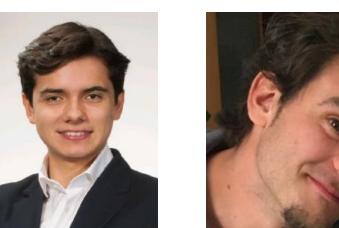

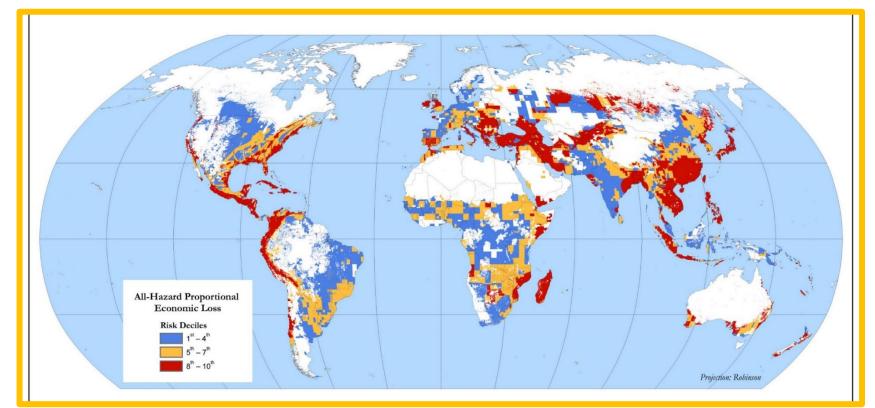

## **ADVANTAGES OVER DIESEL GENERATORS**

- Autonomous system
- Sustainable energy source
- Fast deployment and setup
- Ability to function in an off-grid/remote area
- No carbon emissions

## **APPLICATIONS**

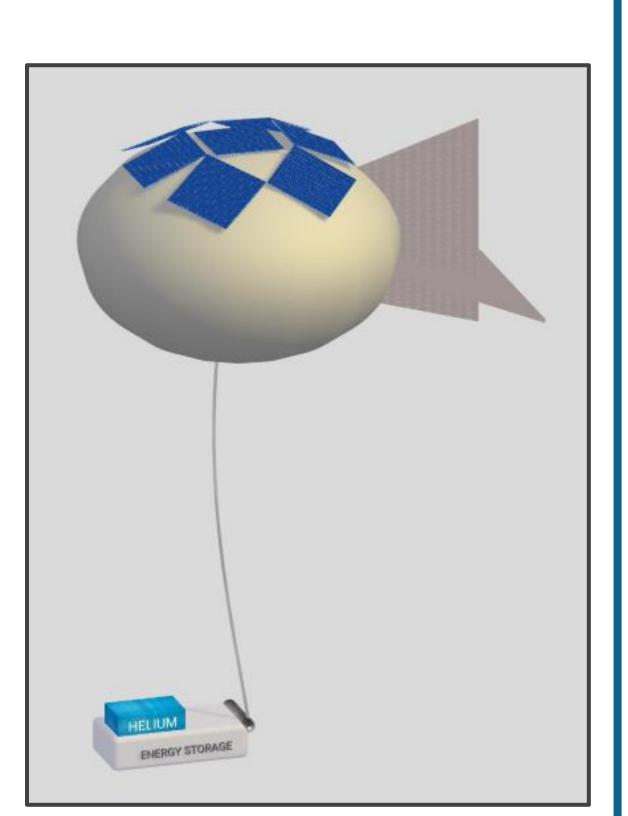
- Natural disaster relief

## **MAIN PARTS**

- Envelope/balloon stabilized
- Solar cells integrated using a net
- Tether for transmission of electricity
- Energy storage / Battery
- Trailer equiped with winch and helium tank

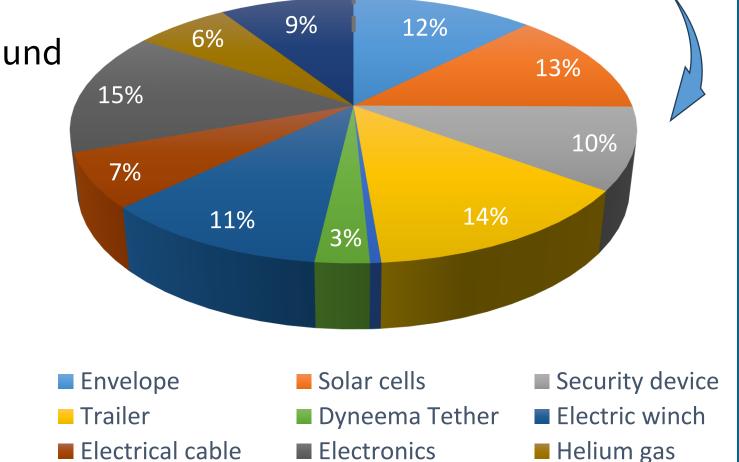
## **TECHNICAL DATA**

- Operational altitude of 150-300 meters
- Balloon volume of 30-60m3
- Payload between 5-10 kg
- Flexible CIGS solar cells (Solar Cloth data)



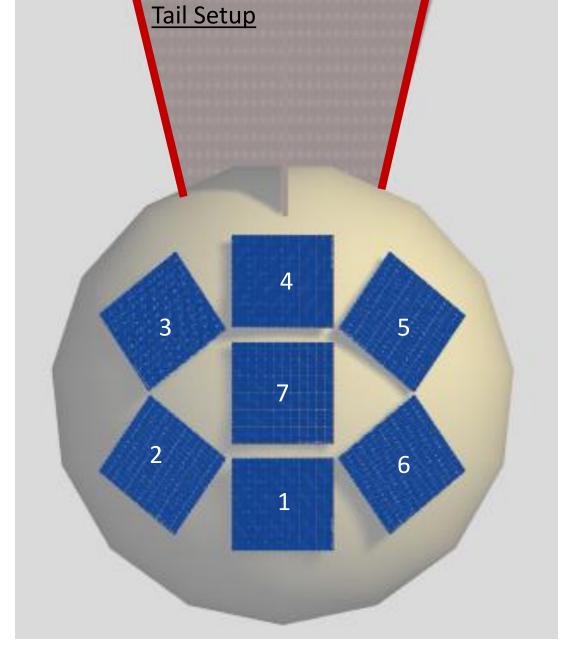
## **ECONOMIC CORNER**

- In 2023, 568000 people were left homeless with no access to electricity
  - In the US, power outages cost business around \$150 billion yearly
- The diesel generator (direct competitors) market is projected to have a size of 26.09 billion USD by 2029
- CAPEX estimated at around 22900 €
- OPEX over 10 years, is 15000 €
- LCOE "Levelized Cost Of Electricity" 3,86 €/kWh

- Battery

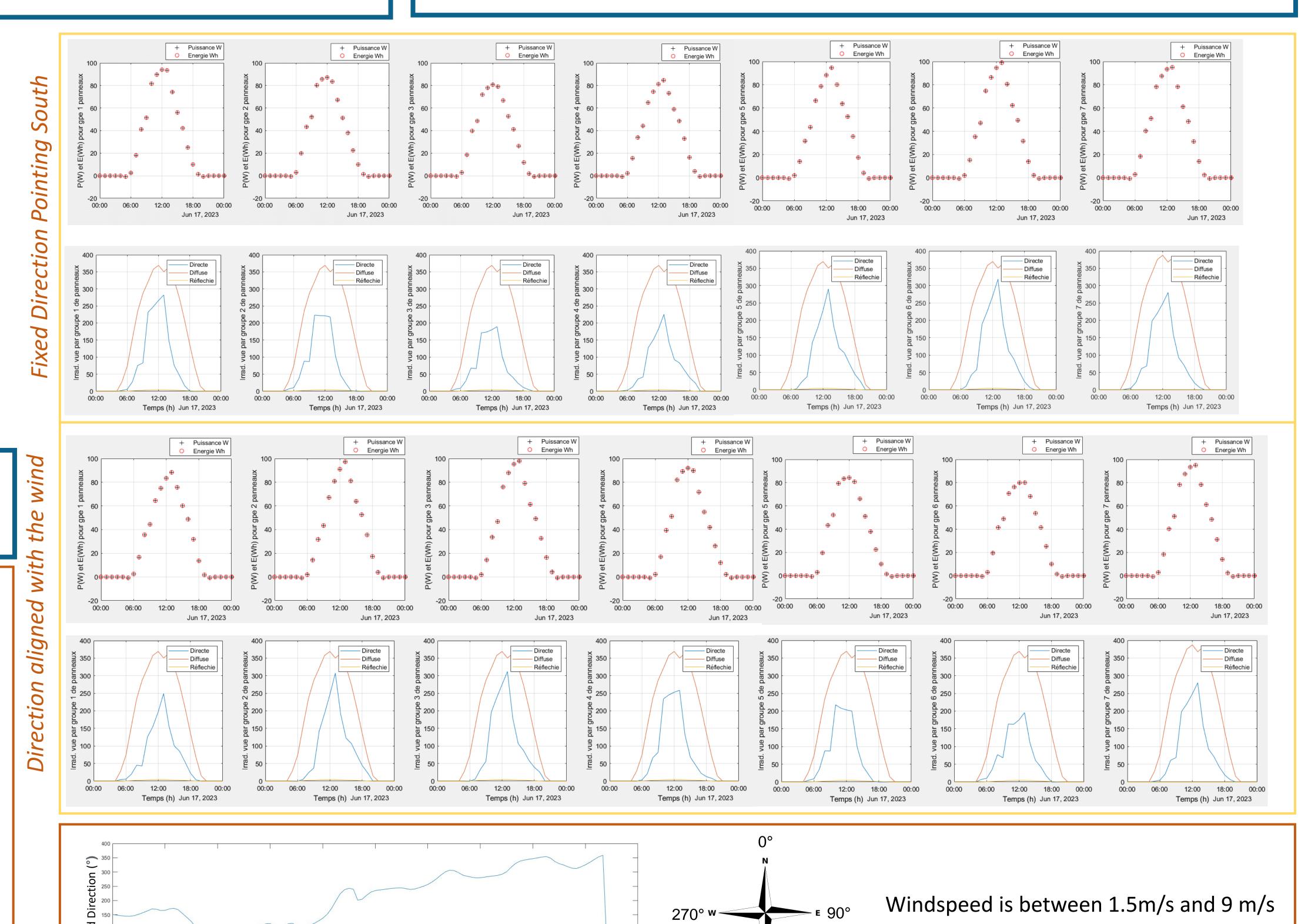


## 2 different cases

- Fixed aerostat facing South (without kite)
- Aerostat facing wind (with kite)

## Main Results for Solar simulation

- The data was chosen for June 2023, direct radiation is dominant
- Except group n°7, all cells have a 25° tilt with respect to the horizontal.
- Very similar energy performance either constantly facing south or aligned with the wind
- May be better to have the balloon aligned with the wind, for a more uniform degradation between panels

- Irradiance data measurements with characterization of solar cells integrated to the balloon in progress.
- Electrical transport and storage using Li-ion battery is planned in a near future.
