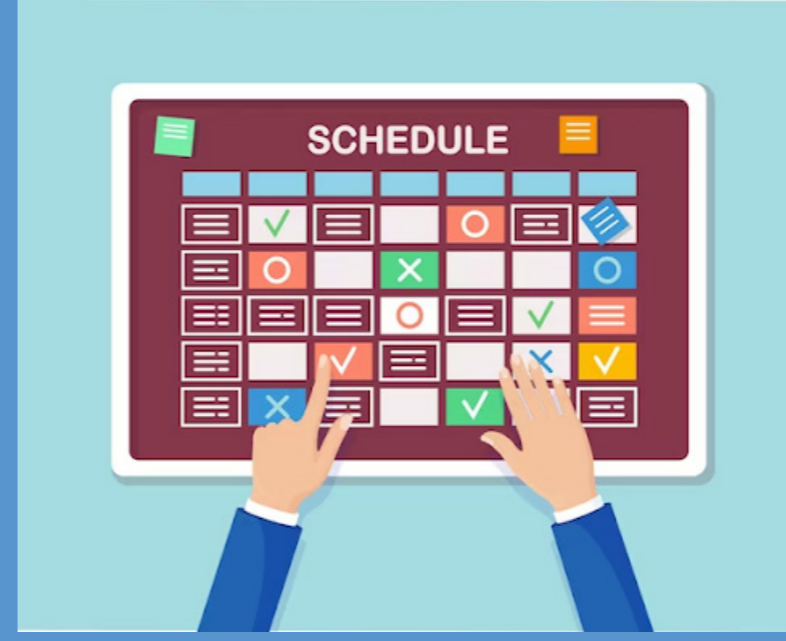
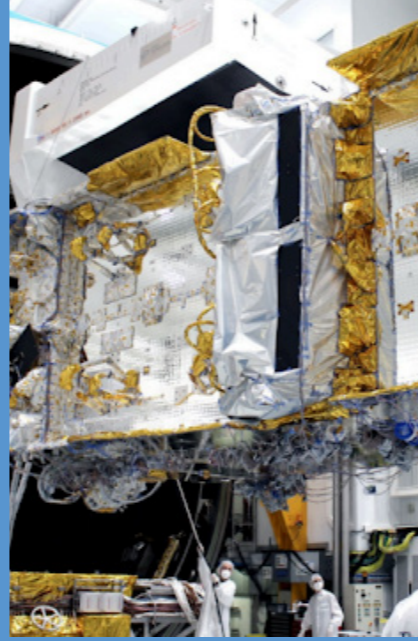

Reduce supervisors' stress and cognitive load

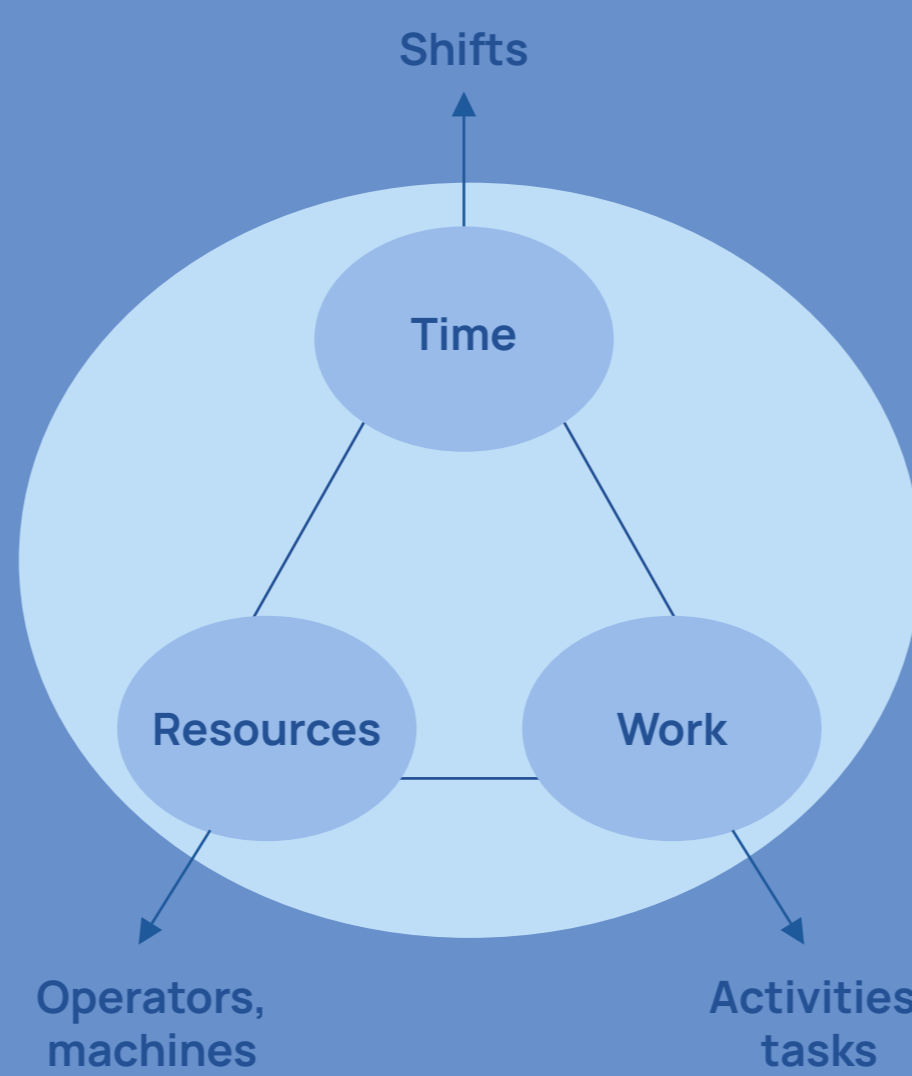


OUR PROBLEM

React in real time to hazards

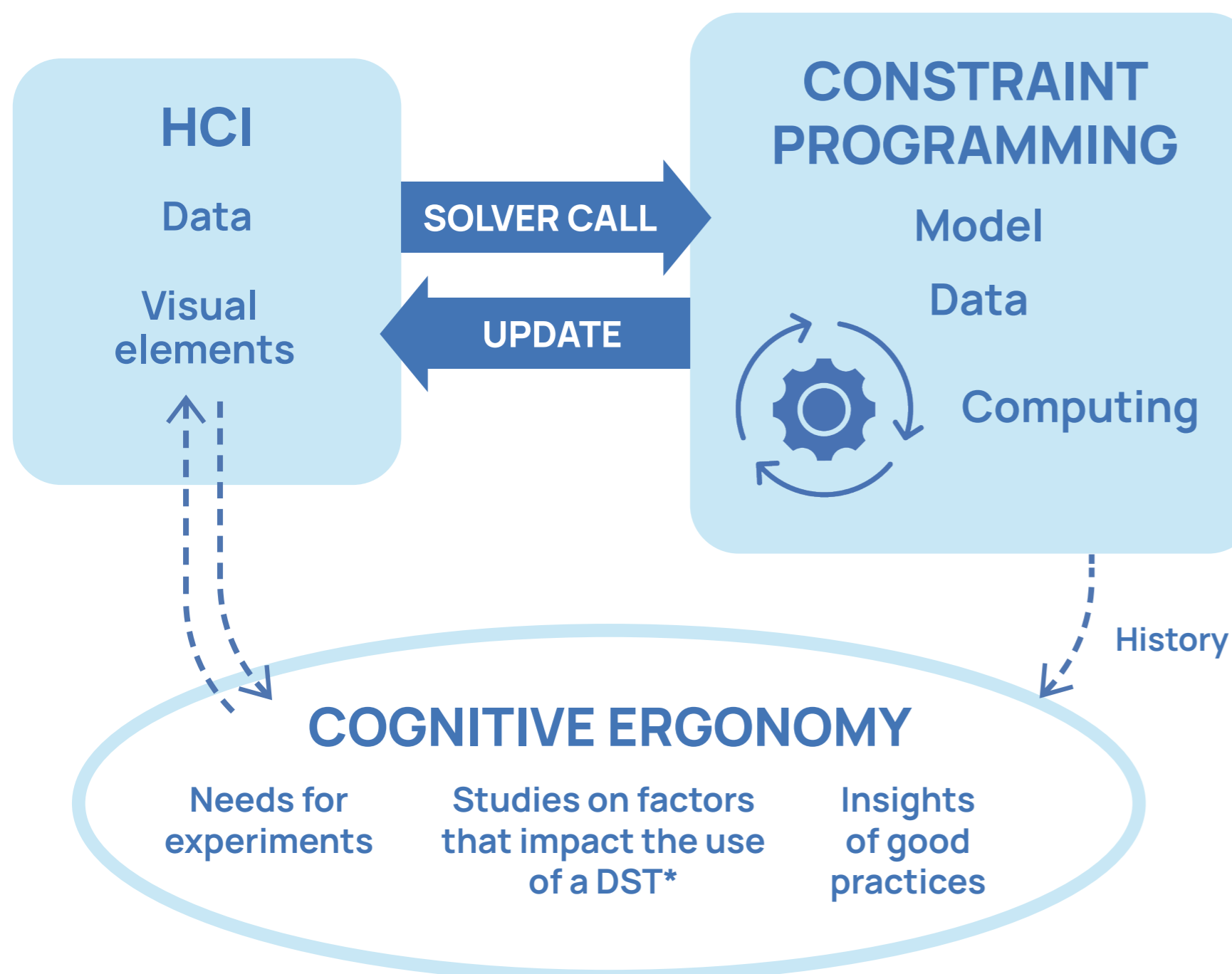


Ensure traceability of decisions

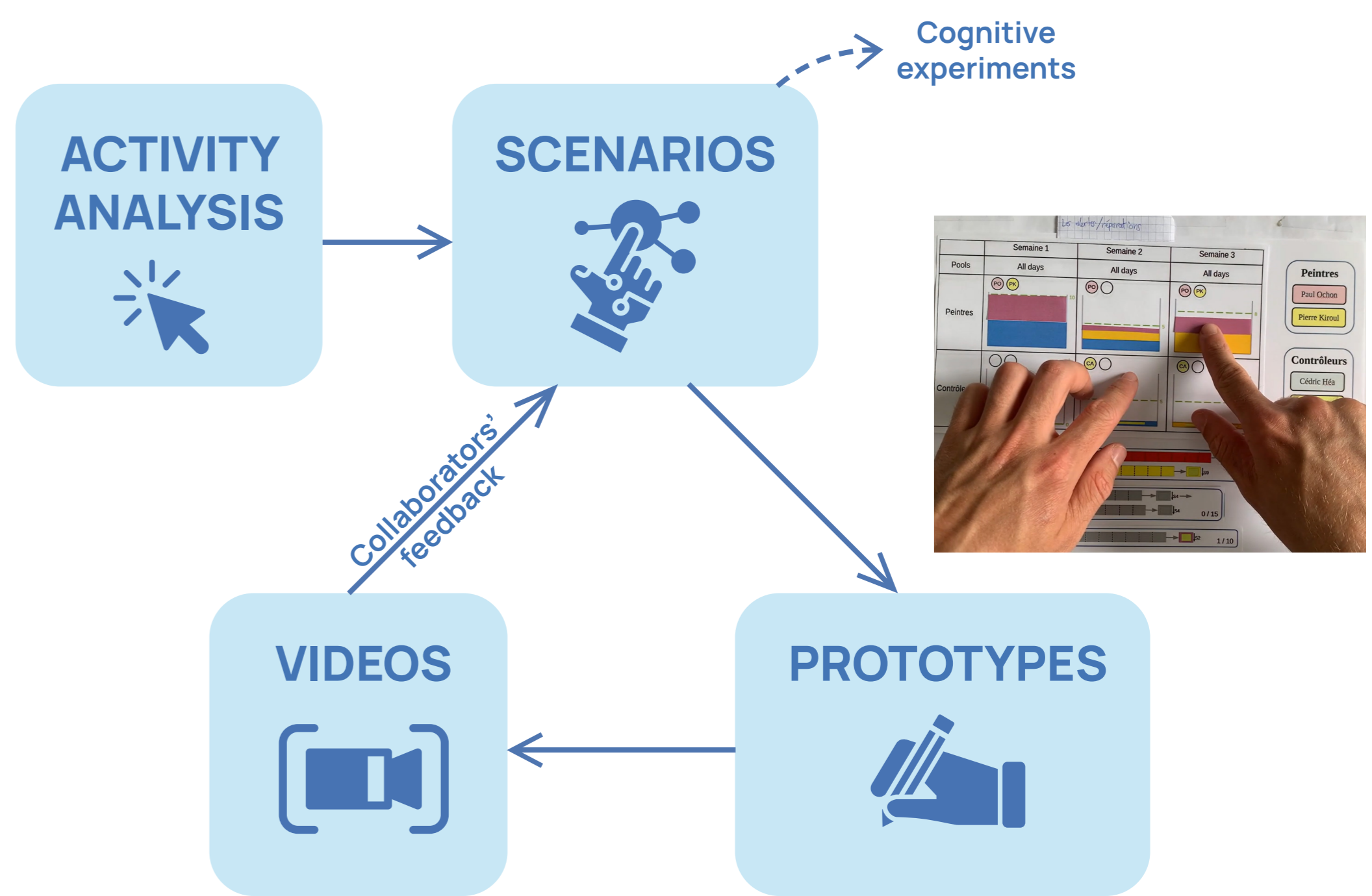
