Glass interposer for heterogeneous integration of flipchipped photonic and electronic integrated circuits



System 1

- Multi-wavelength femtosecond (300fs) diodepumped (DPSS) lasers (343,515,1030nm) galvanometer deflection with extended field of 50×50mm²
- sample stage up to 300×300 mm² with linear accuracy +/- 0.5 μ m, repeatability +/- 0.2 μ m Trepan head
- Position synchronized output (PSO)





- Materials structuring at reduced thermal budget
- No compatibility issues due to materials and processing chemistry
