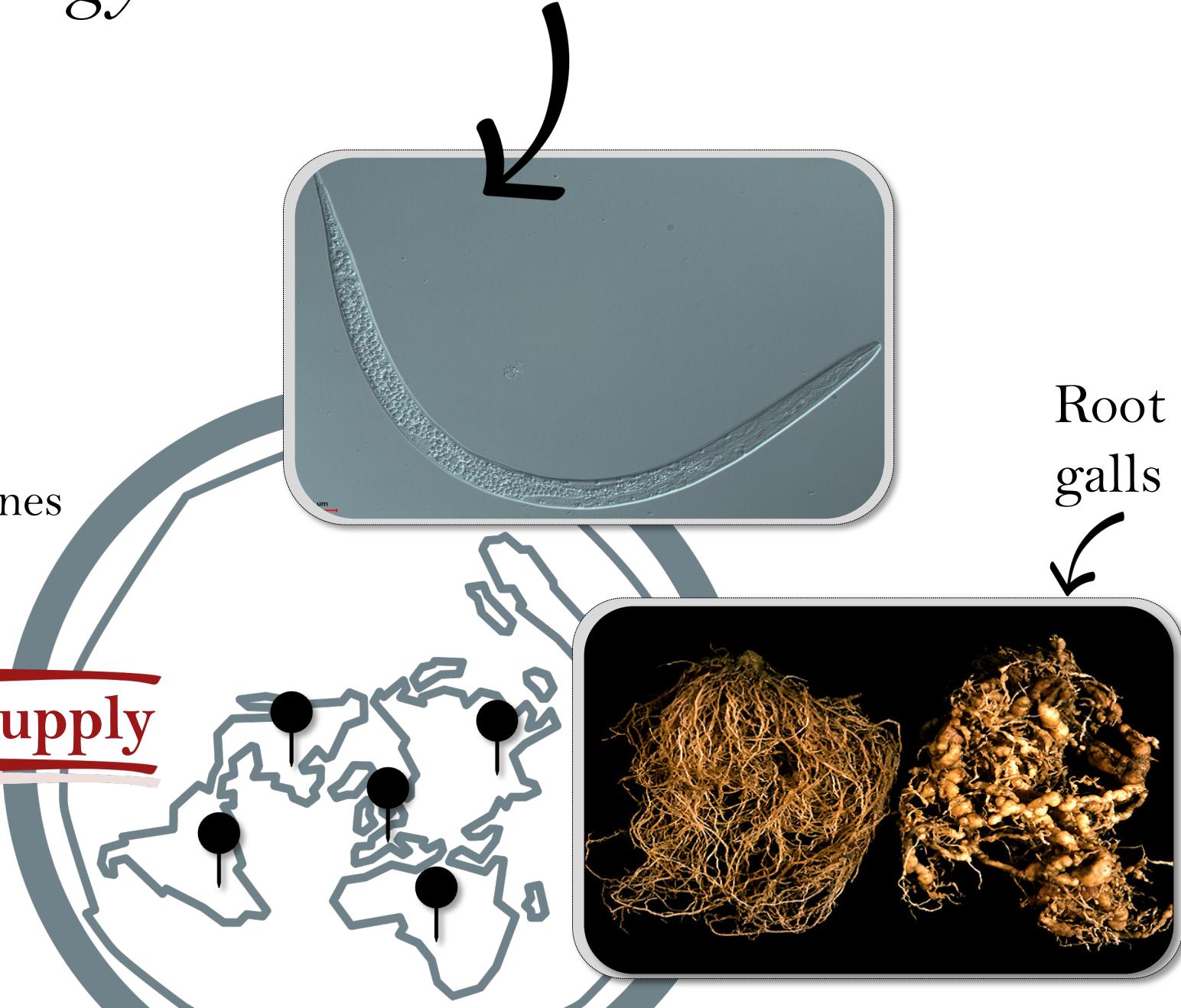
The nematode *Meloidogyne enterolobii*

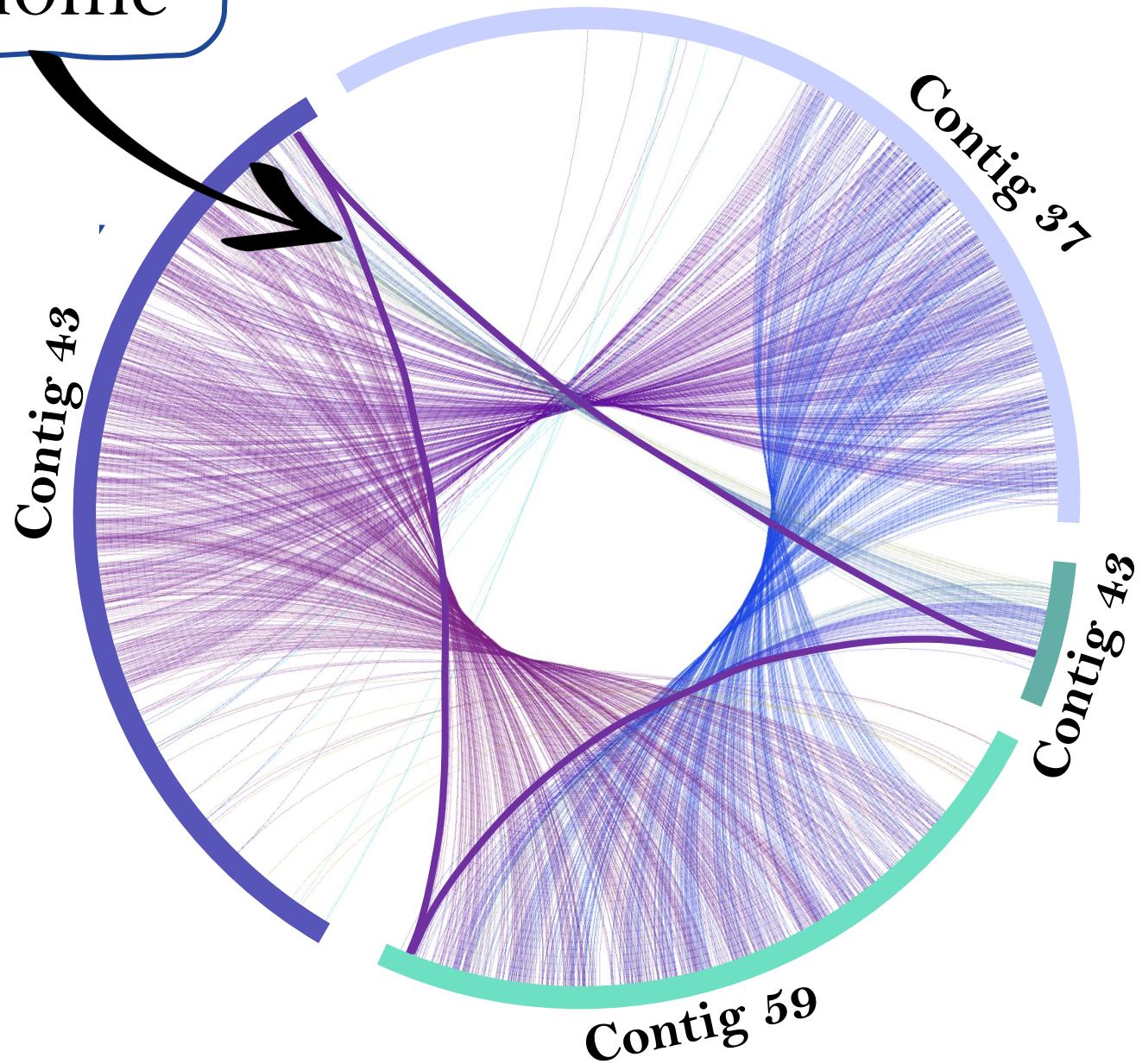


Geographical distribution



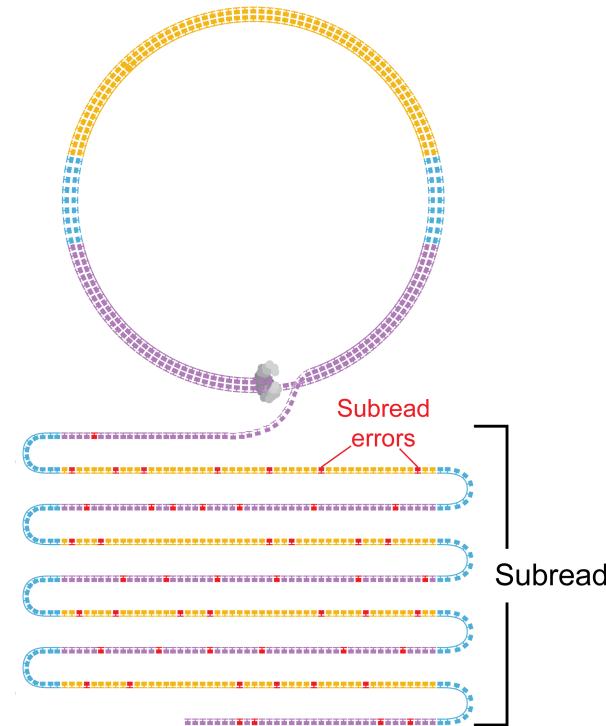
M.ent has a triploid genome

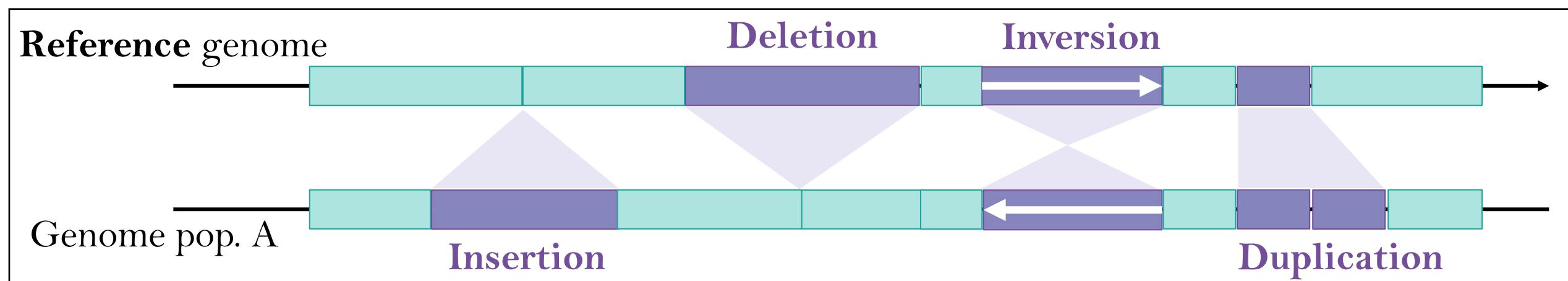

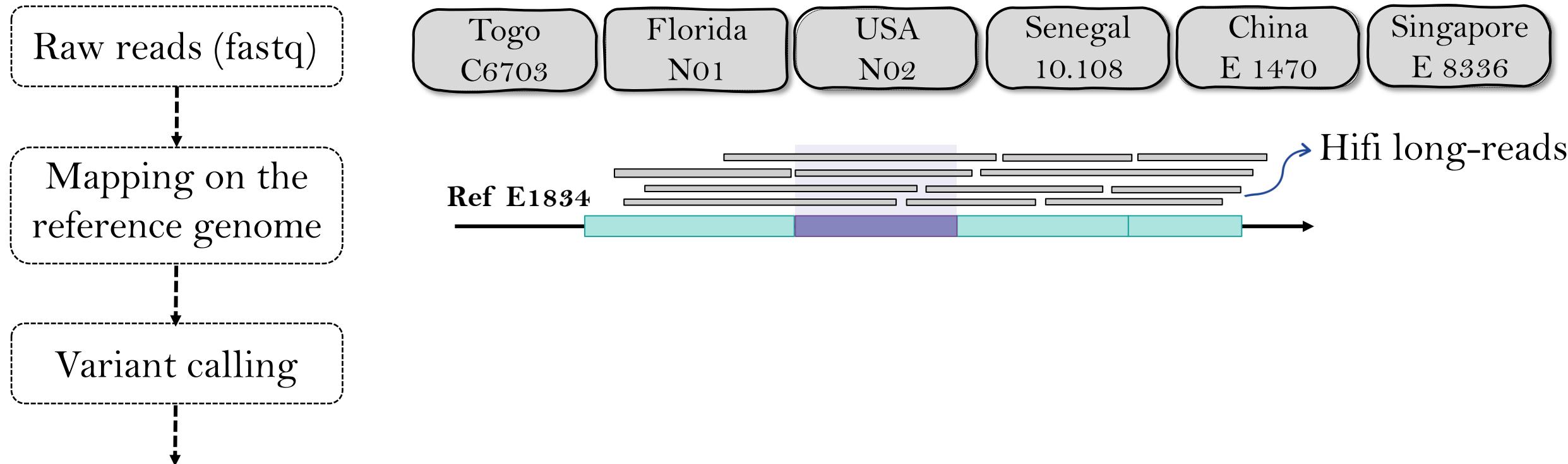

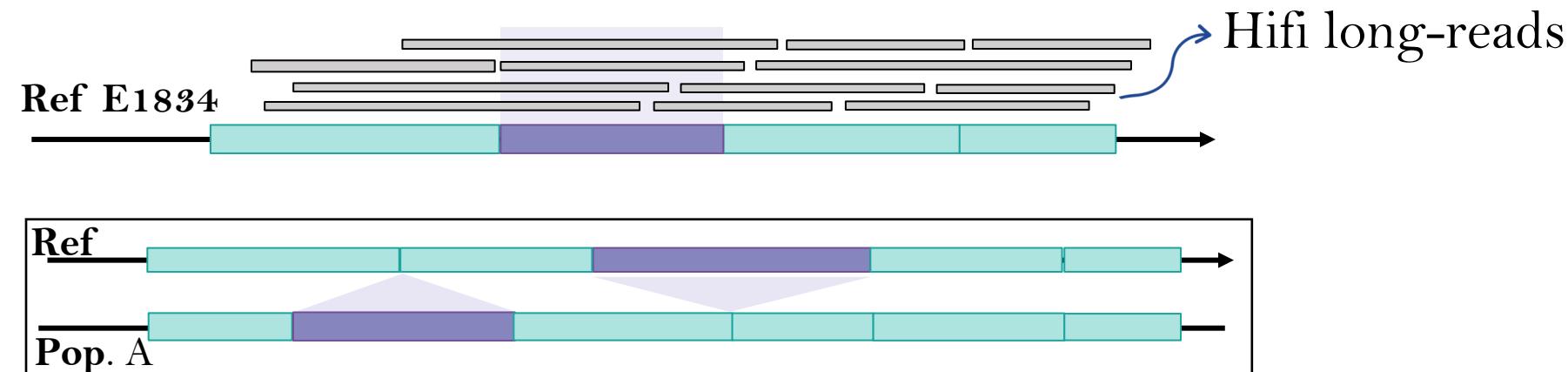
