Description The aim is to create a KO / KOc / KI mouse model for a specific, targeted

gene. The request is made by email (traceability). An inception meeting is

scheduled to determine the targeting strategy.

Production of the transgene, genetic modification using the transgene, characterisation of the mice (between 6 and 15 months after the first

meeting).

Homologous Recombination (HR)

- Production of the transgene (15- 25kb)
- Modification of murine embryonic stem (ES) cells
- Characterisation of murine ES cells
- Injection of RH murine ES cells
- Obtaining chimeric mice
- Transmission of the mutation to the progeny (establishment of the murine line)

CrispR-Cas9

- Transgene design (0.001 1 kb)
- Synthesis of RNA guides
- Electroporation of guide RNA + transgene into zygote stage embryo
- Obtaining F0 mosaic mice
- Transmission of the mutation to the progeny (establishment of the murine line)
