Ultrasound and bioluminescence Imaging

Description

Name of the method

<u>Ultrasound Imaging :</u>

Data will be acquired using various ultrasound Machines. In most research project, images are acquired on anesthetized animals, but acquisitions can be performed to explore some soft material properties. Brielfy ultrasound imaging devices emit ultrasound and collect reflected echoes from soft tissues and eventually generate images or mesure Doppler signals. an image is acquired on a single animal, imaging only parts of soft tissues of the animal.

- Visualsonics machine (VEVO F2 and VEVO 2100) : These systems ar high resolution imaging systems running high frequency probes (15 to 60MHz central frequency), leading to images with resolution up to 40µm. Images are acquired using the proprietary software running the system. The system produces anatomical B mode images, Power or Color Doppler images, Non linear contrast images, shear wave elastography images or optoacoustic images. These images can be a single image or 2D+t image sequences. Lastly these images can be acquired in 3D. Additionnally, there are Pulsed Wave Doppler traces showing blood flow velocities or Time Motion mode showing 1D data over time. These images are acquired live to frame rates up to 200 images per second, stored in the machine and eventually exported for archiving or measurement using proprietary software (VEVO Lab, Visualsonics).
- Aixplorer (Supersonic Imagine) : This system is a clinical device, tunning probes between 3 to 15MHz Probes, leading to resolution up to 250µm. images are acquired using the proprietary software running the system. The system produces anatomical B mode images, Power or Color Doppler images, Shear Wave Elastography images. These images can be a single image or 2D+t image sequences.. Additionnally, there are Pulsed Wave Doppler traces showing blood flow velocities. These images are acquired live to frame rates up to 70 images per second, stored in the machine and eventually exported for archiving. Measurement are being done using the proprietary software on the machine.
- Verasonics Vantage 256 : This machine is a high frame rate programmable ultrasound system. It is run using proprietary libraries runnig using Matlab Software. It can acquire images up to 10000 images per second, and can run ultrasound probes up to 30MHz. The images are stored in a Matlab Format and are processed with user developped software in matlab to generate images. The Raw data or IQ data can be stored for further analysis.

Bioluminescence imaging

The data is collected with an Optima RT (BiospaceLabs, France) system. This sytem acquires photons coming out of up to 5 mice in a single data acquisition. The system collects photons on a CCD Camera after photoamplification allowing real time photon acquisition. The data is stored in a proprietary format based on list file format (similar to nulcea medicine file format, listing the coordinates of each single photon count by the machine). Data is presented as images integrating photon count over time. This photon count can be recalculated afeter acquisition, changing the integration window. The result image can be displayed in counts of photon, couts per minute, photons, photons per second, photons per second per steradian, photons per second per steradiants per cm².

this data, save in a proprietary file format is archived and can further analyzed using the M3 Vision proprietary software.

the machine produces three types of images : a photographs of the animals being imaged, fluorescence images and bioluminescence images. Fluorescence images are generated after appropriate selection of excitation and emission filters with integration times about a few milliseconds. Bioluminescence images are acquired without excitation, collected photons emitted by bioluminescence of chemiluminescence reaction in vivo (luciferaseluciferin, luminol,..).
