
General-purpose computing on GPUs

- **GPGPU** = the use of a graphics processing units (GPUs) beyond computation of computer graphics only
- GPUs could perform computation in applications traditionally handled by the central processing unit (CPU)
- Fits **scientific computing**
- The use of multiple video cards in one computer further parallelizes the processing




General-purpose computing on GPUs

- **GPGPU** = the use of a graphics processing units (GPUs) beyond computation of computer graphics only
- GPUs could perform computation in applications traditionally handled by the central processing unit (CPU)
- Fits **scientific computing**
- Example: estimation of non-linear parameters by the **Levenberg-Marquardt algorithm**






- **Hydrate Donor Redshift Anticipation (HyDRA)** blind challenge for the microhydration
- Organizers:
 - University of Göttingen / Paris-Saclay University
 - Prof. Dr. **Ricardo Mata** (theor) / Prof. Dr. **Anne Zehnacker-Rentien** (exp)
- Ten complexes of organic molecules with water
- No experimental information prior to predictions' submission (before Mar 2022)

The HyDRA Challenge: 2021





- The role of theory in understanding hydration is multifaceted:
 - Helps to **assign** the experimental spectral data
 - Could even replace experiment (to some extent)
- A need for **unbiased** tests of different predictive theoretical approaches by experiment

The HyDRA Challenge: 2023



- Submitted:
 - 18 models from 12 groups
 - mostly DFT
- Three (3) best models were selected
- Model **LS4** based on a novel DFT learning strategy that included water geometrical parameters is among **top-3**
- My idea: PBE0-D3BJ/aVT(Q)Z adjusted with a five-parameter regression function
 - Good for GPU-based calculations








WDRAC: Water dimer radical-cation


- The WDRACs, $(\text{H}_2\text{O})_2^{+\bullet}$, react with organic substances in three rather different ways:
 - as electron acceptors
 - as **proton donors**
 - as reagents for the OH^\bullet moiety exchange
- WDRACs could co-exist in two different conformations:
 - ion-radical structure, $\text{H}_3\text{O}^+ \bullet \bullet \bullet \text{OH}^\bullet$, with standard hydrogen bond
 - two-center-three-electron non-classical **hemibonded** configuration, $(\text{H}_2\text{O} \bullet \bullet \bullet \text{OH}_2)^{+\bullet}$.



“Modern” nitrogen fixation: Haber-Bosch process




- **Haber-Bosch process** (1909) is the main industrial procedure for nitrogen fixation:



- Parameters:
 - Catalyst: Fe/FeO
 - Pressure: ~200 bar
 - Temperature: ~500 °C




