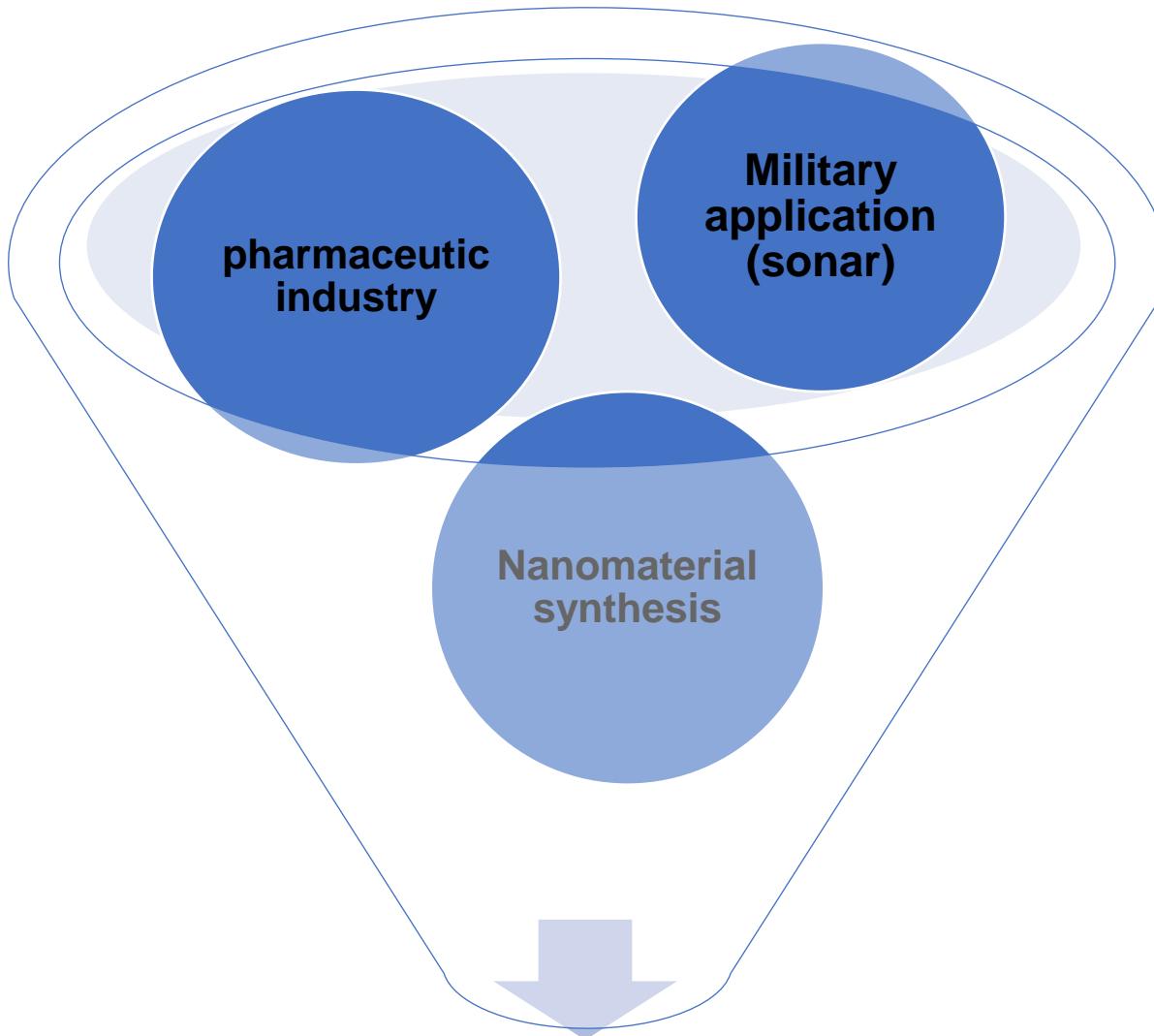

# Sonochemistry & Acoustic cavitation



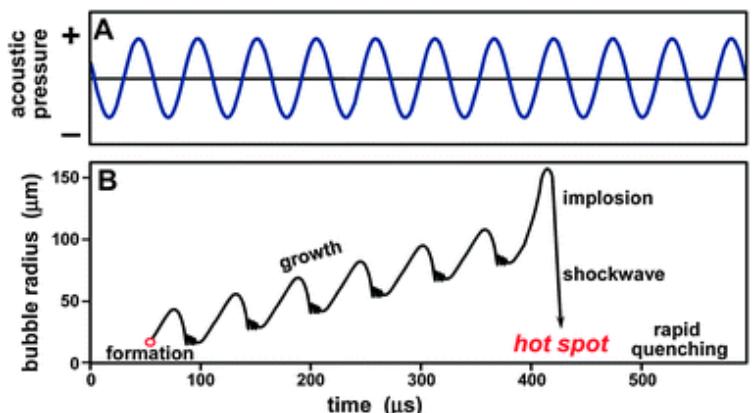
1927: Richards & Loomis describe sonochemical hydrolysis of dimethyl sulphate at **100-500 kHz**

1929: Schmitt describes the ultrasonic oxidation of iodide ions at **750 kHz**

## Acoustic Cavitation

Nucleation > growth > Implosive collapse of micro-bubbles

 $P \sim 1000 \text{ bars}$

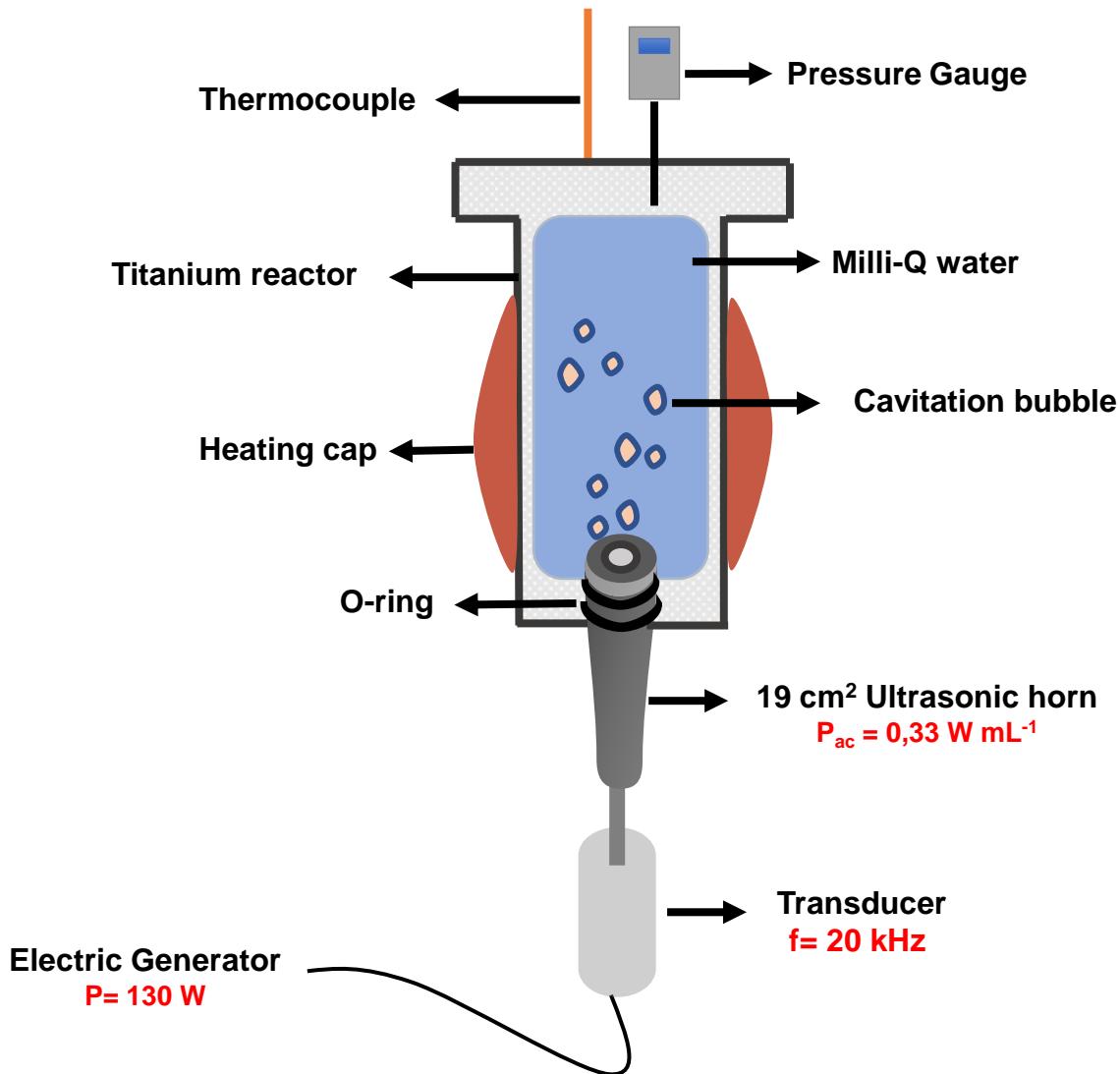
## Mechanical force at the interface S/L

Micro-jet:  $\sim 150 \text{ m s}^{-1}$  à  $20 \text{ kHz}$

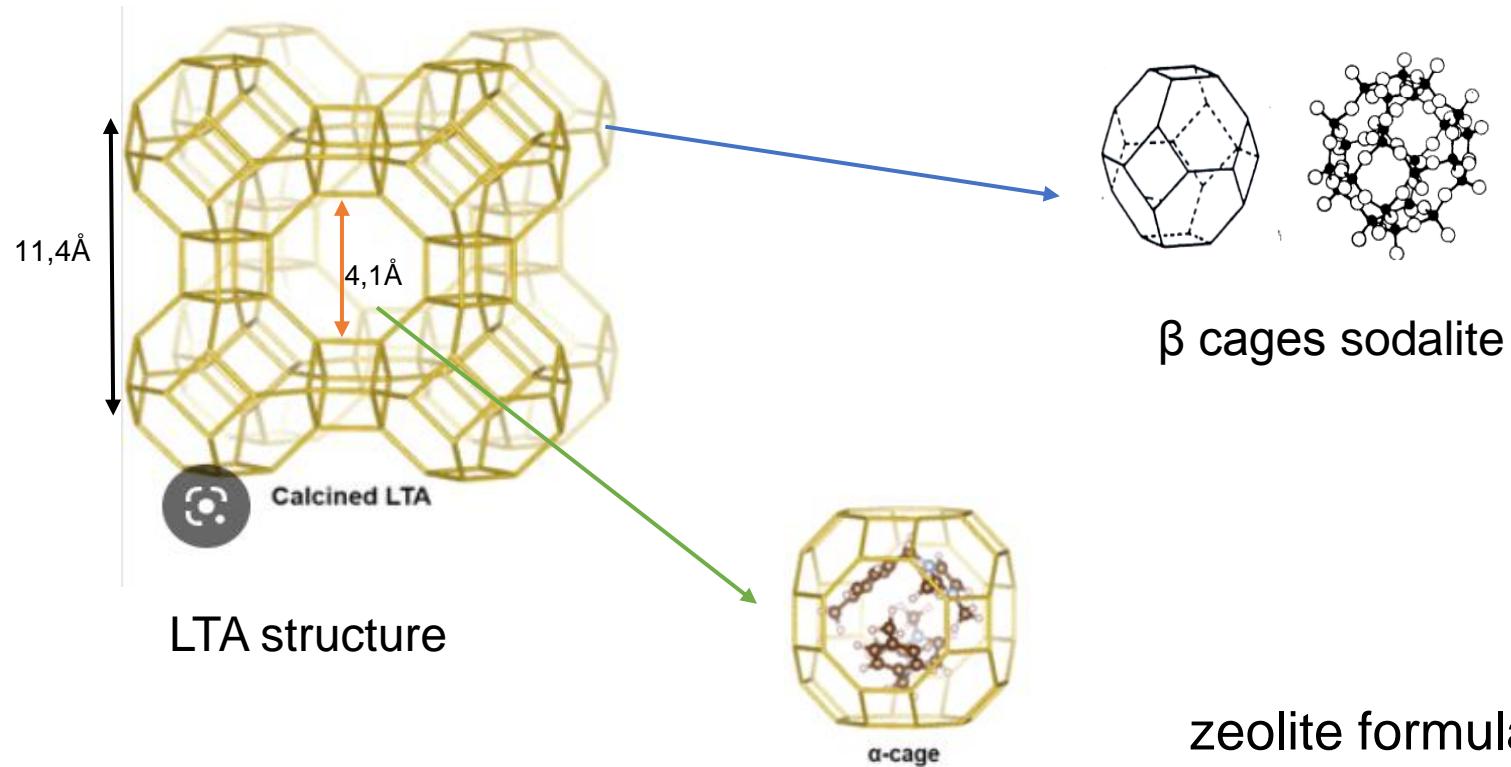

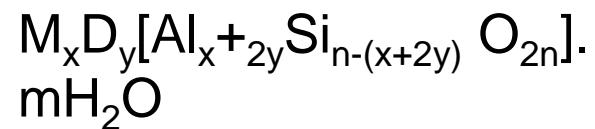

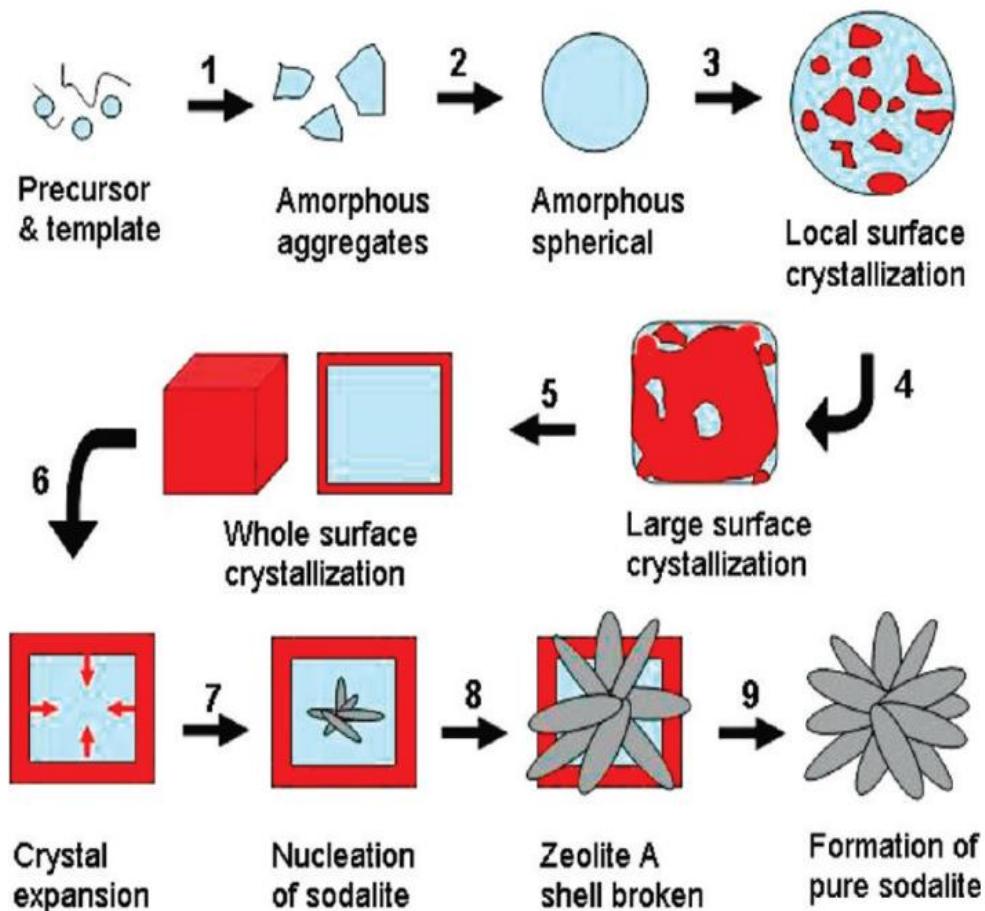

+



$\text{SiO}_2$  in 3M  
sodium hydroxide solution

$\text{NaAlO}_2$  in  
water

LTA zeolite  
formula  
 $\text{Na}_{12}(\text{H}_2\text{O})_{278}$   
 $\text{Al}_{12}\text{Si}_{12}\text{O}_{48}$

Mechanical stirring 30 minutes (25 °C)  
Or 20 kHz US, 70% amplitude, 30 minutes (70 °C)



SHT Reactor

SHT experimental conditions:

20 KHz , 100 °C

Autogenous pressure (1,4 atm)

50mL precursor

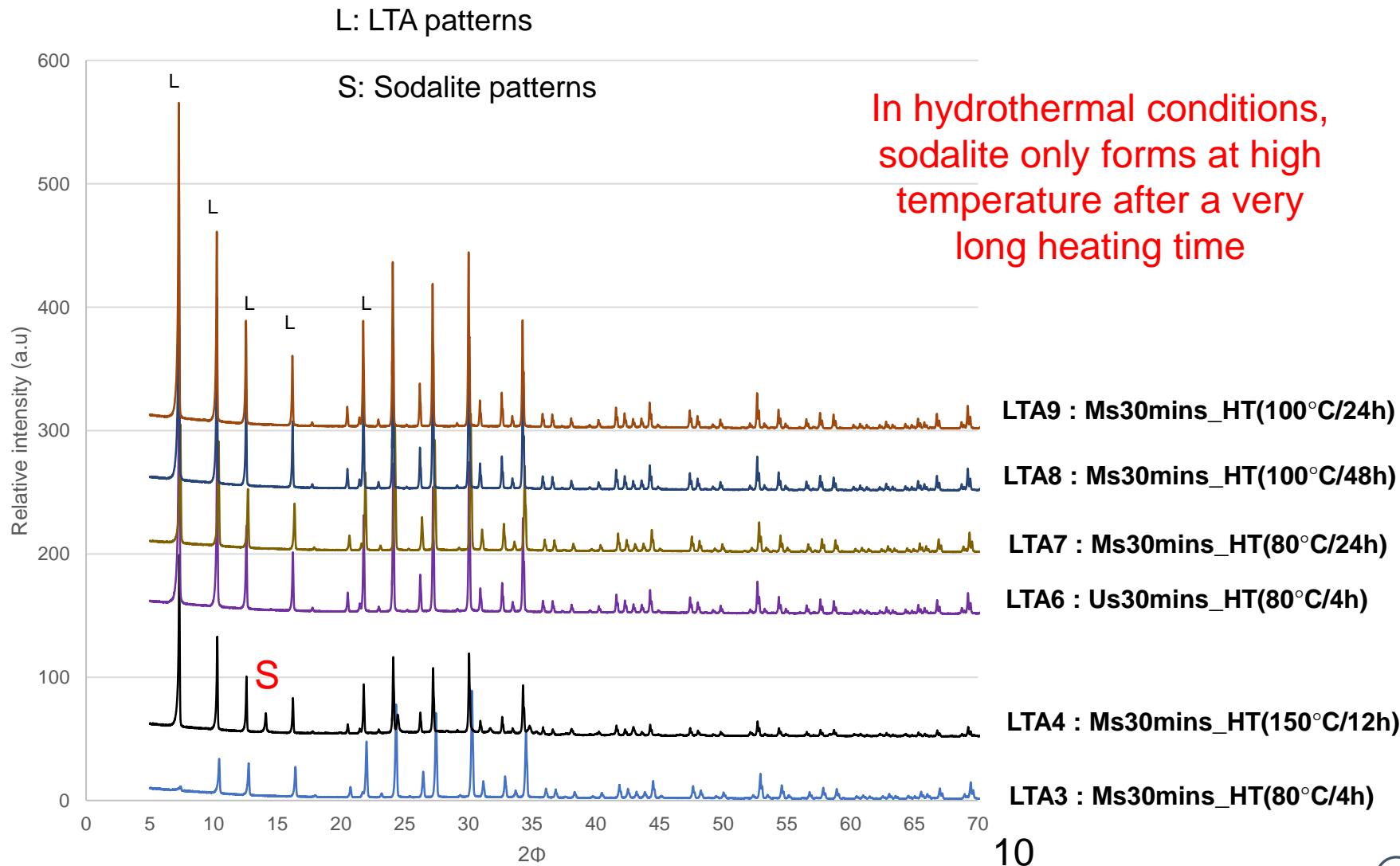


Silent conditions

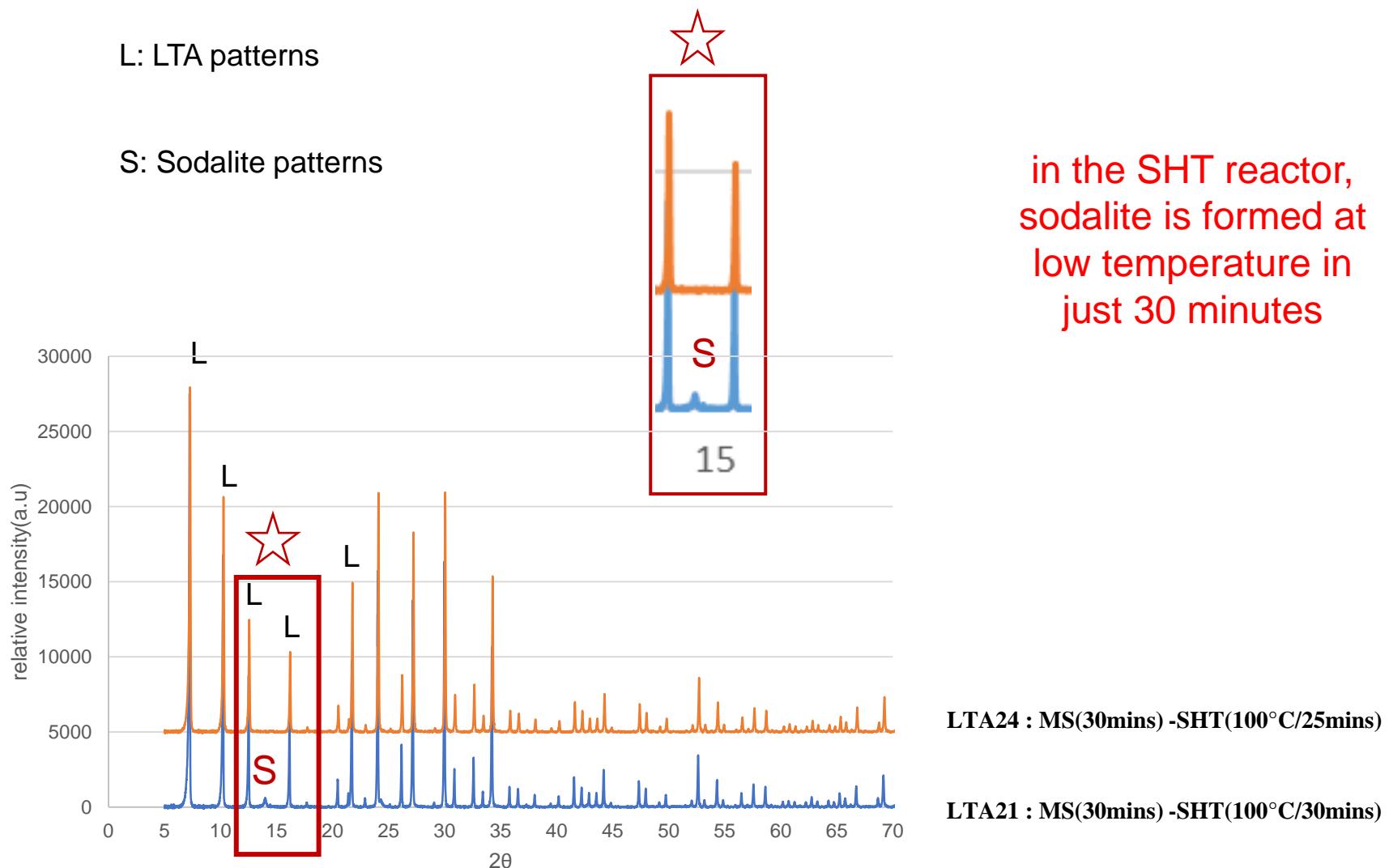
Hydrothermal (Parr reactor)

SHT treatment has an effect on particle size
