



Dear colleague, the COVID-19 pandemic has profoundly impacted daily life in France and affected the healthcare system.

The first early flash survey, conducted among more than 25,000 GPs (7,000 responses) between March 14 and 21, highlighted the rapid and massive adaptation of GPs in a context of uncertainty (first results [HERE](#)).

We will start a new phase of the pandemic from May 11, with the ending of the COVID-19 lockdown. In order to continue improving our response to the pandemic, it is essential to monitor the progress of adaptations in practices, not only in the management of COVID patients, but also in the organization of continuity of care, telemedicine and relations with nursing homes. The ACCORD1 network of general practice structures and partners, united around this issue, invites you to take part in this second flash survey (10 minutes). The results of the survey will be sent to you as soon as possible. Thank you very much in advance for your involvement.
